- And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and **think to change times and laws**... (Daniel 7:25)

Lunar Calendar

- Used by pre-Gregorian civilizations led by pagan/ satanic religious systems
 - Babylon
 - Ancient Egypt (changed to a solar calendar)
 - Ancient Greece/ Roman
 - Eastern religions
 - Hindus
 - Buddhists (Chinese calendar)
 - Tibetans
- Still used by Buddhists for religious dates (year of the dragon/rat/etc)
- Still used by Hindus for religious dates
- Used today by Islam (Saudi Arabia)
- Used today by modern Judaism (Israel)

Pagan Religion Calendars

- The Islamic calendar is a lunar one: months begin when the first crescent of a new moon is sighted. Consequently, the Islamic year is 10 days shorter than the solar year and contains no intercalation, Ramadan migrates throughout the seasons. The Islamic day starts after sunset.
- The Greeks, as early as the time of Homer (8th century BC), appear to have been familiar with the division of the year into the twelve lunar months but no intercalary month or day is mentioned, with twelve months of 354 days. (Philip, Alexander (1921). The Calendar: Its history, structure and improvement. London, UK: Cambridge University Press. p. 7)
- The Hindu calendars have been in use in the Indian subcontinent since Vedic times, and remain in use by the Hindus all over the world, particularly to set Hindu festival dates. The Hindu calendar maintains the integrity of the lunar month, but inserts an extra full month by complex rules, once every 32–33 months, to ensure that the festivals and crop-related rituals fall in the appropriate season. 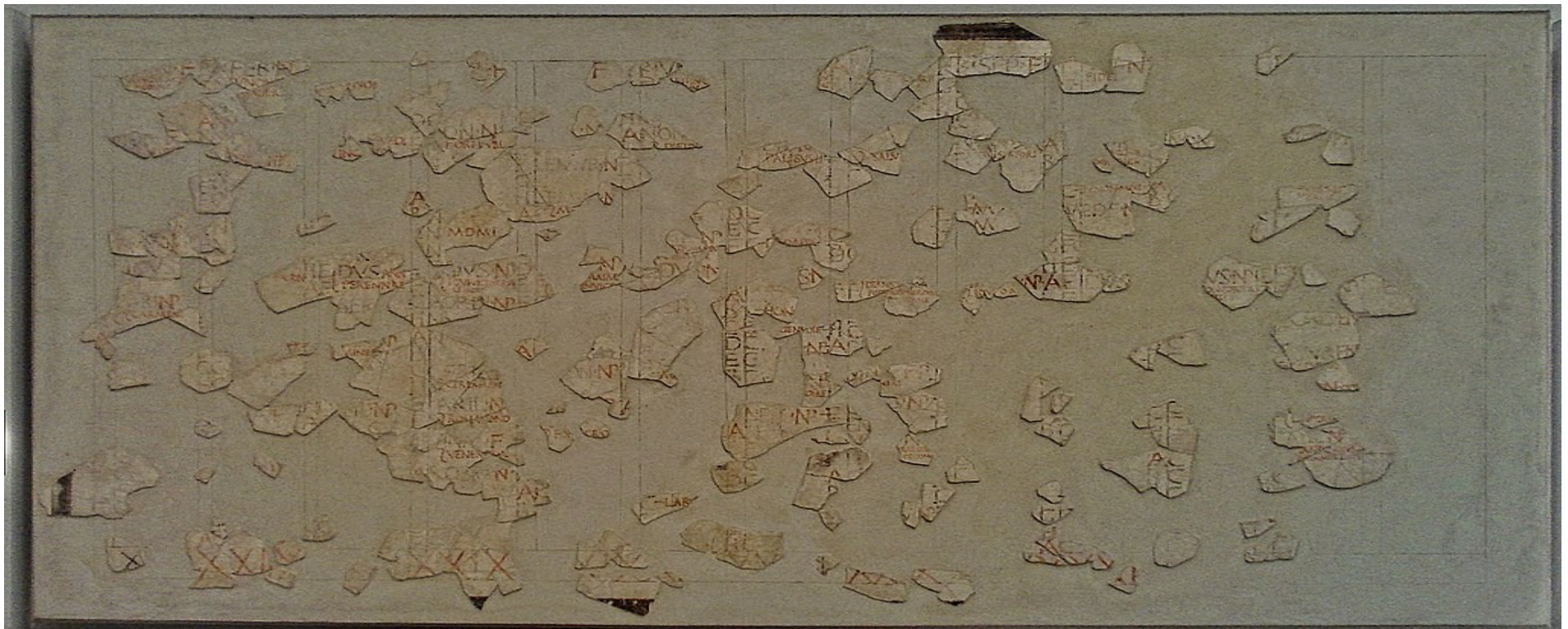
Pagan Religion Calendars

- Buddhist festivals continue to be scheduled according to a lunar system. (Anita Ganeri (2003). Buddhist Festivals Through the Year. BRB. pp. 11–12). The Buddhist and Jain timekeeping systems have attempted to use the Buddha and the Mahavira's lifetimes as their reference points. (Robert E. Buswell Jr.; Donald S. Lopez Jr. (2013). The Princeton Dictionary of Buddhism. Princeton University Press. p. 156)
- Far eastern countries used lunar calendars (China, Vietnam, Thailand, etc). They switched over to the Gregorian calendar in recent history for civil use but still use their lunar calendars to determine their religions' sacred days.
- Ancient Egypt at first had a lunar calendar. Egypt then moved to a solar calendar of 365 days (12 months of 30 days each and five extra intercalary days). The solar calendar incorporated their religion's sacred days

Ancient Roman/ Julian/ Gregorian

- "We have two measures of time, one annual which the sun bounds by its circuit, the other monthly which the moon embraces as it circles." (Varro, On Agriculture -I.27)

Ancient Roman/ Julian/ Gregorian Calendars

- The first Roman calendar is thought to have been developed by the first king (Romulus), with 10 lunar months (starting in the spring) and then an uncounted winter season (circa 750 BC)
- The second Roman king is thought to have added months 11 and 12.
- At some point between 750 and 50 BC, the number of days in some months changed, the beginning of the year was moved into winter (onto the previous 11th month), and an intercalary month was added.
- Julius Caesar developed the Julian calendar (45 BC) with 365 days and a leap year (one day) every four years
- The Gregorian calendar, proclaimed by Pope Gregory XIII, updated the leap years to more accurately track the solar years. This is the world's current standard civil calendar.

All From Babylon

- The Babylonian calendar was a lunisolar calendar with years consisting of 12 lunar months, each beginning when a new crescent moon was first sighted low on the western horizon at sunset, plus an intercalary month inserted as needed by decree. The calendar is based on a Sumerian (Third Dynasty of Ur) predecessor preserved in the Umma calendar of Shulgi (c. 21st century BC).

Warning: pagan info!

- Nanna was the the moon god. The moon was key to the Sumerian understanding of time; the first calendar, invented by the Sumerians, was designed around the phases of the moon, and Nanna was also revered as the god of time, the god who grants the wisdom to look upon the past and learn from it.

Ramadan and the Problem with the Islam Lunar Calendar

- Ramadan is the ninth month of the Islamic calendar. It begins once the new crescent moon appears in the sky, and ends after 29 or 30 days, depending on the moon cycle.
- “As the Islamic calendar goes by the sighting of the moon, Ramadan will fall roughly 10 days earlier each year in the Gregorian calendar and, thus, there is no exact time and date.”*

He Told Us That We Would Lose the Calendar...

- And I will hide My face from them, and I will deliver them into the hand of the Gentiles for captivity, and for a prey, and for devouring, and I will remove them from the midst of the land, and I will scatter them amongst the Gentiles. And they will forget all My Torah and all My commandments and all My judgments, and **will go astray as to new months, and Shabbats, and festivals, and jubilees, and ordinances.**
(Jubilees 1:13-14)

...By Calculating It From the Moon

- For I know and from henceforth will I declare it unto you, and **it is not of My own devising**; for the book is written before Me, and on the heavenly tablets the division of days is ordained, lest they forget the feasts of the covenant and walk according to the feasts of the Gentiles after their error and after their ignorance. For there will be those who will assuredly make observations of the moon-how it disturbs the seasons and comes in from year to year ten days too soon. (Jubilees 6:35-36)
 - For this reason the years will come upon them when they will disturb (the order), and make an abominable (day) the day of testimony, and an unclean day a feast day, and they will confound all the days, the kodesh with the unclean, and the unclean day with the kodesh; for they will go wrong as to the months and Shabbats and feasts and jubilees.
- (Jubilees 6:37)

Commanded to Testify

- For this reason I command and testify to you that you may testify to them; for after your death your children will disturb them, so that they will not make the year **three hundred and sixty-four days only**, and for this reason they will go wrong as to the new months and seasons and Sabbats and festivals, and they will eat all kinds of blood with all kinds of flesh. (Jubilees 6:38)
- Between 1947 and 1956, approximately **15 Jubilees scrolls were found** in five caves at Qumran, **all written in Hebrew**. The large number of manuscripts (more than for any biblical books except for Psalms, Deuteronomy, Isaiah, Exodus, and Genesis, in descending order) indicates that Jubilees was widely used at Qumran. A comparison of the Qumran texts with the Ethiopic version, found that the Ethiopic was in most respects an accurate and literalistic translation. (James VanderKam, "The Book of Jubilees" in L. H. Schiffman and J. C. VanderKam (eds.), Encyclopedia of the Dead Sea Scrolls, Oxford University Press (2000), Vol. I, p. 435.)

Jewish Rabbi on the Calendar

- Jews count the months by the moon; western civilization patterns its calendar after the sun. That presents a dilemma. The moon travels more slowly than the sun -- by approximately 48 minutes a day. At the beginning of the lunar month, she sets in the west shortly after sunset, and each day 40 to 45 minutes later. She continues to lag further and further behind the sun (each lunar month being 29-1/2 days) until, at the end of 12 months, the year of the moon is 11 days shorter than the year of the sun, every three years losing a full month of time.
- This introduces a special predicament for the religious calendar: **Passover needs to be celebrated at the vernal equinox -- springtime and harvest** are its natural hallmarks, the resuscitation of nature coinciding with the redemption of the people. But, if the lunar calendar loses a month every three years, Passover would move further each year and fall successively in every season of the year. That is exactly what happens to the Muslim festival of Ramadan.
- The **teachers of the Talmud made the adjustment** by adding seven leap months (called "Second Adar") in the course of each 19-year cycle, and thereby **ingeniously devised** a perpetual calendar that would keep the holidays in the **approximate season for which they were originally conceived.**

Passover is in the First Month of the Year

- And אףאל spake unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: **it shall be the first month of the year to you.** Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of **this month** they shall take to them every man a lamb... And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of **the same month**... For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt... And this day shall be unto you for a memorial; and ye shall keep it a feast to אףאל throughout your generations; ye shall keep it a feast by an ordinance for ever. (Exodus 12:1-3/6/12/14)
- Observe the month of **Abib**, and keep the Passover unto אףאל thy Elohiym: for in the month of Abib אףאל thy Elohiym brought thee forth out of Egypt by night. (Deuteronomy 16:1)
- Three times thou shalt keep a feast unto Me in the year. Thou shalt keep the feast of unleavened bread... **as I commanded thee**, in the time appointed of the month **Abib**... (Exodus 23:14-15)

Abib Is In the Spring

- And Moses stretched forth his rod toward heaven: and אֶפְרַיִם sent thunder and hail, and the fire ran along upon the ground; and אֶפְרַיִם rained hail upon the land of Egypt. So there was hail, and fire mingled with the hail, very grievous, such as there was none like it in all the land of Egypt since it became a nation... Only in the land of Goshen, where the children of Israel were, was there no hail... And the flax and the barley was smitten: for the barley was in the ear, and the flax was bolled. But the wheat and the rie were not smitten: for they were not grown up. (Exodus 9:23-24/31-32)
 - “in the ear” - 'ābîḇ (H24, אביב), defined as a young ear of grain
- In the fourteenth day of the first month at even is אֶפְרַיִם's Passover. And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread unto אֶפְרַיִם: seven days ye must eat unleavened bread... When ye... reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest: (Leviticus 23:5-6/10)

Abib Grain is Almost Mature

- When grains are early in their development they are flexible and have a dark green color. As they become ripe they take on a light yellowish hue and become more brittle. The reason that the barley was destroyed and the wheat was not is that the barley had reached the stage in its development called Abib and as a result had become brittle enough to be damaged by the hail. In contrast, the wheat and spelt were still early enough in their development, at a stage when they were flexible and not susceptible to being damaged by hail.

Messiah's Declarations to the Religious Leaders of Judaism

- Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves. (Matthew 23:15)
- Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are like unto whited sepulchres, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead men's bones, and of all uncleanness. The Flood Sinks the Lunar Calendar

- **Five months to the day** (2/17 to 7/17), **150 days**
 - In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, **in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month**, the same day were **all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened...And the waters prevailed upon the earth an hundred and fifty days**. (Genesis 7:11/24)
 - And on the new month of the fourth month the mouths of the depths of the abyss beneath were closed. And **on the new month of the seventh month** **all the mouths of the abysses of the earth were opened, and the waters began to descend into them**. (Jubilees 6:26)
 - And the waters returned from off the earth continually: **and after the end of the hundred and fifty days** **the waters were abated**. And the ark rested in **the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month**, upon the mountains of Ararat. (Genesis 8:3-4)

The Flood Sinks the Lunar Calendar (Septuagint - 2nd Witness)

- **Five months to the day** (2/27 to 7/27), **150 days**
 - In the six hundredth year of the life of Noe, **in the second month, on the twenty-seventh day of the month**, on this day all the fountains of the abyss were broken up, and the flood-gates of heaven were opened....**And the water was raised over the earth an hundred and fifty days**. (Genesis 7:11/24 - Sept)
 - And on the new month of the fourth month the mouths of the depths of the abyss beneath were closed. And **on the new month of the seventh month** **all the mouths of the abysses of the earth were opened, and the waters began to descend into them**. (Jubilees 6:26)
 - And the water subsided, and went off the earth, **and after an hundred and fifty days** **the water was diminished**, and the ark rested in **the seventh month, on the twenty-seventh day of the month**, on the mountains of Ararat. (Genesis 8:3 - Sept)

Any Lunar Calendar Fails the Genesis Flood Test

- A lunar calendar will have month lengths of 29 and 30 days, since each new moon is about 29 1/2 days apart*. No matter the year of the lunar calendar, it is impossible to ever have 150 days in 5 lunar months.
 - Month 2, 17th day to the end of the month (29th): 12 days
 - Month 3: 30 days
 - Month 4: 29 days
 - Month 5: 30 days
 - Month 6: 29 days
 - Month 7, 1st day to the 17th day: 17 days
- Total days in a lunar calendar (5 months): 147 days 
 - It can be 148 days if Month 2 starts with 30 days, or an “unsighted 29th day moon” but NO MORE

(14-15) Purim is celebrated on the 14th day of this month (and on Adar Bet in Hebrew leap years); that is, the day following the victory of the Jews over their Persian enemies. In cities that were protected by a surrounding wall, Purim is instead celebrated on the 15th of the month on what is known as Shushan Purim, since fighting in the walled city of Shushan continued one extra day. Today, only Jerusalem and a few other cities celebrate Purim on the 15th.						

The Revelation Great Tribulation Test

(The 2nd Witness)

- ...the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of Elohiym, and the altar, and them that worship therein. But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the set apart city shall they tread under foot **forty and two months**. And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy **a thousand two hundred and threescore days**, clothed in sackcloth. (Revelation 11:1-3)
 - Lunar calendar: (29.5 days/month) x 42 months = 1239 days 
 - THE calendar: (30 days/month) x 42 months = **1260 days** 
- ...the same horn made war with the saints, and prevailed against them... and they shall be given into his hand until **a time** and **times** and **the dividing of time**. (Daniel 7:21/25)
 - “a time” = 1 year, “times” = 2 years, “dividing of time” = ½ year
 - (1 year + 2 years + ½ year) x (12 months/year) = 42 months
 - THE calendar: (42 months) x (30 days/month) = **1260 days** 

Revelation (3rd Witness)

30 Day Months

- And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of Elohiym, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days. (Revelation 12:6)
- To be in sync with how Yah calculates time, we have to have a calendar with 30 days every month.
 - The Genesis Flood test: 150 days in 5 months
 - $(150 \text{ days}) / (5 \text{ months}) = 30 \text{ days/month}$
 - The Revelation Great Tribulation test:
 - $(1260 \text{ days}) / (42 \text{ months}) = 30 \text{ days/month}$

The Flood or Joshua's Long Day Did Not Change The Calendar

- Observe ye everything that takes place in the heaven, how **they do not change their orbits,** and the **luminaries which are in the heaven,** how they all rise and set in order each in its season, and **transgress not against their appointed order.** (Enoch 2:1-2)

An Example of Talmud Calendar Calculation Lunacy

- Based on a line in the Mishnah declaring that Purim must be celebrated in Adar II in a leap year (Megillah 1:4), Adar I is considered the "extra" month. As a result, someone born in Adar during a non leap year would celebrate their birthday in Adar II during a leap year. However, someone born during either Adar in a leap year will celebrate their birthday during Adar in a non-leap year, except that someone born on 30 Adar I will celebrate their birthday on 1 Nisan in a non-leap year because Adar in a non-leap year has only 29 days.

Calendar Deception Tactics

- Corrupting His inspired Word
- Creating poetic stories that tug on sentiment and emotions
- Using scripture out of context to bolster the created narrative
- Widespread acceptance among many of the most known teachers (the backup snare)



Month vs Moon

- “month”, chodesh (H2320, חדש)
- “moon”, yerach (H3394, ירח)
- The word of יָרַח which came unto Zephaniah... in the days of Josiah the son of Amon, king of Judah... Therefore wait ye upon Me, saith יָרַח, until the day that I rise up to the prey: for My determination is to gather the nations, that I may assemble the kingdoms, to pour upon them Mine indignation, even all My fierce anger: for all the earth shall be devoured with the fire of My jealousy. For then will I turn to the people a pure language, that **they may all call upon the name of יָרַח, to serve Him with one consent.**
(Zephaniah 1:1/3:8-9)
 - The Masoretic rewrites (~600-1000AD) completed the process of language twistings and entanglements
 - A pure language from יָרַח would be perfect and not use a completely different word (moon/ “yerach”) for a different event (month/ “chodesh”)

The Prophecy of the Corruption of the Word of אֱלֹהִים

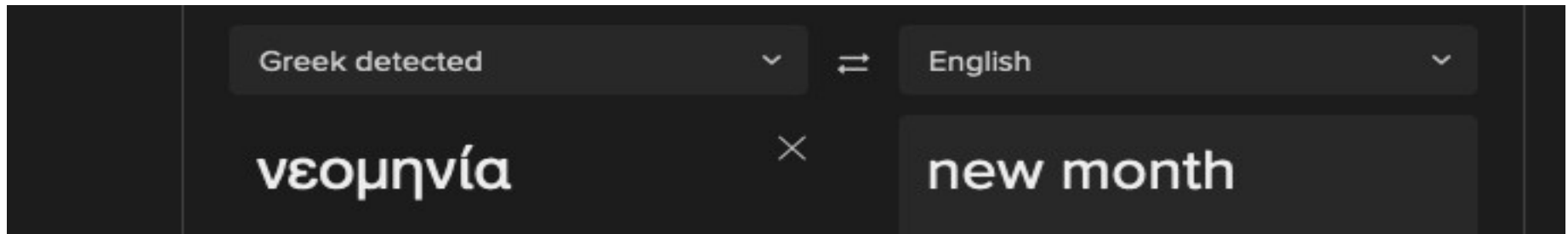

Paul Said New Months

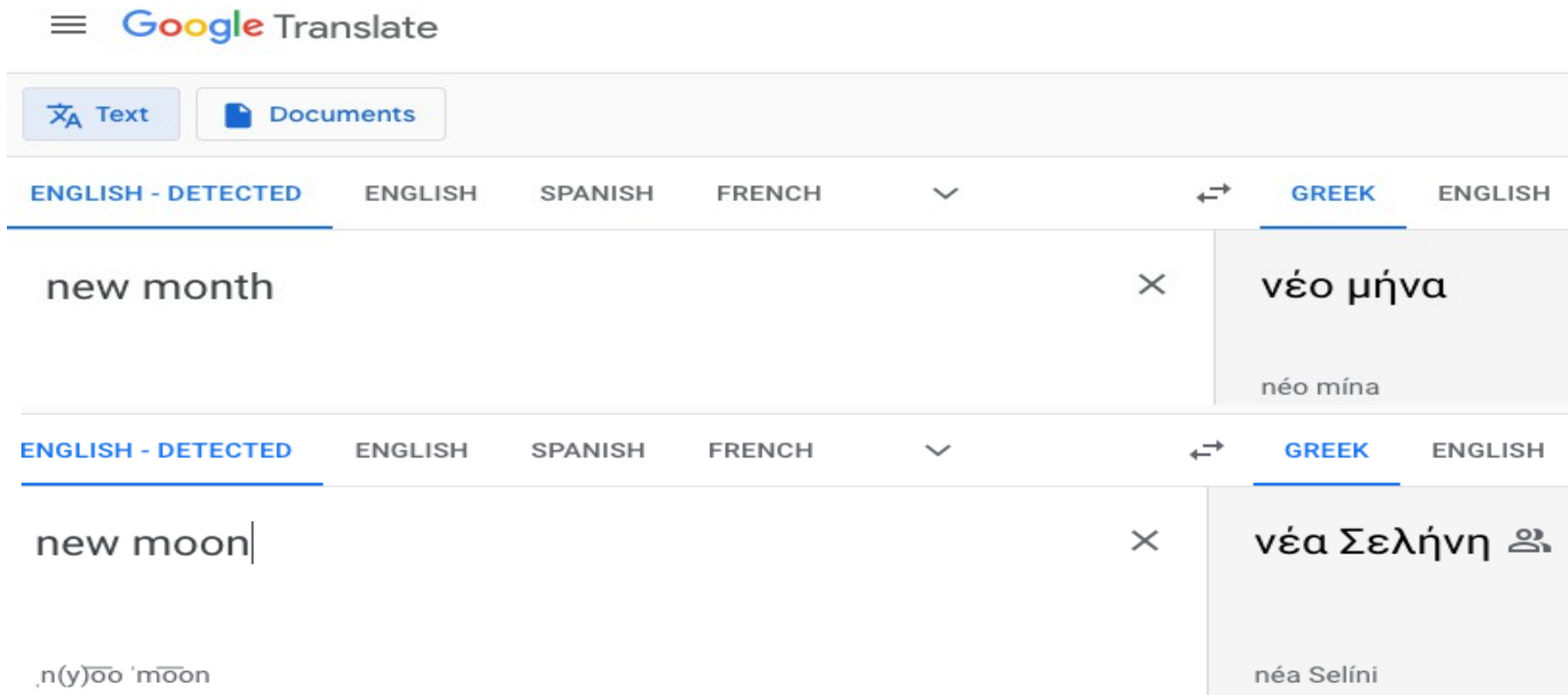
- Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new “moon” (neomēnia, G3561 νοιμηνίας), or of the Sabbath days: (Colossians 2:16 - KJV)
 - Strong's Concordance is not infallible (“**Take heed that no man deceive you.**” - Matthew 24:4)
 - Strong's definition for G3561 is the “festival of new moon”, but this is derived from Masoretic Scripture twisting of chodesh
 - Greek to English translators shows “νοιμηνίας” as “new month”

It's Month, Not Moon

- And David said unto Jonathan, Behold, to morrow is the “new moon” (*chodesh, H2320, שֶׁדֶּחַ*) ... (First Samuel 20:5 – KJV)
- Then Jonathan said to David, Tomorrow is the “new moon” (*chodesh, H2320, שֶׁדֶּחַ*) ... (First Samuel 20:18 – KJV)
- So David hid himself in the field: and when the “new moon” (*chodesh, H2320, שֶׁדֶּחַ*) was come... (First Samuel 20:24 – KJV)
- And he said, Wherefore wilt thou go to him to day? it is neither “new moon” (*chodesh, H2320, שֶׁדֶּחַ*), nor Sabbath. (2 Kings 4:23 – KJV)

It's Month, Not Moon

- Thus saith the Adon יהוה; The gate of the inner court that looketh toward the east shall be shut the six working days; but on the Sabbath it shall be opened, and in the day of the “new moon” (*month, chodesh, H2320, חדש*) it shall be opened. (Ezekiel 46:1 – KJV)
- Saying, When will the “new moon” (*month, chodesh, H2320, חדש*) be gone, that we may sell corn? and the Sabbath, that we may set forth wheat?... (Amos 8:5 – KJV)
- Blow up the trumpet in the “new moon” (*month, chodesh, H2320, חדש*), in the time appointed, on our solemn feast day. (Psalm 81:3 – KJV)
 - תקעו בחדש שופר בכסה ליום חגנו
 - חגנו (H7782 - שופר (H2320 – in month) בחדש (H8628 – you blow) תקעו (H7782 - shofar) ליום (H3117 – for day) בכסה (H3677 – in appointed) חגנו (H2282 – our feast)
 - Blow the shofar in the month appointed for our feast day

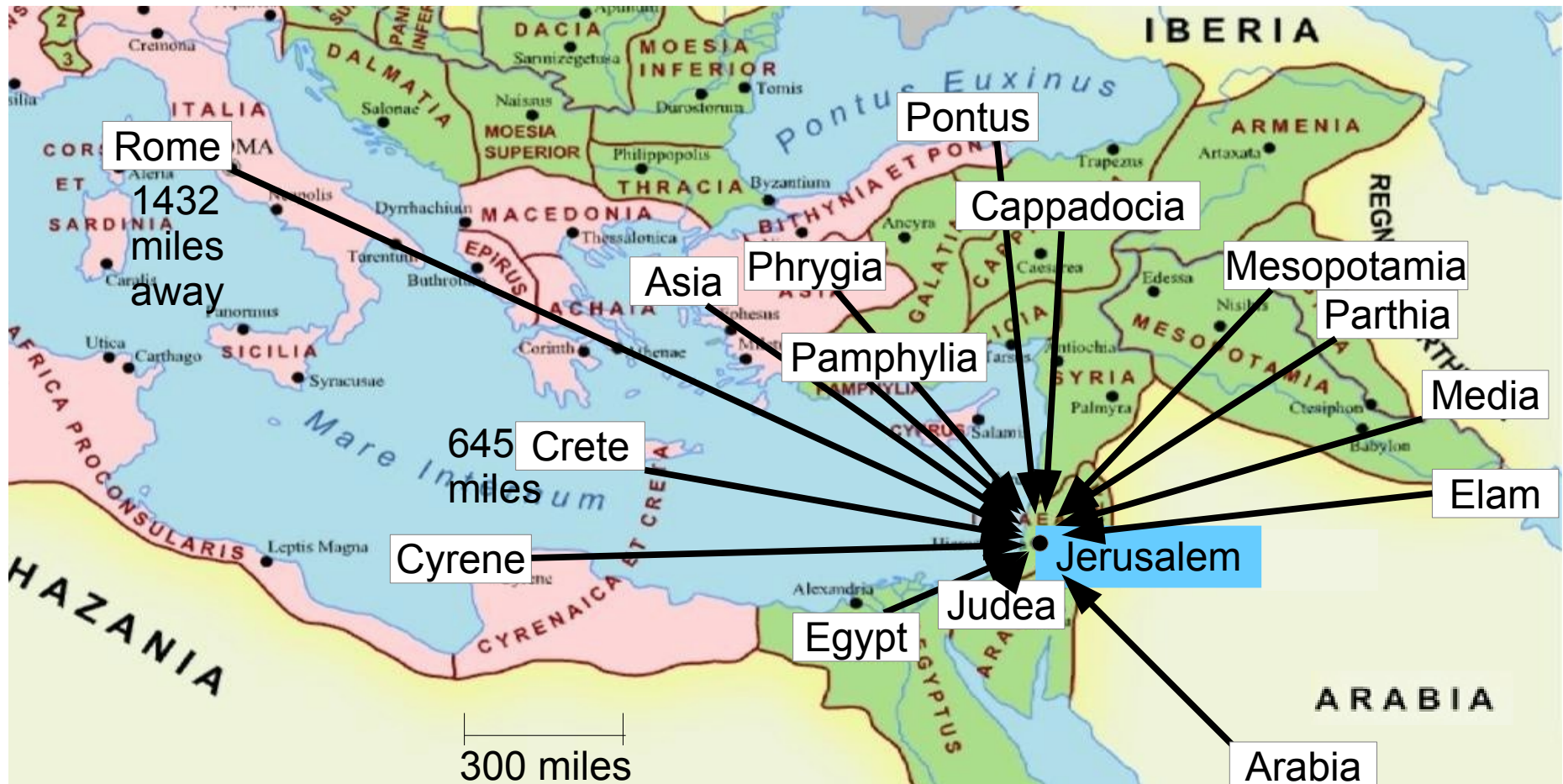
They Came From the Nations to Jerusalem for Shavuot

Six days shall work be done: but the seventh day is the Sabbath of rest, an set apart convocation... These are the feasts of $\aleph\aleph\aleph$, even set apart convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons. In the fourteenth day of the first month at even is the $\aleph\aleph\aleph$'s **Passover**. (Leviticus 23:2-4)

- “feasts” - moed (H4150, מועד), defined as **an appointment, a fixed time or season**, a signal, appointed (sign, time), (place of, solemn) assembly, congregation, (set, solemn) **feast**

A Day and Hour No One Knows

- ...they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And He shall send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other... **But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but My Father only.** (Matthew 24:29-31/36)
- ...they will forget all My Torah... and will go astray as to new months, and Shabbats, and **festivals... the children of Yisrael will forget and will not find the path of the years**, and will forget the new months, and seasons, and Shabbats and they will go wrong as to all the order of the years... after their error and after their ignorance. **For there will be those who will assuredly make observations of the moon... for they will go wrong as to the months and Shabbats and feasts... they will not make the year three hundred and sixty-four days only**, and for this reason they will go wrong as to the **new months** and seasons and Shabbats and **festivals...**
(Jubilees 1:14/6:34/36-38)

A Day and Hour Only the Groom's Father Knows

- But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but My Father only... For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage (Matthew 24:36/38)
- Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom... While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept. And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him. Then all those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps. (Matthew 25:1-7)



The Crime

- The rabbis completed the radical restructuring of Jewish thought and practice that followed the (Roman) destruction of the Temple, a “reinvention of of Judaism... They were closing an old world based on prophecy and angelic revelation and opening the sacred canon to human reinterpretation.” (Rachel Elijor, Hebrew University of Jerusalem)
- "To many of the Jews of the first millennium BCE, all the texts had been equally holy," she says. "The [excluded] Book of Enoch or Book of Jubilees were certainly not considered less sacred than the [canonical] Book of Judges or Daniel." Yet the excluded texts - close to a dozen major works - were not just abandoned but excised as if they were a malignant growth. "Whoever reads them," declared Rabbi Akiva, one of the foremost sages involved in the process, "will have no place in the world to come." (Rachel Elijor, Hebrew University of Jerusalem, Memory and Oblivion: The Mystery of the Dead Sea Scrolls)

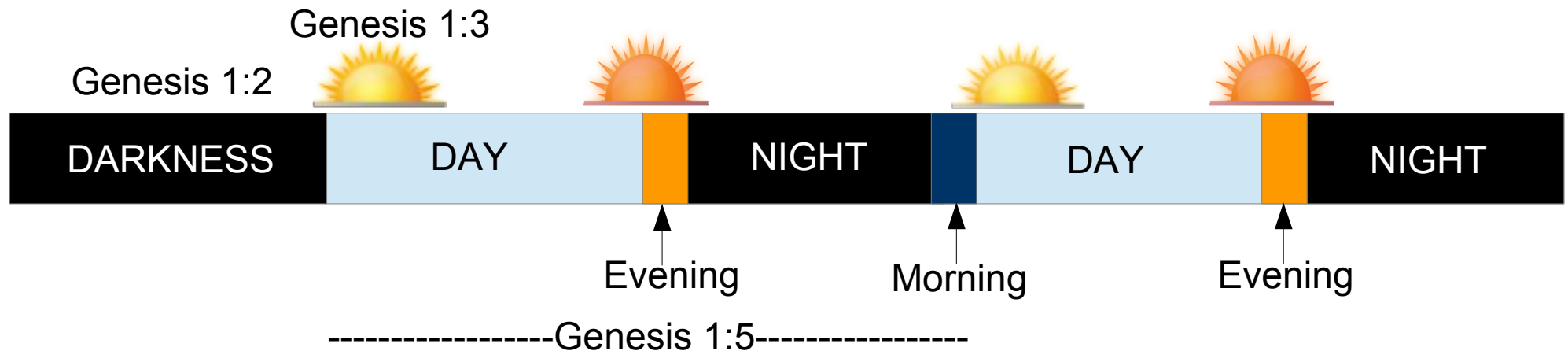
The Motivation

- The short reason for the canon/Apocrypha divide, was a dispute over the calendar. The more profound explanation involves a power struggle between the old priestly order that believed its rulings to be divinely inspired and an emerging class of rabbis espousing a different narrative, one which gave human reason and laws a role in shaping the religion. (Rachel Elijor, Hebrew University of Jerusalem)
- The rabbis favored a lunar calendar because they saw it symbolically freeing the nation from dependence on a closed priestly caste locked into the solar calendar and claiming divine authority. They wanted to symbolize instead man's share in the determination of time and of his own fate. "They declared that human understanding of sacred writings was a legitimate source of authority." **The month would now not commence according to a solar calendar pre-calculated for eternity but by mortals scanning the sky for the new moon, perhaps disagreeing about the sighting among themselves, perhaps even erring.** (Rachel Elijor, Hebrew University of Jerusalem)

The Day Begins With Light

- Genesis 1:5 (with “יהי” added to the verse translation – *missing from KJV and others*, two italic “gapped” words added for English clarity, and the extra intra-verse period (“.”) removed):

And Elohiym called *the* light Day and *the* darkness *He* called Night, and day became evening and night became morning were the first day. (Genesis 1:5)

Walking on the Sea of Galilee

And when even was now come, His disciples went down unto the sea, And entered into a ship, and went over the sea toward Capernaum. And it was now dark, and Jesus was not come to them. And the sea arose by reason of a great wind that blew. So when they had rowed about five and twenty or thirty furlongs, they see Jesus walking on the sea, and drawing nigh unto the ship: and they were afraid. But He saith unto them, **It is I; be not afraid.** Then they willingly received Him into the ship: and immediately the ship was at the land whither they went. The day following, when the people which stood on the other side of the sea saw that there was none other boat there, save that one where into His disciples were entered, and that Jesus went not with His disciples into the boat, but *that* His disciples were gone away alone; (John 6:16-22)



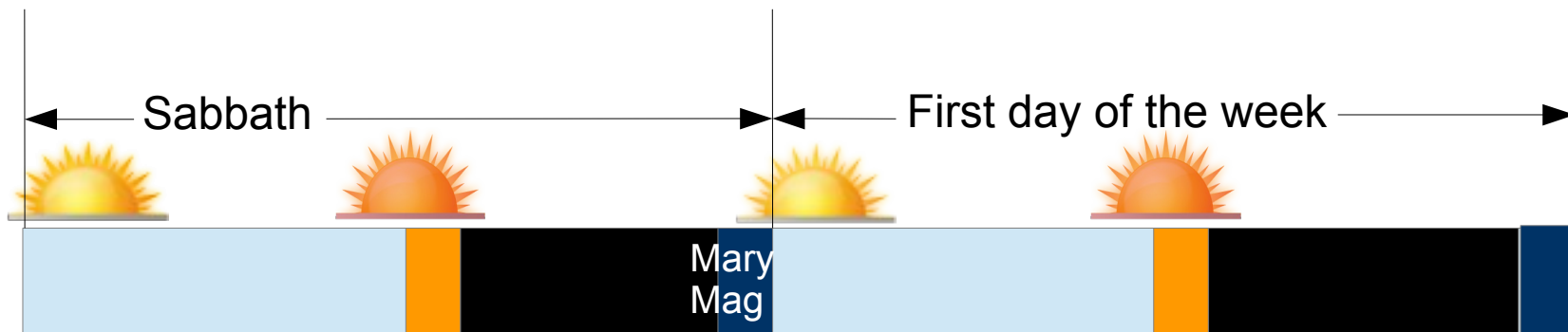

(Matthew 28:1)

- Side Note: This was the weekly Sabbath (7th day) and not the High Sabbath of the first Day of Unleavened Bread feast.

Other References to the Day Beginning at Sunrise

- “There can be no doubt that in pre-exilic times, the Israelites reckoned the day from morning to morning. The day began with the dawn and closed with the end of the night following it.”
(Jacob Callel Lauterbach, Rabbinic Essays, Cincinnati: Hebrew Union College Press, 1951 p. 446)
- “In Israel, the day was for a long time reckoned from morning to morning...and it was in fact in the morning, with the creation of light, that the world began; the distinction of day and night, and time too, began on a morning (Gen. 1:3-5, cf. 14:16, 18)... (Ancient Israel, p.181-182)
- “...In earlier tradition, a day apparently began at sunrise (e.g., Leviticus 7:15-17, Judges 19:4-19)(Oxford Companion to the Bible, p. 744)
- “When the Jews returned to Palestine after their Babylonian exile (516 B.C.E.) they brought back with them the Babylonian astronomy and way of reckoning time...” (What is a Jew, p. 108)

We Have Inherited Lies...

Teach Me Your Way

- O אֱלֹהֵי, my strength, and my fortress, and my refuge in the day of affliction, the Gentiles shall come unto Thee from the ends of the earth, and shall say, **Surely our fathers have inherited lies**, vanity, and things wherein there is no profit.
(Jeremiah 16:19)
- **Teach me Thy way, O אֱלֹהֵי; I will walk in Thy truth:** unite my heart to fear Thy name. (Psalm 86:11)

The Lunar Calendar

- Started in Babylon and has been used by all of the major pagan religions.
- Can not be biblical as it is not possible with any lunar calendar to meet any of the Biblical month timelines stated in Genesis, Daniel, and Revelation.
- Was “ingeniously updated” by the rabbis (Hillel II, etc.) to stay “somewhat” aligned with the harvest seasons and was used by the rabbis after the destruction of Jerusalem to replace the true calendar given by אֱלֹהִים to stay on-time for His appointed feasts.
- The calendar replacement was accomplished as part of the means to usurp religious authority away from the Levitical priesthood designated by אֱלֹהִים.
- Is not supported by about a dozen references in Scripture that shows a day begins at sunrise (see “When Does the Sabbath Begin?”)

I command and testify to you that you may testify to them...

- Following a lunar calendar and days that start at sunset affect when we keep the fourth commandment and the Feasts of $\aleph\aleph\aleph$:
 - Remember the Sabbath day, to **keep it set apart** (Exodus 20:8)
 - And sanctify My Sabbaths; and **they shall be a sign between Me and you**, that ye may know that I am $\aleph\aleph\aleph$ your Elohiym. (Ezekiel 20:20)
- **For there will be those who will assuredly make observations of the moon-how it disturbs the seasons and comes in from year to year ten days too soon.** For this reason the years will come upon them when they will disturb (the order), and make an abominable (day) the day of testimony, and an unclean day a feast day, and they will confound all the days, the kodesh with the unclean, and the unclean day with the kodesh; for they will go wrong as to the months and Shabbats and feasts and jubilees. (Jubilees 6:36-37)
- **Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.** (Revelation 18:4)
