The Days of Judgement

- Lo, <u>thou trustest in the staff of this broken</u> reed, on Egypt; whereon <u>if a man lean, it will</u> go into his hand, and pierce it: <u>so is Pharaoh</u> king of Egypt to all that trust in him. (Isaiah 36:6)
- As for us, our eyes as yet failed for our vain help: in our watching <u>we have watched for a</u> <u>nation that could not save us</u>. <u>They hunt our</u> <u>steps</u>, that <u>we cannot go in our streets</u>: <u>our</u> <u>end is near, our days are fulfilled; for our</u> <u>end is come</u>. (Lamentations 4:17-18)




Come Out of Babylon


Go to the Wilderness

- Escape for thy life; look not behind thee, neither stay thou in all the plain; escape to the mountain, lest thou be consumed. (Genesis 19:17)



Take Up Your Cross

- Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you: But rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Messiah's sufferings; that, when His glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy. (1 Peter 4:12-13)
- ...<u>If any man will come after me, let him deny</u> <u>himself, and take up his cross, and follow me</u>. For <u>whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and</u> <u>whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall</u> <u>find it</u>. For <u>what is a man profited</u>, if he shall gain <u>the whole world</u>, and lose his own soul? or <u>what</u> <u>shall a man give in exchange for his soul</u>? (Matthew 16:24-26)

We Are THE Chosen Generation

- But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a set apart nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of Him who hath called you out of darkness into His marvellous light: Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of Elohiym; which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy. (1 Peter 2:9-10)
- ...<u>remember ye the words</u> which were spoken before of the apostles of our Adonai יהושע Messiah; How that <u>they told you there should be</u> <u>mockers in the last time</u>... (Jude 1:17-18)

Rewarded for Heeding His Call

- Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I
 <u>came not to send peace, but a sword</u>. For I am
 come to set a man at variance against his father, and
 the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in
 <u>law against her mother in law</u>. (Matthew 10:34-35)
- And <u>every one that hath forsaken houses, or</u> brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for My name's sake, shall receive an hundredfold, and shall inherit everlasting life. (Matthew 19:29)
- …Elohiym... may give unto you the spirit... <u>that ye</u> <u>may know what is the hope of His calling, and</u> <u>what the riches of the glory of His inheritance in</u> <u>the saints</u> (Ephesians 1:17-18)

Saints... Assemble!

Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for He is faithful that promised;) And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching. (Hebrews 10:23-25)

Community Blessings

 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! It is like the precious oil upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard: that went down to the skirts of his garments; As the dew of Hermon, and as the dew that descended upon the mountains of Zion: for **there** יהוה <u>commanded the blessing, even life for</u> evermore. (Psalm 133:1-3)

Gather Together in His Name

- Again I say unto you, That <u>if two of you shall</u> agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of My Father which is in heaven. For where two or three are gathered together in My name, there am I in the midst of them. (Matthew 18:19-20)
- ...<u>woe to him that is alone when he falleth;</u> for he hath not another to help him up. (Ecclesiastes 4:10)

"I will bring you into the bond of the covenant"

 Behold, the days come, saith יהוה, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel. and with the house of Judah: Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which My covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith יהוה: But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those <u>days, saith יהוה, I will put My law in their inward</u> parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their Elohiym, and they shall be My people. (Jeremiah 31:31-33

Messiah's Two Greatest Commandments...

 And one of the scribes...asked him, Which is the first commandment of all? And יהושע answered him, The first of all the commandments is, **Hear**, **O Israel; יהוה our Elohiym is one יהוה** And: <u>thou shalt love יהוה thy Elohiym with all thy</u> heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these. (Mark 12:28-31)

Love Thy Neighbor As Thyself

- Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Messiah. (Galatians 6:2)
- With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, <u>forbearing one another in love;</u> Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. (Ephesians 4:2-3)
- And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as Elohiym for Messiah's sake hath forgiven you. (Ephesians 4:32)

Share with the Needy

- ...And sold their possessions and goods, and parted them to all men, as every man had need. And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart, (Acts 2:42/45-46)
- Distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality. (Romans 12:13)
- ...undefiled before Elohiym and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world. (James 1:27)

BLESSING BOX Take what you need. Bring what you can. Above all be blessed!

Long-Suffering

- ...<u>avenge not yourselves</u>, but rather give place unto wrath: for <u>it is written</u>, Vengeance is Mine; I will repay, saith יהוה. (Romans 12:19)
- Do all things without murmurings and disputings: <u>That ye may be blameless and harmless</u>, the <u>sons of Elohiym, without rebuke, in the midst</u> <u>of a crooked and perverse nation</u>, among whom ye shine as lights in the world; (Philippians 2:15)
- ...<u>the righteous judgment of Elohiym; Who will</u> render to every man according to his deeds: To them who by patient continuance in well doing seek for glory and honour and immortality, eternal life (Romans 2:5-7)

Lift Each Other Up

- And whether <u>one member suffer, all the members</u> <u>suffer with it</u>; or <u>one member be honoured, all the</u> <u>members rejoice with it</u>. Now ye are the body of Messiah, and members in particular. (1 Corinthians 12:26-27)
- <u>We then that are strong ought to bear the</u> <u>infirmities of the weak</u>, and not to please ourselves. Let every one of us please his neighbour for his good to edification. (Romans 15:1-2)
- A friend loveth at all times, and a brother is born for adversity. (Proverbs 17:17)

Speak Truth

- Wherefore putting away lying, <u>speak every man</u> <u>truth with his neighbour: for we are members one</u> <u>of another</u>. (Ephesians 4:25)
- Let him that stole steal no more: but rather <u>let him</u> <u>labour</u>, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth. (Ephesians 4:28)
- Let <u>no corrupt communication</u> proceed out of your mouth, but <u>that which is good to the use of</u> <u>edifying, that it may minister grace unto the</u> <u>hearers</u>. (Ephesians 4:29)
- Iron sharpeneth iron; <u>so a man sharpeneth the</u> <u>countenance of his friend</u>. (Proverbs 27:17)

Be United in Righteousness

- Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Adonai יהושע Messiah, that <u>ye all speak the</u> <u>same thing, and that there be no divisions</u> <u>among you; but that ye be perfectly joined</u> <u>together in the same mind and in the same</u> judgment. (1 Corinthians 1:10)
- For as <u>the body is one, and hath many</u> <u>members</u>, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Messiah. (1 Corinthians 12:12)

Mercy, Kindness, and Peace

 Put on therefore, as the elect of Elohiym, set apart and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering; Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Messiah forgave you, so also do ye. And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness. And let the peace of Elohiym rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful. (Colossians 3:12-15)

Charity

 And above all things <u>have fervent charity among</u> yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins. Use hospitality one to another without grudging. As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of Elohiym. If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of Elohiym; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which Elohiym giveth: that Elohiym in all things may be glorified through יהושע Messiah, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever. (1 Peter 4:8-11)

Pray and Give Thanks

- ... be at peace among yourselves. Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all men. See that none render evil for evil unto any man; but ever follow that which is good, both among yourselves, and to all men. Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing. In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of Elohiym in Messiah יהושע concerning you. (1 Thessalonians 5:13-18)
- Confess your faults one to another, and <u>pray one</u> for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much. (James 5:16)



Learn From the Past

 For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope. Now the Elohiym of patience and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to Messiah יהושע: <u>That ye may with one mind and</u> one mouth glorify Elohiym, even the Father of our Adonai יהושע Messiah. Wherefore receive ye one another, as Messiah also received us to the glory of Elohiym. (Romans 15:2-7)

...Are in The Torah

- Hear, O Israel: יהוה our Elohiym is one יהוה:
 And thou shalt love יהוה thy Elohiym with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. (Deuteronomy 6:4-5)
- Thou shalt not hate thy brother in thine heart: <u>thou shalt in any wise rebuke thy neighbour, and</u> <u>not suffer sin upon him</u>. Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but <u>thou shalt love thy neighbour as</u> <u>thyself</u>: I am ...(Leviticus 19:17-18)
- All the Torah and the prophets are hung on these two commandments. (Matthew 22:40 – Sepharad Hebrew)

 Our Father who is in heaven, let Your name be sanctified for it is Set Apart and let Your kingdom come. Do Your will in the heavens and on the earth. Give us bread every day, that it may support our lives. And let go our guilts for us, for we let our guilty ones go. And do not lead us into testing, but keep us from all wickedness. Amein. (Matthew 6:9-13, Hebrew Sepharad)

- Our Father who is in heaven, let Your name be sanctified, for it is Set Apart
 - He sent redemption unto His people: He hath commanded His covenant for ever: Set Apart and reverend is His name. (Psalm 111:9)
 - <u>The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of יהוה come: And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of יהוה shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as hath said and in the remnant whom יהוה shall call</u>. (Joel 2:31-32)(also Acts 2:20-21)(also Romans 10:13)
 - <u>He restoreth my soul: He leadeth me in the paths of</u> righteousness for His name's sake. (Psalm 23:3)

- and let Your kingdom come.
 - ...there were great voices in heaven, saying, <u>The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Adonai, and of His Messiah;</u>
 and He shall reign for ever and ever. (Revelation 11:15)
 - ...Behold, the tabernacle of Elohiym is with men, and <u>He will dwell with them, and they shall be</u> <u>His people, and Elohiym Himself shall be with</u> <u>them, and be their Elohiym</u>. (Revelation 21:3)

- Do Your will in the heavens and on the earth.
 - And we know that <u>all things work together for good to</u> <u>them that love Elohiym</u>, to them who are the called according to His purpose. (Romans 8:28)
 - I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, <u>Hallelu-YAH</u>; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto יהוה our Elohiym: <u>For true and righteous</u> <u>are His judgments</u>... (Revelation 19:1-2)
 - And Elohiym shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. And He that sat upon the throne said, **Behold, I make all things new**. (Revelation 21:4-5)

- Give us bread every day, that it may support our lives.
 - It is written, <u>Man shall not live by bread alone, but by</u> <u>every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of</u> <u>Elohiym</u>. (Matthew 4:4)
 - And He humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that He might make thee know that <u>man doth not live by bread only, but by every word</u> <u>that proceedeth out of the mouth of man live</u>. (Deuteronomy 8:3)
 - And did all eat the same spiritual meat; (1 Corinthians 10:3)
 - I am the bread of life: he that cometh to Me shall never hunger... (John 6:35)

- And let go our guilts for us, for we let our guilty ones go.
 - Then came Peter to him, and said, Adonai, <u>how oft</u> shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him?
 till seven times? יהושע saith unto him, <u>I say not unto</u> thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times
 <u>seven</u>. (Matthew 18:21-22)
 - For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses. (Matthew 6:14-15)

- And do not lead us into testing, but keep us from all wickedness. Amein.
 - Our soul is escaped as a bird out of the snare of the fowlers: the snare is broken, and we are escaped. Our help is in the name of יהוה, who made heaven and earth. (Psalm 124:7-8)
 - But let all those that put their trust in Thee rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because Thou defendest them: let them also that love Thy name be joyful in Thee. For Thou יהוה, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt Thou compass him as with a shield. (Psalm 5:11-12)
 - Yea, <u>though I walk through the valley of the shadow</u>
 <u>of death, I will fear no evil: for Thou art with me</u>; Thy rod and Thy staff they comfort me. (Psalm 23:4)
