# The Salvation of אֱלֹהִים

- Sing to אֱלֹהִים a new song; for אֱלֹהִים has wrought wonderful works, **His right hand, and His set apart arm, have wrought salvation for Him.** אֱלֹהִים has made known His salvation, He has revealed His righteousness in the sight of the nations. **He has remembered His mercy to Jacob, and His truth to the house of Israel; all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our Elohiym.** Shout to Elohiym, all the earth; sing, and exult, and sing psalms. Sing to אֱלֹהִים with a harp, with a harp, and the voice of a psalm. **With trumpets of metal, and the sound of a trumpet of horn make a joyful noise to אֱלֹהִים before the king.** Let the sea be moved, and the fullness of it; the world, and they that dwell in it. The rivers shall clap their hands together; the mountains shall exult. **For He is come to judge the earth;** He shall judge the world in righteousness, and the nations in uprightness. (Psalm 97:1-9, LXXE)

# The Salvation of אֱלֹהִים

## Faith, Obedience, Love

- If Thou wouldest open the heaven, trembling will take hold upon the mountains from Thee, and they shall melt, as wax melts before the fire; and fire shall burn up the enemies, and Thy name shall be manifest among the adversaries: at Thy presence the nations shall be troubled, whenever Thou shalt work gloriously; trembling from Thee shall take hold upon the mountains. From of old we have not heard, neither have our eyes seen an Elohiym beside Thee, and Thy works which Thou wilt perform to them that wait for mercy. For [these blessings] shall happen to them that work righteousness... (Isaiah 64:1-5, LXXE)
  - But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which Elohiym hath prepared for them that love Him. But Elohiym hath revealed them unto us by His Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of Elohiym. (1 Corinthians 2:9-10)

# Noah's Faith and Obedience

- And אֱלֹהִים saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth... And אֱלֹהִים said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth... But **Noah found grace in the eyes of אֱלֹהִים... and Noah walked with Elohiym.** (Genesis 6:5/7-9)
- And Elohiym looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; **for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth...** And Elohiym said unto Noah... **I will destroy them with the earth.** Make thee an ark... I, do bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh... But with thee will I establish My covenant... Thus did Noah; according to **all that Elohiym commanded him, so did he.** (Genesis 6:12-14/17-18/22)



# Judgement Upon The Earth

- And אֱלֹהִים said unto Noah, Come thou and all thy house into the ark... Noah did according unto all that אֱלֹהִים commanded him. (Genesis 7:1/5)
- ...all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened. And the rain was upon the earth forty days and forty nights... And the waters prevailed, and were increased greatly upon the earth; and the ark went upon the face of the waters. And the waters prevailed exceedingly upon the earth... And every living substance was destroyed which was upon the face of the ground, both man, and cattle, and the creeping things, and the fowl of the heaven; and they were destroyed from the earth: and Noah only remained alive, and they that were with him in the ark. (Genesis 7:11-12/18-19/23)



# Noah's Deliverance

- Then Elohiym remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the animals that were with him in the ark. And Elohiym made a wind to **pass over** the earth, and the waters subsided. (Genesis 8:1 – NKJV)
  - ויעבר אלהים רוח על־הארץ וישכו המים
  - (and **will** pass over)(Elohiym)(Spirit)(over-the earth)(and **will** calm)(the waters)
    - “pass over” (H5674, **עבר**), a primitive root; to cross over, any transition (literal or figurative), deliver, enter, pass over/through, set apart



# Abram Leaves His Home

- Now אַבְרָם had said unto Abram, **Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:** And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing... So Abram departed, as אַבְרָם had spoken unto him; and Lot went with him: and Abram was seventy and five years old when he departed out of Haran... and they went forth to go into the land of Canaan; and into the land of Canaan they came. (Genesis 12:1-2/4-5)
  - **And every one that hath forsaken houses, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for My name's sake, shall receive an hundredfold, and shall inherit everlasting life. But many that are first shall be last; and the last shall be first.** (Matthew 19:29-30)

# Abram Passed Through to Canaan

- And Abram passed through the land unto the place of **Sichem**, unto the plain of **Moreh**. And the Canaanite was then in the land. (Genesis 12:6 - KJV)
  - “**Moreh**” (H4176, מורה), "teacher", **the oak tree at Shechem** where Abram stopped when he first entered Canaan; close to the mountains of Ebal and Gerizim
  - “**Sichem**” (H7927, שכם), "back" or "shoulder", a city in Manasseh; located in a valley between Mount Ebal and Mount Gerizim, 34 miles (54 km) north of Jerusalem
- And Abram traversed the land lengthwise as far as the place Sychem, to the **high oak**, and the Chananites then inhabited the land. (Genesis 12:6 – LXXE)
- And Abram journeyed from Haran, and he took Sarai, his wife, and Lot, his brother Haran's son, to the land of Canaan, and he came into Asshur (*אשור* - *Syria*), and proceeded to **Shechem**, and dwelt near **a lofty oak**. And he saw, and, behold, the land was very pleasant from the entering of Hamath (*in Syria*) to the **lofty oak**. (Jubilees 13:1-2)



# Abram Stopped Here

- After entering Canaan, Abram first stayed at Moreh by Mt Gerizim and Mt Ebal.
  - Moreh (H4176, מורה) is a different place than the Mt Moriah (H4179, מוריה) at Jerusalem



# Abram Crossed Over

- And Abram passed through the land unto the place of Sichem, unto the plain of Moreh. And the Canaanite was then in the land. (Gen 12:6)
  - “passed through” (H5674, עבר), a primitive root; to cross over, enter, any transition (literal or figurative), deliver, pass over/ through, set apart
- ...one that had escaped, and told Abram the Hebrew... (Gen 14:13, KJV)
  - “Hebrew” (H5680, עברי), “one from beyond”, a designation of the Israelites (Hebrew)
- ...one of them that had been rescued came and told Abram the Hebrew... (Genesis 14:13, LXXE)
  - “Hebrew” - Peraths (N/A, περάτης), wanderer, immigrant



# Joseph The Hebrew

- And she spake unto him according to these words, saying, The **Hebrew** servant, which thou hast brought unto us, came in unto me to mock me... And Joseph's master took him, and put him into the prison... But אֶזְרָא was with Joseph, and shewed him mercy... (Genesis 39:17/20-21, KJV)
  - “Hebrew” (H5680, עִבְרִי), “one from beyond”, a designation of the Israelites (Hebrew)
- ...The Hebrew servant, whom thou broughtest in to us... (Gen 39:17, LXXE)
  - “Hebrew” - Hebraïos (G, Ἑβραῖος), a Hebræan (i.e. Hebrew)



# Judgement Upon Egypt

And אֲנֹכִי spake unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying... they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house... And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses... it is אֲנֹכִי's Passover. (Exodus 12:1/3/7/11)

Passover (H6453, פסח), from H6452 (to hop, skip over, pass over), the Passover (festival or sacrifice)

For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt, I will execute judgment: I am אֲנֹכִי. And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt. (Exodus 12:12-13)

“pass through” (H5674, עבר) to cross over, any transition (literal or figurative), deliver, enter, pass over/ through set apart

“pass over” (H6452, פסח), to hop, skip over, pass over

# Through the Sea

... אֶת־אֲנֹכְנֹךְ brought them through the midst of the sea as if it were dry land.  
(Jubilees 48:13)

- ...I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea; (1 Corinthians 10:1-2)
  - By faith they passed through the End Sea as by dry land: which the Egyptians assaying to do were drowned. (Hebrews 11:29)
    - “passed through” (G1224, διέβησαν), to cross over, pass through, (see Joshua 1:11 and more in LXXE)

# Israel Will Cross Over

- Hear, O Israel: Thou art to pass over (H5674) Jordan this day, to go in to possess nations greater and mightier than thyself, cities great and fenced up to heaven... For ye shall pass over (H5674) Jordan to go in to possess the land which אף אע your Elohiym giveth you, and ye shall possess it, and dwell therein. (Deuteronomy 9:1/11:31)
- Then Joshua commanded the officers of the people, saying... within three days ye shall pass over (H5674) this Jordan, to go in to possess the land, which אף אע your Elohiym giveth you to possess it. (Joshua 1:10-11)
- And Joshua said unto the people, Sanctify yourselves: for tomorrow אף אע will do wonders among you. (Joshua 3:5)

# Israel at The Jordan

- And Joshua said unto the children of Israel, Come hither, and hear the words of אֱלֹהֵיכֶם your Elohiym... Behold, the ark of the covenant of the Adon of all the earth passeth over (H5674) before you into Jordan... And it shall come to pass, as soon as the soles of the feet of the priests that bear the ark of אֱלֹהֵיכֶם, the Adon of all the earth, shall rest in the waters of Jordan, that the waters of Jordan shall be cut off from the waters that come down from above; and they shall stand upon an heap. (Joshua 3:9/11/13)



# Israel at The Jordan

- And as they that bare the ark were come unto Jordan, and the feet of the priests that bare the ark were dipped in the brim of the water, (for Jordan overfloweth all his banks all the time of harvest,) That the waters which came down from above stood and rose up upon an heap very far from the city Adam, that is beside Zaretan: and those that came down toward the sea of the plain, even the salt sea, failed, and were cut off: and the people passed over (H5674) right against Jericho. And the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of אֲרֹן stood firm on dry ground in the midst of Jordan, and all the Israelites passed over (H5674) on dry ground, until all the people were passed clean over (H5674) Jordan. (Joshua 3:15-17)

# Crossing Over From The Flesh

- And Elohiym said unto him, Thy name is Jacob: thy name shall not be called any more Jacob, but **Israel shall be thy name.** (Genesis 35:10)
  - Jacob (H3290, יעקב), "heel holder" or "supplanter"
  - Israel (H3478, ישראל), "El prevails": from H410 and H8280
    - (H410, אל), power, the Almighty
    - (H8280, שרה), a primitive root; to prevail: have power (as a prince)
- Know ye therefore that **they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham.** (Galatians 3:7)
- For **we are the circumcision,** which **worship Elohiym in the spirit,** and rejoice in Messiah **ⓂⓌⓉⓏ,** and **have no confidence in the flesh.** (Philippians 3:3)

# Crossing Over From The Flesh

- And now, Israel, what doth אִפְאֵל thy Elohiym require of thee, but to fear אִפְאֵל thy Elohiym, to walk in all His ways, and to love Him, and to serve אִפְאֵל thy Elohiym with all thy heart and with all thy soul... Circumcise... your heart... And אִפְאֵל thy Elohiym will circumcise thine heart... to love אִפְאֵל thy Elohiym with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, that thou mayest live. (Deuteronomy 10:12/16/ 30:6)
- But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith אִפְאֵל, I will put My law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their Elohiym, and they shall be My people. (Jeremiah 31:33 and Hebrews 8:8)
  - For I will take you from among the heathen, and gather you out of all countries, and will bring you into your own land. Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and ye shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you. A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. And I will put My spirit within you, and cause you to walk in My statutes, and ye shall keep My judgments, and do them. (Ezekiel 36:24-27)

# Crossing Over - Walking in the Spirit

- Except a man be born of **water** and of the **Spirit**, he cannot enter into the kingdom of Elohiym. That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. (John 3:5-6)
- ...**ye believe in El, believe also in Me.** (John 14:1)
  - “believe” (G4100, πιστεύετε), to have faith, commit, used in the NT of the trust and conviction to which a man is impelled by a certain inner and higher prerogative and law of soul
- ...Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. (Galatians 5:16)
- ...walk worthy of the Adon unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in **the knowledge of El** (Colossians 1:10)
  - And hereby we do know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments. (1 John 2:3)
- Here is the patience of **the saints**: here are **they that keep the commandments of El**, and **the faith of** . (Revelation 14:12)

# Walking in the Spirit

- Beloved... have we confidence toward **Elohiym**. And whatsoever we ask, we receive of **Him**, because we keep **His** commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in **His** sight. And **this is His commandment,** **That we should believe on the name of **His** Son** <sup>ⓄⓂⓂⓂⓂⓂ</sup> **Messiah, and love one another,** as **He** gave us commandment. (1 John 3:21-23)
  - I will raise up to them a Prophet of their brethren, like thee; and **I will put My words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them as I shall command Him.** And whatever man shall not hearken to whatsoever words that Prophet shall speak in My name, I will take vengeance on him. (Deuteronomy 18:18-19 - LXXE)
  - **He that loveth Me not keepeth not My sayings: and the word which ye hear is not Mine, but the Father's which sent Me... as the Father gave Me commandment, even so I do.** (John 14:24/31)
- And he that keepeth **His** commandments dwelleth in **Him**, and He in him. And hereby **we know that He abideth in us,** by the Spirit which **He** hath given us. (1 John 3:21-24)
  - **And I will pray the Father, and He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever;** (John 14:16)

# Sanctify Yourself

- Teacher, what good thing shall I do that I may have eternal life?... **if you want to enter into life, keep the commandments. You shall not murder... if you want to be perfect, go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me.** (Matthew 19:16-18/21 - NKJV)
- **Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill. For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled.** (Matthew 5:17-18 – NKJV)
- ...**a man is justified by faith...Do we then make void the law through faith? El forbid: yea, we establish the law... For not the hearers of the law are just before El, but the doers of the law shall be justified... love is the fulfilling of the law.** (Romans 3:28/31; 2:13; 13:8)
- For **alms doth deliver from death, and shall purge away all sin. Those that exercise alms and righteousness shall be filled with life.** (Tobit 12:9)
- **Sanctify yourselves:** for **tomorrow אף אז will do wonders among you.** (Joshua 3:5)

# Spiritual Hebrews (“Ones From Beyond”)

- I have given them Thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. (John 17:14)
- If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you. (John 15:19)
- Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul; (1 Peter 2:11)
- For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Adon משיח Messiah, who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself. (Philippians 3:20-21 – NKJV)
- But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of Elohiym. (Romans 2:29)

# Spiritual Hebrews (“Ones From Beyond”) No Difference Between Gentiles and Jews

- For **there is no partiality with Elohiym... for there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek... For whosoever shall call upon the name of יהוה shall be saved.** (Romans 10:12-13)  
(Joel 2:32)
- But **if ye have respect to persons, ye commit sin, and are convinced of the law as transgressors.** (James 2:9)
  - *There can not be different paths or requirements for different people (example: dispensationalism's “tribulation Jews” and “pre-trib raptured Christians”)... that would partiality for one group above another, and is explicitly stated as sin.*
- And I charged your judges at that time, saying, Hear the causes between your brethren, and **judge righteously between every man and his brother, and the stranger that is with him... Ye shall not respect persons in judgment.**... (Deuteronomy 1:16-17)
- **...thou shalt not respect persons.**... (Deuteronomy 16:19)



# Spiritual Hebrews (“Ones From Beyond”) The House of Israel

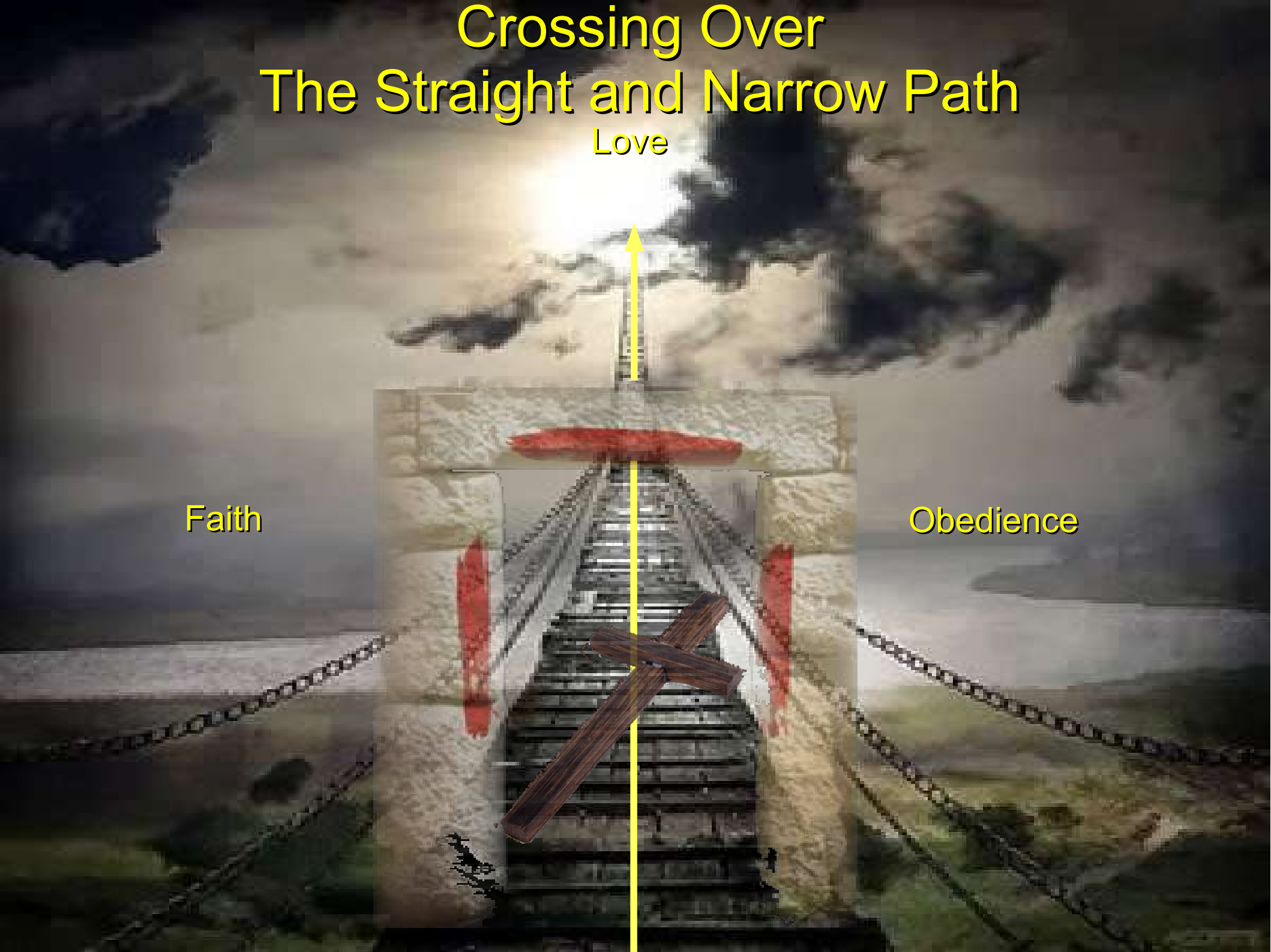
- For there is no partiality with Elohiym... for there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek... For whosoever shall call upon the name of אֱלֹהִים shall be saved. (Romans 10:12-13)(Joel 2:32)
- For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of El... For we are His workmanship, created in Messiah אֱלֹהִים unto good works, which Elohiym hath before ordained that we should walk in them. Wherefore remember, that ye being in time past Gentiles in the flesh... That at that time ye were without Messiah, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without Elohiym in the world: But now in Messiah אֱלֹהִים ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Messiah... Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of Elohiym; And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, אֱלֹהִים Messiah Himself being the chief corner stone... In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of Elohiym through the Spirit. (Ephesians 2:8/10-13/19-20/22)
