

The Feasts of יהוה

- The Feasts of יהוה, part of the law of the Torah and followed by the tribes of Israel over a period of ~1440 years (BC), were placed on the calendar to pre-designate memorials and celebrations for certain days and events when יהוה would incrementally implement His plan to redeem man from death.
 - ...a feast, or of the new month, or of the Sabbath: Which are a shadow of things to come and body of Messiah (Colossians 2:16-17)
 - For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things... (Hebrews 10:1)
- The Spring Feasts contain the shadow of the events that were performed by Messiah during His First Coming, on the very day of the feast associated with that event.
- The Fall Feasts contain the shadow of the events that Messiah will soon complete upon His Second Coming, on the very same day of the feast!

Spring Feasts Overview

- Passover (1st month)
 - Lamb Selected (10th)
 - Lamb Sacrificed (14th)
- Feast of Unleavened Bread (1st month)
 - Feast of Unleavened Bread (7 days, 15th 21st, 2
 High Sabbaths occurring on the first and last days)
 - Day of First Fruits (day after weekly Sabbath during the Feast)
- Shavuot (Feast of Weeks) (50 days after First Fruits, a High Sabbath)



Fall Feasts Overview

- Sukkot (Feast of Tabernacles) (in the 7th month)
 - Yom Teruah (Day of Trumpets) (1st Day High Sabbath)
 - Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement) (10th Day High Sabbath from 9th even)
 - Sukkot (Feast of Tabernacles) (7 days, 15th 21st Days, with a High Sabbath on the first day)
 - Shemini Atzeret (Last Great Day) (22nd Day High Sabbath)




The Feast Rituals

- And when the builders laid the foundation of the temple of יהוה, they set the <u>priests in their apparel with trumpets</u>, and the Levites the sons of Asaph <u>with cymbals</u>, to <u>praise</u>, <u>after the ordinance of David king of Israel</u>. (Ezra 3:10)
- These ordinances are the details of the "shadow of good things to come"
- No direct scroll of the ordinances of David has been found to date but many of the traditional ritual procedures/ details have been captured in verses or other historical documents.

Day of Trumpets

- Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a Sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, a set apart convocation. Ye shall do no servile work therein: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto יהוה. (Leviticus 23:24-25)
- And in the seventh month, on the first day of the month, ye shall have a set apart convocation; ye shall do no servile work: it is a day of blowing the trumpets unto you. (Numbers 29:1)




The Day of Trumpets

- Day of Trumpets (Yom Teruah), יום תרועה
- Teruah (H8643, תרועה), defined as:
 - clamor, i.e. <u>acclamation of joy</u> or a <u>battle-cry</u>;
 especially clangor of <u>trumpets</u>, as an alarum:
 - alarm,
 - blowing (of, the) (trumpets),
 - joy, jubile, loud noise, rejoicing, <u>shouting</u>, (high, joyful) sounding.
- Also known as the <u>Day of Shouting</u>

The Day of Trumpets A Celebration!

- ...Sing aloud unto Elohiym our strength: make a joyful noise unto the Elohi of Jacob. Take a psalm, and bring hither the timbrel, the pleasant harp with the psaltery.
 Blow up the trumpet in the new month, in the time appointed, on our solemn feast day. (Psalm 81:1-3)
 - "psalm", zamrah (H2172 זמרה), a musical melody or song to be accompanied by an instrument
 - "timbrel", tofe (H8596, תף), a tambourine
 - "harp", ken-nore (H3658, כנור), a harp, to twang
 - "psaltery", nevel (H5035, נבל), a lyre (as having a body of like form as a vase)
 - "trumpet", shofar (H7782, שופר), a cornet (as giving a clear sound) or curved horn



Day of Trumpets Noah and the Flood

• ...And on the new month of the seventh month all the mouths of the abysses of the earth were opened, and the waters began to descend into them. (Jubilees 6:26)



Day of Trumpets Abram Declares the Most High

...Abram sat up throughout the night on the new month of the seventh month to observe the stars from the evening to the morning, in order to see what would be the character of the year with regard to the rains... And a word came into his heart and he said: All the signs of the stars, and the signs of the moon and of the sun are all in the hand of יהוה. Why do I search them out?.. And he prayed that night and said, 'My Sovereign Ruler, in Most High, You alone are my Sovereign Ruler, And You and Your dominion have I chosen. (Jubilees 12:16-17)



Day of Trumpets Abram Asks to Walk the Path of יהוה

- And <u>Terah took Abram his son</u>, and <u>Lot</u> the son of Haran his son's son, and Sarai his daughter in law, <u>his son Abram's wife</u>; and they went forth with them from <u>Ur of the Chaldees</u>, to go into the land of Canaan; <u>and they came unto Haran</u>, and <u>dwelt there</u>. (Genesis 11:31)
- Deliver me from the hands of evil spirits who have dominion over the thoughts of men's hearts, and let them not lead me astray from You, my Sovereign Ruler. And establish You me and my seed forever that we go not astray from henceforth and forevermore.'... 'Shall I return unto Ur of the Chaldees who seek my face that I may return to them, am I to remain here in this place? The right path before You prosper it in the hands of Your servant that he may fulfill it and that I may not walk in the deceitfulness of my heart, O יהוה my Sovereign Ruler.'
 ...behold the word of יהוה was sent... (Jubilees 12:19-21)

Day of Trumpets Promises to Abram


- Now יהוה had said unto Abram, <u>Get thee out of thy country</u>, <u>and from thy kindred</u>, <u>and from thy father's house</u>, <u>unto a land that I will shew thee</u>: And <u>I will make of thee a great nation</u>, and <u>I will bless thee</u>, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing: And <u>I will bless them that bless thee</u>, <u>and curse him that curseth thee</u>: and <u>in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed</u>. (Genesis 12:1-3)
- 'Get you up from your country, and from your kindred and from the house of your father unto a land which I will show you, and I shall make you a great and numerous nation....And I will be a Sovereign Ruler to you and your son, and to your son's son, and to all your seed: fear not, from henceforth and unto all generations of the earth I am יהוה your Sovereign Ruler.' (Jubilees 12:22/24)

Day of Trumpets Abram Receives the Pure Language

• And יהוה Almighty said: 'Open his mouth and his ears, that he may hear and speak with his mouth, with the language which has been revealed'; for it had ceased from the mouths of all the children of men from the day of the overthrow (of Babel). And I opened his mouth, and his ears and his lips, and I began to speak with him in Hebrew in the tongue of the creation. And he took the books of his fathers, and these were written in Hebrew, and he transcribed them, and he began from henceforth to study them,... (Jubilees 12:25-27)

Jacob's Sanctification Before The Day of Trumpets

- And <u>Elohiym said unto Jacob</u>, <u>Arise</u>, <u>go up to Bethel</u>, <u>and dwell there</u>: <u>and make there an altar unto Elohiym</u>, that appeared unto thee when thou fleddest from the face of Esau thy brother. <u>Then Jacob said unto his household</u>, and to all that were with him, <u>Put away the strange gods</u> that are among you, and <u>be clean</u>, and <u>change your garments</u>: (Genesis 35:1-2)
- And on the new month of the month (Note: this would be the sixth month) Yacob spoke to all the people of his house. saying: 'Purify yourselves and change your garments, and let us arise and go up to Bethel, where I vowed a vow to Him on the day when I fled from the face of Esau my brother, because He has been with me and brought me into this land in shalom, and put you away the strange gods that are among you.'And they gave up the strange gods and that which was in their ears and which was on their necks and the idols which Rachel stole from Laban her father she gave wholly to Yacob. And he burnt and brake them to pieces and destroyed them, and hid them under an oak which is in the land of Shechem. (Jubilees 31:1-2)

The Day of Trumpets Isaac's Prophecy to Levi

- And he went up on the new month of the seventh month to Bethel. And he built an altar at the place where he had slept, and he set up a pillar there... And <u>Yacob</u> went to... the house of his father Abraham, and he took two of his sons with him, Levi and Yahudah, and he came to his father Yitschaq and to his mother Rebecca. (Jubilees 31:3/5)
- And the spirit of prophecy came down into his mouth,... And he turned to Levi first, and began to bless him first, and said to him: May the ALMIGHTY of all, the very יהוה of all the ages, bless you and your children throughout all the ages. And may in give to you and to your seed greatness and great splendor, and cause you and your seed, from among all flesh, to approach Him to serve in His sanctuary as the malakim of the presence and as the kodesh ones. (Even) as they, shall the seed of your sons be for splendor and greatness and kodeshness, and may He make them great unto all the ages. (Jubilees 31:12-14)

The Day of Trumpets Isaac's Prophecy to Levi

 And they shall be judges and princes, and chiefs of all the seed of the sons of Yacob; They shall speak the word of יהוה in righteousness, And they shall judge all His judgments in righteousness. And they shall declare My ways to Yacob And My paths to Yisrael. The blessing of יהוה shall be given in their mouths To bless all the seed of the beloved. Your mother has called your name Levi, And justly has she called your name; You shall be joined to יהוה And be the companion of all the sons of Yacob; Let His table be yours, And do you and your sons eat thereof; And may your table be full unto all generations, And your food fail not unto all the ages. And let all who hate you fall down before you, And let all your adversaries be rooted out and perish; And blessed be he that blesses you, And cursed be every nation that curses you.' (Jubilees 31:15-17)


The Day of Trumpets Isaac's Prophecy to Judah

• And to Yahudah he said: 'May יהוה give you strength and power To tread down all that hate you; A prince shall you be, you and one of your sons, over the sons of Yacob; May your name and the name of your sons go forth and traverse every land and region. Then shall the Gentiles fear before your face, and all the nations shall quake [And all the peoples shall quake]. In you shall be the help of Yacob, And in you be found the salvation of Yisrael. And when you sit on the throne of honor of your righteousness, There shall be great shalom for all the seed of the sons of the **beloved**; Blessed be he that blesses you, And all that hate you and afflict you and curse you Shall be rooted out and destroyed from the earth and be accursed... And he went forth from between his feet and fell down and bowed down to him, and he blessed them and rested there with Yitschaq his father that night, and they eat and drank with joy... And Yacob told his father everything during the night, how יהוה had shown him great mercy, and how he had prospered (him in) all his ways, and protected him from all evil. (Jubilees 31:18-20/22/24)

The Day of Trumpets Eternal Hope

 And Yacob remembered the prayer with which his father had blessed him and his two sons, Levi and Yahudah, and he rejoiced and blessed יהוה the ALMIGHTY of his fathers, Abraham and Yitschaq. And he said: 'Now I know that I have an eternal hope, and my sons also, before the ALMIGHTY of all'; and thus is it ordained concerning the two; and they record it as an eternal testimony unto them on the heavenly tablets how Yitschaq blessed them. (Jubilees 31:31-32)

The Day of Trumpets Joseph

- Sing aloud unto Elohiym our strength: make a joyful noise unto the Elohi of Jacob. Take a psalm, and bring hither the timbrel, the pleasant harp with the psaltery. Blow up the trumpet in the new month, in the time appointed, on our solemn feast day. (Psalm 81:1-3)
- For this was a statute for Israel, and a law of the Elohiym of Jacob. This He ordained in Joseph for a testimony, when he went out through the land of Egypt: where I heard a language that I understood not. I removed his shoulder from the burden: his hands were delivered from the pots. Thou calledst in trouble, and I delivered thee; I answered thee in the secret place of thunder: I proved thee at the waters of Meribah. Selah. (Psalm 81:4-7)

The Day of Trumpets Joseph

- Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him hastily out of the dungeon... (Genesis 41:14)
- And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I have dreamed a dream...And Pharaoh said unto his servants, Can we find such a one as this is, a man in whom the Spirit of Elohiym is? And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, See, I have set thee over all the land of Egypt. And Pharaoh took off his ring from his hand, and put it upon Joseph's hand, and arrayed him in vestures of fine linen, and put a gold chain about his neck; And he made him to ride in the second chariot which he had; and they cried before him, Bow the knee: and he made him ruler over all the land of Egypt. And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, Lam Pharaoh, and without thee shall no man lift up his hand or foot in all the land of Egypt. (Genesis 41:15/38-41)

The Day of Trumpets Joshua



Joshua at Jericho The Feast of Unleavened Bread

 And the children of Israel encamped in Gilgal, and kept the Passover on the fourteenth day of the month at even in the plains of Jericho. And they did eat of the old corn of the land on the morrow after the passover, unleavened cakes, and parched corn in the selfsame day. And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and, behold, there stood a man over against him with his sword drawn in his hand: and Joshua went unto him, and said unto him, Art thou for us, or for our adversaries? And he said, Nay; but as captain of the host of יהוה am I now come. And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and did worship... And יהוה said unto Joshua, See, I have given into thine hand Jericho, and the king thereof, and the mighty men of valour. And ye shall compass the city, all ye men of war, and go round about the city once. Thus shalt thou do six days... and the seventh day ye shall compass the city seven times, and the priests shall blow with the trumpets. (Joshua 5:10-11/13-14; 6:2-4)

Joshua and Jericho – Day One

- Now Jericho was straitly shut up... none went out, and none came in... And Joshua the son of Nun called the priests, and said unto them, Take up the ark of the covenant, and let seven priests bear seven jubilee trumpets before the ark of יהוה...And Joshua had commanded the people, saying, Ye shall not shout, nor make any noise with your voice, neither shall any word proceed out of your mouth, until the day I bid you shout; then shall ye shout...And seven priests bearing seven jubilee trumpets before the ark of יהוה went on continually, and blew with the trumpets: and the armed men went before them; but the <u>multitude</u> came after the ark of יהוה, the priests going on, and blowing with the trumpets. (Joshua 6:1/6/10/13)
 - Jubilee (H3104, yobel), Jubilee (KJV has ram's horns)
 - Multitude (H622), better word to understand than rereward

Joshua and Jericho The Seventh Day

- And the second day they compassed the city once, and returned into the camp: so they did six days. And it came to pass on the seventh day, that they rose early about the dawning of the day, and compassed the city after the same manner seven times: only on that day they compassed the city seven times. And it came to pass at the seventh time, when the priests blew with the trumpets, Joshua said unto the people, Shout; for יהוה hath given you the city. And the city shall be accursed, even it, and all that are therein, to יהוה: only Rahab the harlot shall live, she and all that are with her in the house, because she hid the messengers that we sent... But all the silver, and gold, and vessels of brass and iron, are consecrated unto יהוה: they shall come into the treasury of יהוה. (Joshua 6:14-17/19)
- The 7th Day of Unleavened Bread has a final fulfillment of the 7th Millennium, which starts at the Day of Trumpets (see "The Feast of Unleavened Bread" study)

The Day of Trumpets Daniel





Daniel and King Nebuchadnezzar

- But there is a Elohiym in heaven that revealeth secrets, and maketh known to the king Nebuchadnezzar what shall be in the latter days...Thou, O king, sawest, and behold a great image. This great image, whose brightness was excellent, stood before thee; and the form thereof was terrible. This image's <u>head was of fine gold</u>, his <u>breast and his arms of silver</u>, his <u>belly and his thighs of brass</u>, His <u>legs of iron</u>, his feet part of iron and part of clay. (Daniel 2:28/31-33)
 - Gold (Babylon Daniel 2:38)
 - Silver (Persia Daniel 2:39)
 - Brass (Greece Daniel 2:39)
 - Iron (Rome Daniel 2:40)
 - Iron and Clay (The Beast, Babylon the Great Daniel 2:41-43, ...we are the clay, and Thou our potter... -Isaiah 64:8)
- But <u>all the silver</u>, and <u>gold</u>, and <u>vessels of brass and iron</u>, are consecrated unto יהוה: <u>they shall come into the treasury of</u>.
 (Joshua 6:19)

The Day of Trumpets Just Left Babylon

And when the seventh month was come, and the children of Israel were in the cities, the people gathered themselves together as one man to Jerusalem. Then stood up Yeshua the son of Jozadak, and his brethren the priests, and Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and his brethren, and builded the altar of the Elohiym of Israel, to offer burnt offerings thereon, as it is written in the law of Moses the man of Elohiym... From the first day of the seventh month began they to offer burnt offerings unto the יהוה But the foundation of the temple of the יהוה was not yet laid. (Ezra 3:1-

2/6)

The Day of Trumpets Worshipping Our Father

 And <u>all the people gathered themselves together as one man</u> into the street that was before the water gate; and they spake unto Ezra the scribe to bring the book of the law of Moses, which the יהוה had commanded to Israel. And Ezra the priest brought the law before the congregation both of men and women, and all that could hear with understanding, upon the first day of the seventh month. And he read therein before the street that was before the water gate from the morning until midday...and the ears of all the people were attentive unto the book of the law... And Ezra opened the book... and when he opened it, all the people stood up: And Ezra blessed the יהוה, the great Elohiym. And all the people answered, Amein, Amein, with lifting up their hands: and they bowed their heads, and worshipped the יהוה with their faces to the ground... Also Yeshua... and the Levites, caused the people to understand **the law** (Nehemiah 8:1-3/5-7)


The Day of Trumpets A Celebration!

 This day is Set Apart unto יהוה your Elohiym; mourn not, nor weep...Then Nehemiah said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is Set Apart unto our Adonai: neither be ye sorry; for the joy of the <u>is your strength</u>. And all the people went their way to eat, and to drink, and to send portions, and to make great mirth, because they had understood the words that were declared unto them. (Nehemiah 8:10-12)

A Great Wonder in Heaven

- And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars: And she being with child <u>cried</u>, travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered. (Revelation 12:1-2)
 - "cried": krazō (H2896, κράζει), defined as to "croak" (as a raven) or scream, to call aloud (shriek, exclaim, intreat)
 - Probable Day of Trumpets Fulfillment: The heavens announce the birth of יהושע Messiah
- The sceptre shall not depart from <u>Judah</u>, nor a <u>lawgiver from</u> <u>between his feet</u>, <u>until Shiloh come</u>; and unto him the gathering of the people (Genesis 49:10)

The Day of Trumpets: Summary (so far)

- A day the floods and destruction of the earth began to recede (Noah)
- A day that Abram reached up in faith, was blessed, told to go to a promised land, and was given the pure language (Abraham)
- A day that Levi and Judah were blessed to have the seed of judges princes, and chiefs being close to יהוה, and the Messiah with salvation and a great kingdom (Isaac, Jacob, Levi, and Judah)
- A day that delivered Joseph from prison and elevated him to second in the kingdom (Joseph)
- A day and a law to be kept forever (Moses)
- A day with a future fulfillment shadowed by the destruction of Jericho just after the children of Israel entered the promised land (Joshua)
- A day for great celebrations (David)
- A day that the children of Israel, after just leaving Babylon, gather in Jerusalem and build the altar of Elohiym (Yeshua the son of Yozedek)
- A day that the people worshipped יהוה, heard the law, were given understanding of it, and celebrated (Ezra and Nehemia)

Messiah's Words – Day of Trumpets

- For I came down from heaven, not to do Mine own will, but the will of Him that sent Me. And this is the Father's will which hath sent Me, that of all which He hath given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day. And this is the will of Him that sent Me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on Him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day. (John 6:38-40)
- No man can come to Me, except the Father which hath sent Me draw him: and <u>I will raise him up at the last</u> <u>day</u>. (John 6:44)
- These things said He in the synagogue, as He taught in Capernaum. (John 6:59)*

^{*} Note: This Sabbath was either the one preceding, or possibly on The Day of Trumpets



Day of Trumpets Coming With The Clouds

- Immediately after the tribulation of those days...And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And He shall send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other. (Matthew 24:29-31)
- And when He had spoken these things, while they beheld, He was taken up; and a cloud received Him out of their sight. And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel; Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same יהושע, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen Him go into heaven. (Acts 1:9-11)
- Behold, He cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see Him, and they also which pierced Him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of Him. (Revelation 1:7)

The Day of Trumpets The Day of Shouting

- For as in Adam all die, even so in Messiah shall all be made alive.
 But every man in his own order: Messiah the firstfruits; afterward
 they that are Messiah's at His coming. (1 Corinthians 15:22-23)
- For this we say unto you by the word of Messiah, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of Messiah shall not prevent them which are asleep. For Messiah Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of Elohiym: and the dead in Messiah shall rise first:
 Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet Messiah in the air: and so shall we ever be with Messiah. (1 Thessalonians 4:15-17)
- Beloved, now are we the sons of Elohiym, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when He shall appear, we shall be like Him; for we shall see Him as He is. (1 John 3:2)

The Day of Trumpets Glory!

- When Messiah, who is our life, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory. (Colossians 3:4)
- And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, <u>ye shall receive a</u>
 <u>crown of glory that fadeth not away</u>. (1 Peter 5:4)
- And to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, יהושע, which delivered us from the wrath to come. (1 Thessalonians 1:10)
- Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. (1 Corinthians 15:51-52)
 - When is "the last trump"? At The Last (7th) Trumpet at the end of the great tribulation (before the vials of wrath)!
 - There is NO pre-tribulation rapture

The Day of Trumpets Daniel's Vision

 And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book. And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever. (Daniel 12:1-3)

The Day of Trumpets There Are Two Resurrections

- And יהוה spake unto Moses, saying, Make thee two trumpets of silver; of a whole piece shalt thou make them: that thou mayest use them for the calling of the assembly, and for the journeying of the camps. And when they shall blow with them, all the assembly shall assemble themselves to thee at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. And if they blow with one, then the princes, heads of the thousands of Israel, shall gather themselves unto thee. (Numbers 10:1-4)
- Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which <u>all that are in</u>
 the graves shall hear <u>His voice</u>, And shall come forth; <u>they that have</u>
 done good, unto the resurrection of life; and <u>they that have done</u>
 evil, unto the resurrection of damnation. (John 5:28-29)
- The first Day of Trumpets resurrection is only for the righteous and faithful, called to be princes, judges, and priests in His Millennial Kingdom.
- The second Day of Trumpets resurrection is for all remaining mankind

The Day of Trumpets Very Close Future Fulfillment!!

- The Fall Feasts are the prophetic shadow pictures of the events of His Second Coming
- The "last trump" is the Seventh (last) Trumpet in Revelation
- The Seventh Trumpet is the ending of the Great Tribulation (just after the Seven Thunders)
- The Seventh Trumpet is the beginning of the Wrath of Elohiym
- Messiah's Second Coming is announced by an archangel's shout (The Day of Shouting) and the trumpet of Elohiym (Day of Trumpets)
- The righteous and faithful receive incorruptible bodies and are brought by angels up to meet Messiah in the air
- His Second Coming to collect the righteous and faithful is only a surprise to those that have not prepared

Day of Trumpets Dominion of the Earth

- And the <u>seventh angel sounded</u>; and <u>there were great voices in heaven</u>, saying, <u>The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Adonai, and of His Messiah; and He shall reign for ever and ever</u>. And the four and twenty elders, which sat before El on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshipped El, Saying, <u>We give thee thanks</u>, O Adonai El Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because Thou hast taken to Thee Thy great power, and hast reigned. (Revelation 11:15-17)
- This image's head was of fine gold, his breast and his arms of silver, his belly and his thighs of brass, His legs of iron, his feet part of iron and part of clay. Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet that were of iron and clay, and brake them to pieces...and the stone that smote the image became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth. (Daniel 2:32-34)
- But <u>all the silver</u>, and <u>gold</u>, and <u>vessels of brass and iron</u>, are consecrated unto יהוה: <u>they shall come into the treasury of</u>.
 (Joshua 6:19)
