# His Miracles Had Many Purposes

  - fulfill prophecy showing that He is the Messiah
  - grant healing requests from people with great faith
  - show mercy to the poor
  - teaching moments
  - show that man-made religious rules were null and void in the Kingdom of Heaven
  - set in motion the chain of events required for the consecration of the New Covenant

# The Children's Bread

- Then **ⲙⲁⲩⲁⲛⲓ** went thence, and departed into the coasts of Tyre and Sidon. And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto Him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Adon, thou Son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil. But He answered her not a word. And His disciples came and besought Him, saying, Send her away; for she crieth after us. But He answered and said, **I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel.** Then came she and worshipped Him, saying, Adon, help me. But He answered and said, **It is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast it to dogs.** And she said, Truth, Adon: **yet the dogs eat of the crumbs which fall from their masters' table.** Then **ⲙⲁⲩⲁⲛⲓ** answered and said unto her, **O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt.** And her daughter was made whole from that very hour. # The Living Bread

- I am that bread of life. Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead... I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever... (John 6:48-49/51)
- It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of El. (Matthew 4:4)
  - All the commandments which I command thee this day shall ye observe to do... And thou shalt remember all the way which  thy Elohiym led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep His commandments, or no. And He humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that He might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of  doth man live. (Deuteronomy 8:2-3)
- Give not that which is set apart unto the dogs, neither cast ye your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn again and rend you. (Matthew 7:6)

# Such Great Faith

- And when *ᵐᵂᶠᶺᶻ* was entered into Capernaum, there came unto Him a centurion, beseeching Him, And saying, Adon, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented. And *ᵐᵂᶠᶺᶻ* saith unto him, I will come and heal him. The centurion answered and said, Adon, I am not worthy that Thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed. For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it. When *ᵐᵂᶠᶺᶻ* heard it, **He marvelled**, and said to them that followed, **Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.** (Matthew 8:5-10)
- And *ᵐᵂᶠᶺᶻ* said unto the centurion, **Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee.** And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour. (Matthew 8:13)



# The Olive Tree Branches

- **And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven. But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.** (Matthew 8:11-12)
- For if the firstfruit be set apart, the lump is also set apart: and if the root be set apart, so are the branches. And if some of the branches be broken off, and thou, being a wild olive tree, wert grafted in among them, and with them partakest of the root and fatness of the olive tree; Boast not against the branches. But if thou boast, thou bearest not the root, but the root thee... Well; because of unbelief they were broken off, and thou standest by faith... if thou continue in his goodness: otherwise thou also shalt be cut off. And they also, if they abide not still in unbelief, shall be grafted in: for Elohiym is able to graft them in again. (Romans 11:16-18/20/22-23)

# Only Believe (in Him)

## (Miracle #15)

- And, behold, there cometh one of the rulers of the synagogue, Jairus by name; and when he saw Him, he fell at His feet, And besought Him greatly, saying, My little daughter lieth at the point of death: I pray thee, come and lay Thy hands on her, that she may be healed; and she shall live. And *⓪ⓂⓂⓂⓂ* went with him; and much people followed Him... there came from the ruler of the synagogue's house certain which said, Thy daughter is dead: why troublest thou the Master any further? As soon as *⓪ⓂⓂⓂⓂ* heard the word that was spoken, He saith unto the ruler of the synagogue, **Be not afraid, only believe.** And He suffered no man to follow him, save Peter, and James, and John the brother of James. (Mark 5:22-24/35-37)

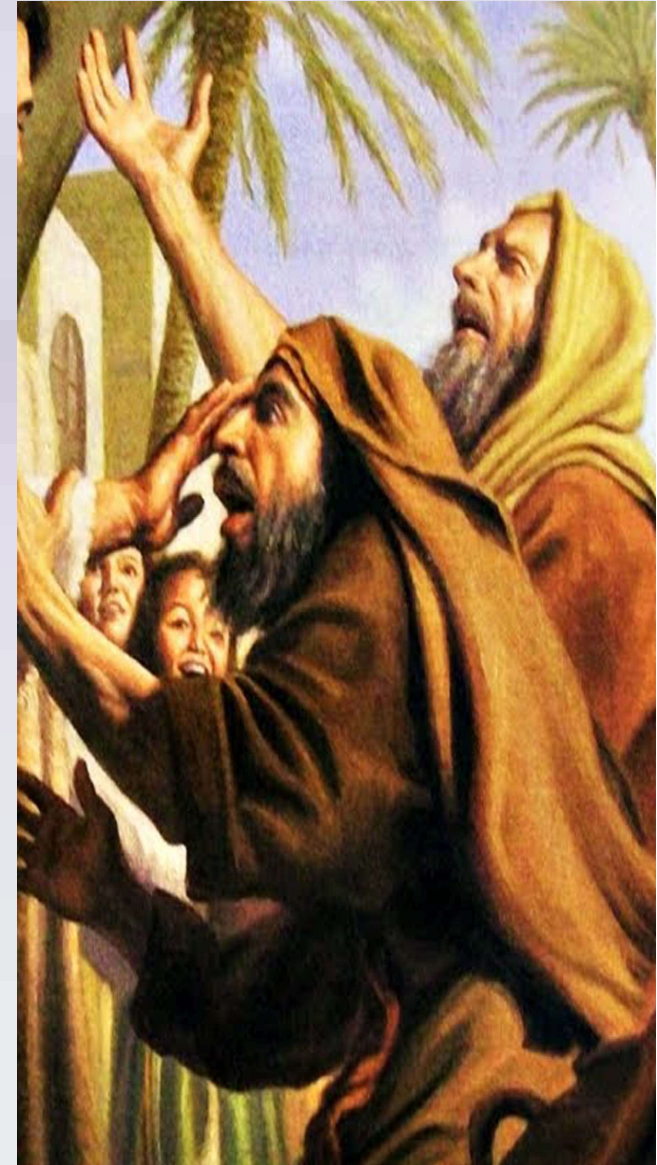
- And when  came into the ruler's house, and saw the minstrels and the people making a noise, He said unto them, Give place: for the maid is not dead, but sleepeth. And they laughed Him to scorn. But when the people were put forth, He went in, and took her by the hand, and the maid arose. (Matthew 9:23-25)



# Cry Out For Healing

## (Miracle #35)

- And as they departed from Jericho, a great multitude followed Him. And, behold, two blind men sitting by the way side, when they heard that אֵלֹהִים passed by, **cried out**, saying, Have mercy on us, O Adon, thou Son of David. And the multitude rebuked them, because they should hold their peace: but **they cried the more**, saying, Have mercy on us, O Adon, thou Son of David. And אֵלֹהִים stood still, and called them, and said, What will ye that I shall do unto you? They say unto Him, Adon, that our eyes may be opened. So אֵלֹהִים had compassion on them, and touched their eyes: and immediately their eyes received sight, and they followed Him. (Matthew 20:29-34)
- אֵלֹהִים my Elohiym, I cried unto Thee, and Thou hast healed me. (Psalm 30:2)



# Increase Our Faith

- And the apostles said unto Messiah, Increase our faith. And Messiah said, **If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.** (Luke 17:5-6)
- ...Truth I say unto you, **If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.** (Matthew 17:20)
-  answered and said unto them, **Verily I say unto you, If ye have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done. And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.** (Matthew 21:21-22)
- But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to Elohiym must believe that He is, and that **He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.** (Hebrews 11:6)

# A Mustard Tree...

- Then said He, **Unto what is the kingdom of El like? and whereunto shall I resemble it? It is like a grain of mustard seed, which a man took, and cast into his garden; and it grew, and waxed a great tree; and the fowls of the air lodged in the branches of it.** (Luke 13:18-19)



# ...Starts With A Seed

- And as Esaias said before, Except אִף־אֵל of Sabaoth had left us a seed, we had been as Sodoma, and been made like unto Gomorrha. (Romans 9:29)
  - Except אִף־אֵל of hosts had left unto us a very small remnant, we should have been as Sodom, and we should have been like unto Gomorrah. (Isaiah 1:9)
  - And if אִף־אֵל of Sabaoth had not left us a seed, we should have been as Sodom, and we should have been made like Gomorrha. (Isaiah 1:9, LXXE)

# The “Hem” of His Garment

- And when the men of that place had knowledge of Him, they sent out into all that country round about, and brought unto Him all that were diseased; And besought Him that they might only touch the **hem** of His garment: and as many as touched were made perfectly whole. (Matthew 14:35-36)
- Wherever He entered, into villages, or into cities, or into the country, they laid the sick in the marketplaces, and begged Him that they might touch just the **border** of His garment; and as many as touched Him were made well. (Mark 6:56)



# A Cord of Blue to Remember

- Thou shalt make thee fringes upon the four quarters of thy vesture, wherewith thou coverest thyself. (Deuteronomy 22:12)
- Speak to the children of Israel, and bid them that they make them fringes in the borders of their garments throughout their generations, and that they put on the fringe of each border a cord of blue: and it shall be to you for a fringe, that you may look on it, and remember all the commandments of אֶת־אֵלֶיךָ, and do them; and that you not follow after your own heart and your own eyes, after which you use to play the prostitute; That ye may remember, and do all My commandments, and be set apart unto your Elohiym.  
(Numbers 15:38-40)



# Unclean Ordinances

- And if a woman have an issue, and her issue in her flesh be blood, she shall be put apart seven days: and **whosoever toucheth her shall be unclean until the even**. (Leviticus 15:19)
- And if a woman have **an issue of her blood many days** out of the time of her separation, or if it run beyond the time of her separation; **all the days of the issue** of her uncleanness shall be as the days of her separation: **she shall be unclean**. Every bed whereon she lieth all the days of her issue shall be unto her as the bed of her separation: and whatsoever she sitteth upon shall be unclean, as the uncleanness of her separation. And **whosoever toucheth those things shall be unclean**, and shall wash his clothes, and bathe himself in water, and be unclean until the even. (Leviticus 15:25-27)
- **Thus shall ye separate** the children of Israel from their uncleanness; that they **die not** in their uncleanness, **when they defile My tabernacle** that is among them. (Leviticus 15:31)

# “A Common Thread” in the Meanings

- **Fringes** – (gadeel, H1434 – גדל) **twisted threads**, **tassels on the border of garments** (Deuteronomy 22:12)
- **Fringe** – (tzitzit, H6734 – ציצית) a floral or **wing-like projection**, i.e. a **fore-lock of hair**, a **tassel**:—fringe, lock; **tassel on flowing ends of garments** (Numbers 15:38-39)
- **Wings** – (kanaph, H3671 – כנף) an **edge** or **extremity**; specifically (of a bird or army) **a wing**, (**of a garment or bedclothing**) **a flap** (Malachi 4:2), (Deuteronomy 22:12)
- **Hem** - (kraspedon, G2899 – κρασπέδου) **the extremity** or prominent part of a thing, **edge**, skirt, margin; in the NT a little **appendage hanging down from the edge of the mantle or cloak**, made of **twisted wool**, **the Jews had such appendages attached to their mantles to remind them of the law** (Matthew 9:20 & 14:36)
- **Border** (kraspedon, G2899 – κρασπέδου) see above (Mark 6:56)

# Healing In His Wings

- But to you that fear My name shall the Sun of righteousness arise, and healing in his wings: and ye shall go forth, and bound as young calves let loose from bonds. (Malachi 4:2, LXXE)



# Twisted Words in the KJV

- But to you that fear My name shall the Sun of righteousness arise, and healing in his wings: and ye shall go forth, and **bound as young calves let loose from bonds**. (Malachi 4:2, LXXE)
- But unto you that fear My name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and ~~grow up as calves of the stall~~. (Malachi 4:2 – KJV)

# A Woman Had Suffered 12 Years...

## (Miracle #14)

- And it came to pass, that, when **᠋᠋᠋᠋᠋᠋** was returned, the people gladly received Him: for they were all waiting for Him. And, behold, there came a man named Jairus, and he was a ruler of the synagogue: and he fell down at **᠋᠋᠋᠋᠋᠋**'s feet, and besought Him that He would come into his house: For he had one only daughter, about twelve years of age, and she lay a dying. (Luke 8:40-41)
- And **᠋᠋᠋᠋᠋᠋** arose, and followed him, and so did his disciples. (Matthew 9:19)
- But as He went the people thronged Him. (Luke 8:42)
- And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years... (Matthew 9:20)
  - And if a woman have **an issue of her blood many days...** (Leviticus 15:25)

# She Risked Her Life...

- And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse, When she had heard of @wfAz, came in the press behind... (Mark 5:26-27)
- ...Him, and touched the **hem** of his garment: For she said within herself, If I may but touch His garment, I shall be whole. (Matthew 9:20-21)
- And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague. And @wfAz immediately knowing in Himself that virtue had gone out of Him, turned Him about in the press, and said, **Who touched My clothes?** (Mark 5:29-30)

# She Confessed...

- ...When all denied, Peter and they that were with Him said, Master, the multitude throng Thee and press Thee, and sayest Thou, Who touched Me? And ~~an~~ said, **Somebody hath touched Me: for I perceive that virtue is gone out of Me.** (Luke 8:45-46)
- And He looked round about to see her that had done this thing. But the woman fearing and trembling, knowing what was done in her, came and fell down before Him, and told Him all the truth. (Mark 5:32-33)
- ...she declared unto Him before all the people for what cause she had touched Him, and how she was healed immediately. (Luke 8:47)



# But Had Faith in Him

- But  turned Him about, and when He saw her, He said, **Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole**... (Matthew 9:22)
- ...**Go in peace** (Luke 8:48)
- But unto you that fear My name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with **healing in his wings**... (Malachi 4:2)

## (Miracle #21)

- And when the men of that place had knowledge of Him, they sent out into all that country round about, and brought unto Him all that were diseased; And besought Him that they might only touch the **hem** of His garment: and as many as touched were made perfectly whole. (Matthew 14:35-36)
- Wherever He entered, into villages, or into cities, or into the country, they laid the sick in the marketplaces, and begged Him that they might touch just the **border** of His garment; and as many as touched Him were made well. (Mark 6:56)



# The Healing Wings

- Ye have seen what I did unto the Egyptians, and how **I bare you on eagles' wings**, and brought you unto Myself. Now therefore, **if ye will obey My voice indeed, and keep My covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto Me above all people:** for all the earth is Mine: And **ye shall be unto Me a kingdom of priests, and a set apart nation.** (Exodus 19:4-6)
- For **אֱלֹהִים's portion is His people; Jacob is the lot of His inheritance.** He found him in a desert land, and in the waste howling wilderness; He led him about, He instructed him, He kept him as the apple of His eye. **As an eagle stirreth up her nest, fluttereth over her young, spreadeth abroad her wings, taketh them, beareth them on her wings:** So **אֱלֹהִים** alone did lead him... (Deuteronomy 32:9-12)
- But **they that wait upon אֱלֹהִים shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles;** they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint. (Isaiah 40:31)

# The Sun of Righteousness

- For this Melchisedec, king of Salem, priest of the most high Elohiym...first being by interpretation King of **righteousness**, and after that also King of Salem, which is, King of peace;...having neither beginning of days, nor end of life; but made like unto the **Son of Elohiym**; abideth a priest continually. (Hebrews 7:1-3)
- And Elohiym made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day and the lesser light to rule the night: He made the stars also...And became evening and became morning were the **fourth day**. (Genesis 1:16/19)
- Then spake  again unto them, saying, **I am the light of the world: he that followeth Me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.** (John 8:12)
- And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for **the glory of El did lighten it**, and **the Lamb is the light** thereof. (Revelation 21:23)
- For a thousand years in thy sight are but as yesterday when it is past, and as a watch in the night. (Psalm 90:4)

- Unto you that fear My name shall the Sun of Righteousness arise with healing in His wings... (*or hem, or tzitzit*) (Malachi 4:2)
- Consider, my children, what that signifies, He finished them in six days. The meaning of it is this; That in six thousand years ~~אלף אלף~~ Elohiym will bring all things to an end. For with Him one day is a thousand years; as Himself testifies, saying, Behold this day shall be as a thousand years. Therefore, children, in six days, that is, in six thousand years, shall all things be accomplished. (Barnabas 13:4-5)

# The Royal Law is Love

- And **ⲉⲱⲓⲁⲛ** answered him, **The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; ⲉⲓⲁⲛ our Elohiym is one ⲉⲓⲁⲛ: And thou shalt love ⲉⲓⲁⲛ thy Elohiym with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength (1): this is the first commandment. And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself (2). There is none other commandment greater than these.** (Mark 12:29-31)
  - (1) Deuteronomy 6:5
  - (2) Leviticus 19:18
- Now the purpose of the **commandment** is love from a pure heart, from a good conscience, and from sincere faith (1 Timothy 1:5 – NKJV)
- For Messiah is the purpose for **righteousness** to every one that believeth. (Romans 10:4)
- ...Elohiym is love (1 John 4:8)

# This Is Love

- And now I beseech thee, lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment unto thee, but that which we had from the beginning, that we love one another. And this is love, that we walk after His commandments. This is the commandment, That, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should walk in it. (2 John 1:5-6)
- But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. El is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth. (John 4:23-24)
- Sanctify them through Thy truth: Thy word is truth. (John 17:17)
- Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of Elohiym; and every one that loveth is born of Elohiym, and knoweth Elohiym. He that loveth not knoweth not Elohiym; for Elohiym is love. (1 John 4:7-8)
- ...the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of El, and have the testimony of אֱלֹהִים Messiah. (Revelation 12:17)

# The Restoration of All Things... Starts With Messiah and The Word

- For I will bring about thy healing, I will heal thee of thy grievous wound, saith אֶף אֵל; for thou art called Dispersed... (Jeremiah 37:17, LXXE)
  - “Dispersed” - spi'-ro (Εσπαρμένη, G4687), defined as sow, sown (seed)
- And He said unto them, Know ye not this parable? and how then will ye know all parables? The sower soweth the word. (Mark 4:13-14)
- For as in Adam all die, even so in Messiah shall all be made alive. But every man in his own order: Messiah the firstfruits; afterward they that are Messiah's at His coming. (1 Corinthians 15:22-23)
- And as Esaias said before, Except אֶף אֵל of Sabaoth had left us a seed, we had been as Sodoma, and been made like unto Gomorrha. (Romans 9:29)

# The Restoration of All Things...

- Behold, I will bring it health and cure, and I will cure them,  
and will reveal unto them the abundance of peace and  
truth... And I will cleanse them from all their iniquity,  
whereby they have sinned against Me. (Jeremiah 33:6/8)
- ...I am thy Elohiym: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help  
thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of My  
righteousness. (Isaiah 41:10)
- I have seen his ways, and will heal him... (Isaiah 57:18)
- And ye shall serve אֱלֹהֶיךָ your Elohiym, and He shall bless  
thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away  
from the midst of thee. (Exodus 23:25)

# ...When We Follow His Word in Faith

- ...If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of אֱלֹהֶיךָ thy Elohiym, and wilt do that which is right in His sight, and wilt give ear to His commandments, and keep all His statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am אֱלֹהֶיךָ that healeth thee. (Exodus 15:26)
- If My people, which are called by My name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land. Now Mine eyes shall be open, and Mine ears attent unto the prayer that is made in this place. (2 Chronicles 7:14-15)
- My son, forget not My law; but let thine heart keep My commandments: For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee... Trust in אֱלֹהֶיךָ with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths. Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear אֱלֹהֶיךָ and depart from evil. It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones. (Proverbs 3:1-2/5-8)

# Sacrifice and Healing

- I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of Elohiym, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, set apart, acceptable unto Elohiym, which is your reasonable service. (Romans 12:1)
- Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, a set apart priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to El by **᠋᠋᠋᠋᠋᠋** Messiah. (2 Peter 2:5)
- The sacrifices of Elohiym are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O Elohiym, Thou wilt not despise. (Psalm 51:17)
- ...The sacrifice unto Elohiym is a broken heart, the smell of a sweet savor unto **᠋᠋᠋᠋᠋᠋** is a heart that glorifies its Maker. (Barnabas 2:10)
- And in like manner the Spirit also helpeth our infirmity: for we know not how to pray as we ought; but the Spirit Himself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered; and He that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because He maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of El. And we know that to them that love Elohiym all things work together for good, even to them that are called according to His purpose. (Romans 8:26-28-ASV)

# The Restoration of All Things

- And Elohiym shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. (Revelation 21:4)
- He will swallow up death in victory; and the Adoni אדני will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of His people shall He take away from off all the earth: for אדני hath spoken it. And it shall be said in that day, Lo, this is our Elohiym; we have waited for Him, and He will save us: this is אדני; we have waited for Him, we will be glad and rejoice in His salvation. (Isaiah 25:8-9)

# The Final Word

- And, behold, I come quickly; and My reward is with Me, to give every man according as his work shall be. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last. Blessed are they that do His commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city. For without are dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie. I  have sent Mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star. (Revelation 22:12-16)
