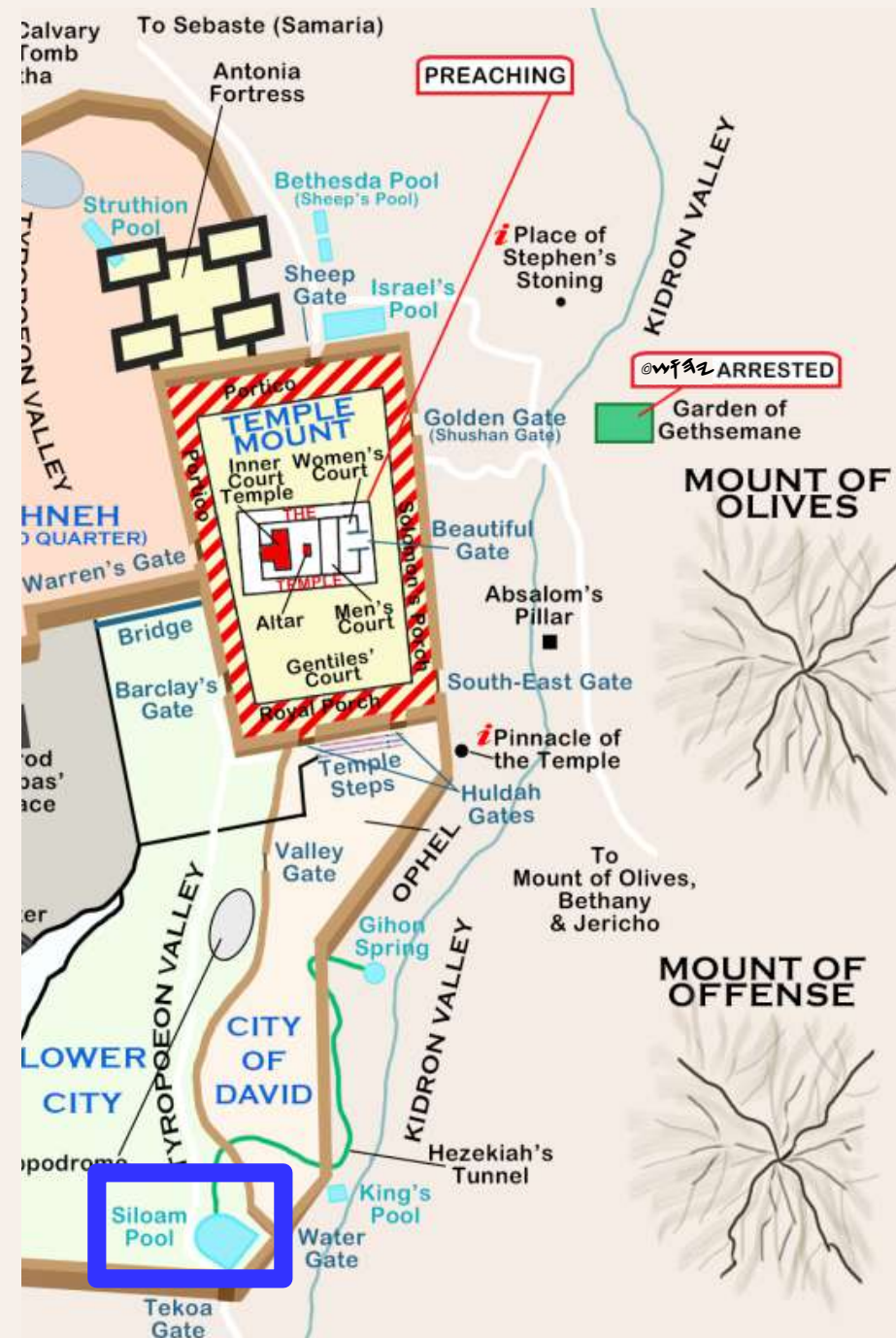
The Garments Of Salvation

- The Spirit of אִשְׂרָאֵל is upon Me, because He has anointed Me...to declare the acceptable year of אִשְׂרָאֵל, and the day of recompense; For I am אִשְׂרָאֵל who love righteousness, and hate robberies of injustice; and I will give their labour to the just, and will make an everlasting covenant with them... and they shall greatly rejoice in אִשְׂרָאֵל. Let My soul rejoice in אִשְׂרָאֵל; for He has clothed Me with the robe of salvation, and the garment of joy: He has put a mitre on Me as on a bridegroom, and adorned Me with ornaments as a bride. (Isaiah 61:1-2/8/10, LXXE)
 - recompense (G469, ἀνταποδόσεως), requital, reward
 - ...from אִשְׂרָאֵל you will receive the reward (G469) of the inheritance; for you serve the Adon Messiah. But he who does wrong will be repaid for what he has done, and there is no partiality. (Colossians 3:24-25, NKJV)



The Sent One

- And as @wfa2 passed by, He saw a man which was blind from his birth. And His disciples asked Him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind? @wfa2 answered, **Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of El should be made manifest in him. I must work the works of Him that sent Me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work... And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, **Sent**.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing. (John 9:1-4/7)**



The Pool of Siloam

- The Pool of Siloam was initially found at the end of the 19th century, when archaeologists exposed some of the steps of the pool.
- The pool's scope was more fully understood in 2004, when Jerusalem's water infrastructure work accidentally laid bare more of the location.



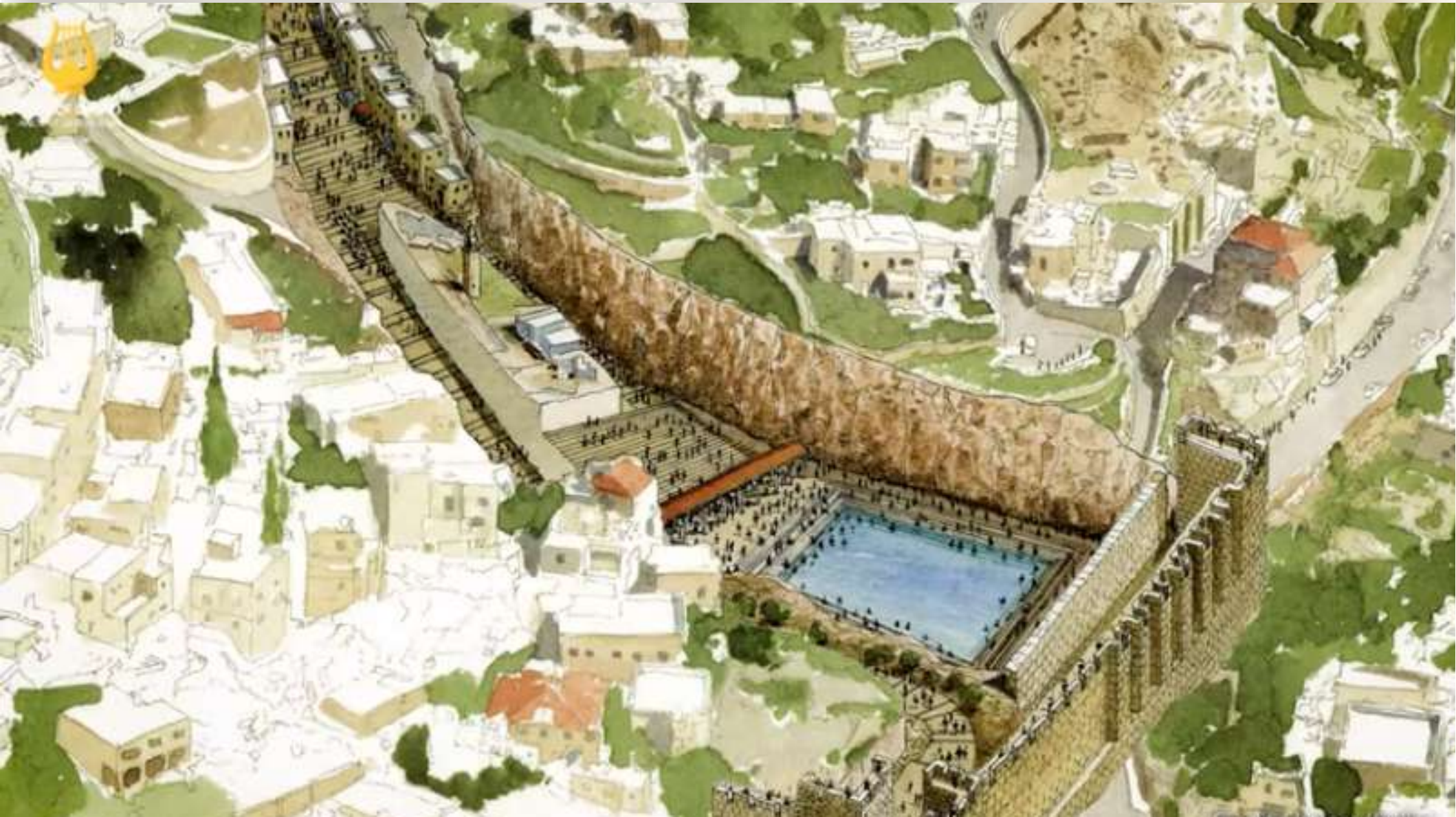
The Pool of Siloam

- The pool site is estimated to be over an acre. The site is now planned to be fully excavated and then opened to the public.



The Pool of Siloam

- A stone path, dubbed “the Pilgrimage Road,” that connects the Pool of Siloam with the Temple Mount (from the south) has also been recently uncovered.



The Pool of Siloam

- Worshippers used “The Pilgrimage Road,” which used to ascend from the Pool of Siloam up to the Temple Mount during the time of the Second Temple.
- The people would immerse themselves in the pool to purify themselves in water and then put on white robes before walking up to the Temple Mount to celebrate the Feasts of שבעה עצרת .

Sanctified in White

- Let thy garments be always white; and let not oil be wanting on thine head. (Ecclesiastes 9:8, LXXE)
- **Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee. Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with Me in white: for they are worthy. He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before My Father, and before His angels. He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the assemblies.** (Revelation 3:3-6)

- “heard” is שמע (obey) in the Hebrew Revelation



The Wedding Garment

- The kingdom of heaven is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for his son, And sent forth his servants to call them that were bidden to the wedding: and they would not come... And the remnant took his servants, and entreated them spitefully, and slew them. But when the king heard thereof, he... destroyed those murderers, and burned up their city. Then saith he to his servants, The wedding is ready, but they which were bidden were not worthy. Go ye therefore into the highways, and as many as ye shall find, bid to the marriage... And when the king came in to see the guests, he saw there a man which had not on a wedding garment: And he saith unto him, Friend, how camest thou in hither not having a wedding garment? And he was speechless. Then said the king to the servants, Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast him into outer darkness; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. For many are called, but few are chosen. (Matthew 22:2-3/6-9/11-14)



The Levites

- ... אֱלֹהִים separated the tribe of Levi, to bear the ark of the covenant of אֱלֹהִים, to stand before אֱלֹהִים to minister unto Him, and to bless in His name, unto this day. (Deuteronomy 10:8)
- The priests the Levites, and all the tribe of Levi, shall have no part nor inheritance with Israel: they shall eat the offerings of אֱלֹהִים made by fire, and His inheritance. Therefore shall they have no inheritance among their brethren: אֱלֹהִים is their inheritance, as He hath said unto them... For אֱלֹהִים thy Elohiym hath chosen him out of all thy tribes, to stand to minister in the name of אֱלֹהִים, him and his sons **for ever**. And **if a Levite come from any of thy gates out of all Israel, where he sojourned, and come with all the desire of his mind unto the place which אֱלֹהִים shall choose; Then he shall minister in the name of אֱלֹהִים his Elohiym, as all his brethren the Levites do, which stand there before אֱלֹהִים.** (Deuteronomy 18:1-2/5-7)

The Levites

- And if a Levite come from any of thy gates out of all Israel, where he sojourned, and come with **all the desire of his mind** unto the place which אףאז shall choose; (Deuteronomy 18:6)
 - And now, Israel, what doth אףאז thy Elohiym require of thee, but to **fear אףאז** thy Elohiym, to **walk in all His ways**, and **to love Him, and to serve אףאז thy Elohiym with all thy heart and with all thy soul**, To **keep the commandments of אףאז**, and His statutes... (Deuteronomy 10:12-13)
- Then he shall minister in the name of אףאז his Elohiym, as all his brethren the Levites do, which **stand there before אףאז**. (Deuteronomy 18:7)
 - **Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.** (Luke 21:36)

The Consecration of the Levite Priests

- And **אֱלֹהִים** spake unto Moses, saying, Take Aaron and his sons with him, and the garments... And gather thou all the congregation together unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation... And Moses said unto the congregation, This is the thing which **אֱלֹהִים** commanded to be done. And Moses brought Aaron and his sons, and **washed them with water**... And Moses brought Aaron's sons, and put coats upon them, and girded them with girdles, and put bonnets upon them; as אֱלֹהִים commanded Moses. (Leviticus 8:1-3/5/13)*



* the first part of the consecration process

The Laver (The Tabernacle)

- And look that thou make them **after their pattern**, which was shewed thee in the mount. (Exodus 25:40)
- Thou shalt also make a laver of brass, and his foot also of brass, to wash withal: and thou shalt put it between the tabernacle of the congregation and the altar, and thou shalt put **water** therein. For Aaron and his sons shall wash their hands and their feet... (Exodus 30:18)
- And he made the laver of brass, and the foot of it of brass, of the **lookingglasses** of the women assembling, which assembled at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. (Exodus 38:8)
- So they shall wash their hands and their feet, **that they die not**: and it shall be a statute **for ever to them, even to him and to his seed throughout their generations.** (Exodus 30:21)



The Molten Sea (The Temple)

- Take heed now; for **אֲנִי** hath chosen thee to build an house for the sanctuary: be strong, and do it... Then David gave to Solomon his son the pattern... All this, said David, **אֲנִי** made me understand in writing by His hand upon me, even **all the works of this pattern.** (1 Chronicles 28:10-11/19)



The Molten Sea

- And he made a molten sea, ten cubits from the one brim to the other: it was round all about, and his height was five cubits... It stood upon twelve oxen, three looking toward the north, and three looking toward the west, and three looking toward the south, and three looking toward the east: and the sea was set above upon them... And it was an hand breadth thick, and the brim thereof was wrought like the brim of a cup, with flowers of lilies: it contained two thousand baths. (1 Kings 7:23/25-26)
- He made also ten lavers... to wash in them: such things as they offered for the burnt offering they washed in them; but the sea was for the priests to wash in. (2 Chronicles 4:6)



The Chosen

- And אֶפְרַיִם spoke to Moses, saying, Take the Levites out of the midst of the children of Israel, and thou shalt purify them. And thus shalt thou perform their purification: thou shalt sprinkle them with water of purification, and a razor shall come upon the whole of their body, and they shall wash their garments, and shall be clean. (Numbers 8:5-7, LXXE)
- And Aaron shall separate the Levites for a gift before אֶפְרַיִם from the children of Israel: and they shall be prepared to perform the works of אֶפְרַיִם... And thou shalt separate the Levites from the midst of the sons of Israel, and they shall be Mine... And I took the Levites in the place of every first-born among the children of Israel. (Numbers 8:11/14/18, LXXE)

The Philadelphia Assembly

- To the angel of the assembly in Philadelphia write... **I know your works... that you have a little power, and kept My word, and didn't deny My name.** (Revelation 3:7-8 - HNV)
 - And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with **the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of EI, and have the testimony of 𐌸𐌹𐌺𐌹 Messiah.** (Revelation 12:17)
- **Because you kept My command to endure, I also will keep you from the hour of testing, which is to come on the whole world, to test those who dwell... I am coming quickly! Hold firmly that which you have, so that no one takes your crown. He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My EI, and he will go out from there no more... He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the assemblies.** (Revelation 3:10-13 – HNV)
 - **Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which 𐌸𐌹𐌺𐌹 hath promised to them that love him.** (James 1:12)
 - **You will be hated by all men for My name's sake, but he who endures to the end, the same will be saved.** (Mark 13:13)

Immersed In the Sea


...they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory...

(Matthew 24:30)

...I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea; (1 Corinthians 10:1-2)

Purified Unto Him

- **...they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory...**
(Matthew 24:30)

- Looking for the blessed hope, and **glorious appearing** of our great Elohiym and Savior  Messiah, who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works. (Titus 2:13-14, NKJV)

Prophecy of The Great Immersion

- Take the Levites out of the midst of the children of Israel, and thou shalt purify them... thou shalt sprinkle them with water of purification... (Numbers 8:6-7, LXXE)
- And I will sanctify My great name, which was profaned among the heathen, which ye have profaned in the midst of them; and the heathen shall know that I am אֱלֹהִים, saith the Adon אֱלֹהִים, when I shall be sanctified in you before their eyes. For I will take you from among the heathen, and gather you out of all countries... Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and ye shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you. (Ezekiel 36:23-25)
- And I will bring them again from the land of Egypt, and I will gather them in from among the Assyrians... and there shall not even one of them be left behind. And they shall pass through a narrow sea... And I will strengthen them in אֱלֹהִים their Elohiym; and they shall boast in His name, saith אֱלֹהִים. (Zechariah 10:10-12, LXXE)

Waters of The Great Immersion

- In the beginning Elohiym created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of Elohiym moved upon the face of the waters... And Elohiym said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters. And Elohiym made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament: and it was so. And Elohiym called the firmament Heaven... (Genesis 1:1-2/6-8)
- Praise ye אֱלֹהִים. Praise ye אֱלֹהִים from the heavens: praise Him in the heights. Praise ye Him, all His angels: praise ye Him, all His hosts. Praise ye Him, sun and moon: praise Him, all ye stars of light. Praise Him, ye heavens of heavens, and the water that is above the heavens. Let them praise the name of אֱלֹהִים: for He commanded, and they were created. (Psalm 148:1-5)

Crossing Over... Through A Narrow Sea

- I will make a sign to them, and gather them in... I will sow them among the people; and they that are afar off shall remember Me... And I will bring them again from the land of Egypt, and I will gather them in from among the Assyrians... and there shall not even one of them be left behind. And **they shall pass through a narrow sea**... and all the pride of the Assyrians shall be taken away, and the sceptre of Egypt shall be removed. And I will strengthen them in אֱלֹהֵיהֶם their Elohiym; and they shall boast in His name, saith אֱלֹהֵיהֶם. (Zechariah 10:8-12, LXXE)

- ...shall pass through the sea... (Zechariah 10:11, KJV)

- “pass through” (H5674, עָבַר), a primitive root; **to cross over**, any transition (literal or figurative), deliver, enter, pass over/through, set apart



The Sea of Glass and Fire



TRUTH I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of Elohiym. (John 3:5)



The Sea of Glass and Fire

- When ye see the ark of the covenant of אֱלֹהֵיכֶם your Elohiym... then ye shall remove from your place, and go after it. Yet there shall be a space between you and it, about two thousand cubits by measure: come not near unto it... (Joshua 3:3-4)

- And after that I looked, and, behold, The Temple of The Tabernacle of The Testimony in Heaven was opened: And the seven angels came out of The Temple, having the seven plagues... And The Temple was filled with smoke from the glory of Elohiym, and from His power; and no man was able to enter into The Temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled. (Revelation 15:5-6/8)

- For El hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Adon אֱלֹהֵינוּ Messiah... (1 Thessalonians 5:9)

Saved From The Wrath of אֱלֹהִים

- ...in heaven, great and marvellous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of El.

(Revelation 15:1)

- And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of Elohiym. (Revelation 15:2)

- And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, Go your ways, and pour out the vials of the wrath of El upon the earth. (Revelation 16:1)

Purified In The Laver of אֲפֶקֶז



- And he set the laver between the tent of the congregation and the altar, and put water there, to wash... and when they came near unto the altar, they washed; as אֲפֶקֶז commanded... (Exodus 40:30/32)

The Greater Exodus – Sing !!!

- And Israel saw that great work which אֱלֹהִים did upon the Egyptians: and the people feared אֱלֹהִים, and believed אֱלֹהִים, and His servant Moses. Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto אֱלֹהִים... (Exodus 14:31/15:1)
- And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of El. And they sing the song of Moses the servant of El, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous are Thy works, אֱלֹהִים El Almighty; just and true are Thy ways, Thou King of saints. (Revelation 15:2-3)
- He will swallow up death in victory; and the Adon אֱלֹהִים will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of His people shall He take away from off all the earth: for אֱלֹהִים hath spoken it. And it shall be said in that day, Lo, this is our Elohiym; we have waited for Him, and He will save us: this is אֱלֹהִים; we have waited for Him, we will be glad and rejoice in His salvation. (Isaiah 25:8-9)

And Moses brought Aaron's sons, and **put coats upon them**, and girded them with girdles, and put bonnets upon them; as אֲרָאֵל commanded Moses. (Leviticus 8:1-3/5/13)



Forever in White Before The Throne

- I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations... stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with **white robes**, and **palms** in their hands... with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our El... and unto the Lamb.... And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in **white robes**? and whence came they? And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are **they which came out of great tribulation**, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. Therefore are they before the throne of Elohiym, and serve Him day and night in His temple: and **He that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.** They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat. (Revelation 7:9/13-16)

Now Are They Crowned

- And the crown shall be to **them that wait patiently** and to the **useful men of the captivity, and to them that have known it...**
(Zechariah 6:14, LXXE)
- I Esdras saw upon the mount Sion a great people, whom I could not number, and they all praised אֲשֶׁר אֲנִי with songs. And in the midst of them there was a young Man of a high stature, taller than all the rest, and upon every one of their heads He set crowns, and was more exalted; which I marveled at greatly. So I asked the angel, and said, Sir, what are these? He answered and said unto me, These be **they that have put off the mortal clothing, and put on the immortal, and have confessed the name of Elohiym: now are they crowned,** and **receive palms.** Then said I unto the angel, What young Person is it that crowneth them, and giveth them palms in their hands? So he answered and said unto me, **It is the Son of El, whom they have confessed in the world.** Then began I greatly to commend **them that stood so stiffly for the name of אֲשֶׁר אֲנִי.** (2 Esdras 2:42-47)

The Consecration of the Priests



- And Moses brought Aaron and his sons, and washed them with water... (Leviticus 8:5)
 - And they shall pass through a narrow sea... (Zechariah 10:11)
- And Moses brought Aaron's sons, and put coats upon them... (Leviticus 8:13)
 - and there was given to each one white robes... standing before the throne, and before the Lamb, arrayed in white robes, and palms in their hands... (Revelation 6:11; 7:9)
- And Moses brought Aaron's sons...and put bonnets upon them; as אֵפֹדֹת commanded Moses. (Leviticus 8:13)
 - And the crown shall be to them that wait patiently... (Zechariah 6:14, LXXE)
 - ...**I will give thee a crown of life**. (Revelation 2:10)
 - ...now are they crowned, and receive palms. (2 Esdras 2:44)


The Consecration of the Priests



- And Moses brought Aaron's sons, and **girded them with girdles**... (Leviticus 8:13)
 - Finally, my brethren, **be strong in ἀσπάζ**, and in the power of His might... For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. (Ephesians 6:10/12)
 - **Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth**... (Ephesians 6:14)
 - **They are not of the world**, even as I am not of the world. Sanctify them through Thy truth: **Thy word is truth**. (John 17:16-17)
- Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to **stand before the Son of man**. (Luke 21:36)

The Consecration of the Priests

And ye shall be unto Me a kingdom of priests, and a set apart nation. These are the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel. (Exodus 19:6)



Blessed and set apart is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of El and of Messiah, and shall reign with Him a thousand years... (Revelation 20:6)

(Isaiah 61:1-2/8/10, LXXE)
 - Look to yourselves, that we do not lose those things we worked for, but that we may receive a full reward. (2 John 1:8, NKJV)
 - ...from אֱלֹהִים you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Adon Messiah. But he who does wrong will be repaid for what he has done, and there is no partiality. (Colossians 3:24-25, NKJV)
 - The nations were angry, and Your wrath has come... And that You should reward Your servants the prophets and the saints, and those who fear Your name, small and great... (Revelation 11:18, NKJV)
