


#### The Feasts of 3732

- ... \* spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to the children of Israel, and thou shalt say unto them, The feasts of \* which ye shall call set apart assemblies, these are My feasts. (Leviticus 23:1-2, LXXE)
  - "feasts" (H4150, מועדי ), an appointment, a fixed time or season, a year, a signal, feast, an assembly (by implication),
- For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect. (Hebrews 10:1)
- For now we see in a mirror, dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part, but then I will know fully, even as I was also fully known. (1 Corinthians 13:12)
- Let no man therefore judge you in eating, or in drinking, or with respect to a feast day or a new month or Shabbat, which are a shadow of the things to come; but the body is Messiah's.
   (Colossions 2:16-17 – HNV)

# FEAST DAYS

- Feast of Tabernacles (Booths) (in the 7th month)
  - Day of Trumpets
    - 1<sup>st</sup> Day High Sabbath
  - Day of Atonements
    - 10<sup>th</sup> Day High Sabbath from 9th at even
  - Tabernacles
    - 7 days, 15th 21<sup>st</sup> Days, with a <u>High Sabbath</u> on the first day
  - The Eighth Day
    - 22<sup>nd</sup> Day High Sabbath

#### The Eighth Day

- ...and the eighth-day shall be a set apart convocation to you; and ye shall offer whole-burnt-offerings to 4742: it is a time of release, ye shall do no servile work. (Leviticus 23:36, LXXE)
  - "a time of release" (N/A, ἐξόδιόν), final\*, end, solemn assembly
- And on the eighth day there shall be to you a <u>release</u>
   (ἐξόδιόν): ye shall do no servile work in it. (Numbers 29:35,
   LXXE)
- The day is also less well known as <u>Addition</u>.
  - And its name was called "Addition," because that it was recorded amongst the days of the feast days, according to the number of the days of the year. (Jubilees 32:29)

## The Eighth Day Historical Accounts

- Upon the f fteenth day of the same month, when the season of the year is changing for winter, the law enjoins us to pitch tabernacles ... On the eighth day all work was laid aside... (Josephus, Antiquities of the Jews, Book III, Chapter 10.4)
- The last of all the annual festivals is that which is called the feast of tabernacles, which is fixed for the season of the autumnal equinox... And after the festival has lasted seven days, he adds an eighth as a seal, calling it a kind of crowning feast, not only as it would seem to this festival, but also to all the feasts of the year which we have enumerated; for it is the last feast of the year, and is a very stable and holy sort of conclusion, befitting men who have now received all the produce from the land, and who are no longer in perplexity and apprehension respecting any barrenness or scarcity. (Philo, Book 28, The Special Laws II)

#### The Book of Jubilees

- Between 1947 and 1956, approximately 15 copies of the "Book of Jubilees" were found among the Dead Sea Scrolls. This is second only in number to Psalms, Deuteronomy, Isaiah, Exodus, and Genesis, and far greater than any other extra-biblical text found there, including "The Book of Enoch". (The Book of Jubilees: Re-Presented by Robert Bagley III)
- The original Hebrew text survives only in fragments found in the Dead Sea Scrolls at Qumran. Up until their discovery, the work was known only from an Ethiopic translation of the whole and incomplete versions in Latin and Syriac. The fact that the surviving Hebrew fragments are from at least 12 different caves indicates that the Book enjoyed considerable popularity among the Qumran community. (The Oxford Dictionary of the Christian Church, s.v. "Jubilees, Book of." Page 905.)
- The book of Jubilee (Kufale, i.e. Division) otherwise known as the Little Genesis has also been preserved entire only in the Ethiopic (Bible)... (https://www.ethiopianorthodox.org/english/canonical/books.html)

## The Eighth Day A New Name for Jacob

- And Aluhiym appeared to Jacob once more... and Aluhiym blessed him. And Aluhiym said to him, Thy name shall not be called Jacob, but <u>Israel shall be thy name</u>; and He called his name Israel. (Genesis 35:9-10, LXXE)
  - And he went up on the new month of the seventh month to Bethel... on the twenty-second day of this month, Jacob resolved to build that place, and to surround the court with a wall, and to sanctify it and make it set apart for ever, for himself and his children after him. And appeared to him by night and blessed him and said unto him: "Thy name shall not be called Jacob, but Israel shall they name thy name." (Jubilees 31:3/ 32:16-17)

### The Eighth Day The Promise of Eternal Inheritance

- And Aluhiym said to him, I am thy Aluhiym; increase and multiply; for nations and gatherings of nations shall be of thee, and kings shall come out of thy loins. And the land which I gave to Abraham and Isaac, I have given it to thee; and it shall come to pass that I will give this land also to thy seed after thee. And Aluhiym went up from him from the place where He spoke with him. (Genesis 35:11-13, LXXE)
  - And He said unto him again: I am 🌂 who created the heaven and the earth, and I shall increase thee and multiply thee exceedingly, and kings will come forth from thee, and they will judge everywhere wherever the foot of the sons of men hath trodden... and after that they will get possession of the whole earth and inherit it for ever. And He finished speaking with him, and He went up from him, and Jacob looked till He had ascended into heaven. (Jubilees 32:18-20)

# The Eighth Day The Day of Addition

• ...he sacrificed thereon according to all that he sacrificed on the former days, and called its name "Addition," for this day was added, and the former days he called "The Feast." And thus it was manifested that it should be, and it is written on the heavenly tables: wherefore it was revealed to him that he should celebrate it, and add it to the seven days of the feast. And its name was called "Addition," because that it was recorded amongst the days of the feast days, according to the number of the days of the year. (Jubilees 32:27-29)



### David was the Eighth

• And Jessae caused <u>his seven sons</u> to pass before Samuel: and Samuel said, \*\*\*\* has not chosen these. And Samuel said to Jessae, Hast thou no more sons? And Jessae said, [There is] <u>yet a little one; behold, he tends the flock...</u> And \*\*\*\*\* said to Samuel, Arise, and anoint <u>David...</u> (1 Samuel 16:10-12, LXXE)




Now therefore so shalt thou <u>say unto My servant</u>
 <u>David...</u> And <u>thine house and thy kingdom shall</u>

 <u>be established for ever</u> before thee: <u>thy throne</u>
 <u>shall be established for ever</u>. (2 Samuel 7:12/16)

 English mathematician John Wallis is credited with introducing the infinity symbol with its mathematical meaning in 1655, in his De sectionibus conicis nova methodo expositis.

### Solomon's Dedication of the Temple

 And on the eighth day he kept a solemn assembly (ἐξόδιον): for he kept a feast of seven days as the dedication of the altar. And on the twenty-third day of the seventh month he dismissed the people to their tents, rejoicing, and with a glad heart because of the good deeds which afaz had done to David, and to Solomon, and to Israel His people. (2 Chronicles 7:9-10, LXXE)



# The Eighth Day After Returning From Babylon

And [Esdras] read in the book of the law of Aluhiym daily, from the first day even to the last day: and they kept the feast seven days; and on the eighth day a solemn assembly, (ἐξόδιον) according to the ordinance. (Nehemiah 8:18, LXXE)



### The Covenant with Abraham And The Eighth Day

- And this [is] the covenant which thou shalt fully keep between Me and you, and between thy seed after thee for their generations;
   every male of you shall be circumcised...it shall be for a sign of a covenant between Me and you. And the child of eight days [old] shall be circumcised by you, every male throughout your generations... (Genesis 17:10-12, LXXE)
  - ...in the third month, in the middle of the month, <u>Abram celebrated the feast of the first-fruits of the grain harvest</u>... And ATAL appeared to Abram, and said to him: I am ATAL Almighty; approve yourself before Me and be you perfect. And I will make My covenant between Me and you, and I will multiply you exceedingly... <u>I shall establish My covenant between Me and you, and your seed after you, throughout their generations, for an eternal covenant</u>... (Jubilees 15:1/3-4/9)
- Speak to the children of Israel...Whatsoever woman shall have conceived and born a male child... on the eighth day she shall circumcise the flesh of his... (Leviticus 12:2-3, LXXE)



### The Covenant of Circumcision And The Eighth Day

- And <a href="#">Afathy Aluhiym will circumcise thine heart, and the heart</a>
   of thy seed, to love <a href="#">Afathy Aluhiym with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, that thou mayest live</a>. (Deuteronomy 30:6)
  - ...Aluhiym, who also hath given unto us the earnest of the Spirit.
     (2 Corinthians 5:5)
  - And no man putteth new wine into old bottles; else the new wine will burst the bottles, and be spilled, and the bottles shall perish. But new wine must be put into new bottles; and both are preserved. (Luke 5:37-38)
- And I will give you a new heart, and will put a new spirit in you:
   and I will take away the heart of stone out of your flesh, and will
   give you a heart of flesh. And I will put My Spirit in you, and will
   cause you to walk in Mine ordinances, and to keep My judgments,
   and do [them]. And ye shall dwell upon the land which I gave to
   your fathers; and ye shall be to Me a people, and I will be to you
   Aluhiym. (Ezekiel 36:26-28, LXXE)

### The Eighth Day The Promise of Circumcision

- Every man child... it shall be a token of the covenant betwixt Me and you... he that is eight days old shall be circumcised... (Genesis 17:10-12)
- And in the eighth day the flesh of his foreskin shall be circumcised. (Leviticus 12:3)
- And when <u>eight days were accomplished for the circumcising</u> of the child, His name was called @\f\[4\ldot\]... (Luke 2:21)
  - This rite was performed on Messiah (being born on the first day of Booths) on The Eighth Day.

### Tabernacles and The Eighth Day in The Gospel of John


- Now the Feast of Tabernacles was at hand. (John 7:2)
- But when His brethren were gone up, then went He also up unto the Feast, not openly, but as it were in secret. (John 7:10)
- Now about the midst of the feast ๑๙६९० went up into the temple, and taught. (John 7:14)
- In the last day, that great day of the Feast, @\forall \( \sigma \) stood and cried, saying If any man thirst, let him come unto Me, and drink (John 7:37)
- - Ye shall dwell in booths seven days... (Leviticus 23:42)
- And <u>early in the morning</u> He came again into the temple, and all the people came unto Him; and He sat down, and taught them. (John 8:2)

#### Feast of Tabernacles in John

- He also up unto the Feast, not openly, but as it were in secret. (John 7:10)
- ...about the midst of the feast one went up into the temple, and taught... My doctrine is not Mine, but His that sent Me... Why go ye about to kill Me? (John 7:14/16/19)
- On the last day, that great day of the Feast, @→f為レ stood and cried out... He who believes in Me... out of his heart will flow rivers of living water. (John 7:37-38, NKJV)
  - ... new wine into new bottles ... (Matthew 9:17)






### The Eighth Day

- John 8:2 John 10:21 documents the prophetic teachings and good works of Messiah during the Eighth Day.
  - Forgiveness of the adulterous woman (writings on the ground)
  - Providing further witness of Himself as The Prophet, and I AM
  - Teaching on the Light and judgement







## Messiah on The Eighth Day Judgement

- answered them, Verily! I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin. And the servant abideth not in the house for ever: but the Son abideth ever. (John 8:34-35)
- Ye judge after the flesh; I judge no man. And yet if I judge, My judgment is true: for I am not alone, but I and the Father that sent Me. (John 8:15-16)
- I have many things to say and to judge of you: but He that sent Me is true; and I speak to the world those things which I have heard of Him. (John 8:26)
- And I seek not Mine own glory: there is One that seeketh and judgeth. (John 8:50)
- And anti-said, For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind. (John 9:39)



### Amalek – The Enemy of Israel

- And <u>Amalek came and fought with Israel</u> in Raphidin. And Moses said to Joshua, <u>Choose out for thyself mighty men, and go forth and set the army in array against Amalek</u> to-morrow; and, behold, I [shall] stand on the top of the hill, and the <u>rod of Aluhiym</u> [will be] in my hand. (Exodus 17:8-9, LXXE)
- Remember what things Amalek did to thee by the way, when thou wentest forth out of the land of Egypt: how he withstood thee in the way, and harassed thy rear, [even] those that were weary behind thee, and thou didst hunger and wast weary; and he did not fear Aluhiym. And it shall come to pass whenever \*\* thy Aluhiym shall have given thee rest from all thine enemies round about thee, in the land which \*\* thy Aluhiym gives thee to inherit, thou shalt blot out the name of Amalek from under heaven, and shalt not forget [to do it]. (Deuteronomy 25:17-19, LXXE)
  - Be sober, be vigilant; <u>because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:</u>
     Resist him... (1 Peter 5:8-9)

### The Final Judgement For hasatan

- But the hands of Moses were heavy, and they took a stone and put it under him, and he sat upon it; and Aaron and Or <u>supported his</u> hands one on this side and the other on that, and the hands of Moses were supported till the going down of the sun. And <u>Joshua routed Amalek and all his people with the slaughter of the sword.</u> (Exodus 17:12-13, LXXE)
- And Afa said to Moses, Write this for a memorial in a book, and speak [this] in the ears of Joshua; for I will utterly blot out the memorial of Amalek from under heaven. (Exodus 17:14, LXXE)
- And when the thousand years are expired, satan shall be loosed out of his prison... And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever. (Revelation 20:7/10)

### The Amorites Destroyed

- Then Joshua spoke to 4542, in the day in which 4542 delivered the Amorite into the power of Israel, when He destroyed them in Gabaon, and they were destroyed from before the children of Israel: and Joshua said, Let the sun stand over against Gabaon, and the moon over against the valley of Aelon. And the sun and the moon stood still, until Aluhiym executed vengeance on their enemies; and the sun stood still in the midst of heaven; it did not proceed to set till the end of one day. And there was not such a day either before or after, so that Aluhiym should hearken to a man, because Afat fought on the side of Israel. (Joshua 10:12-14, LXXE)
  - ...Thus saith 🌂 to Jerusalem; Thy root and thy birth are of the land of Chanaan: thy father was an Amorite, and thy mother a Chettite. (Ezekiel 16:3, LXXE)
  - And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire. (Revelation 20:15)

### The Eighth Day Is... The Final Judgement

- For the end, a Psalm of David, concerning the secrets of the Son...

  \*f\*\* endures for ever: He has prepared His throne for judgment.

  And He will judge the world in righteousness, He will judge the nations in uprightness... And let them that know Thy name hope in Thee: for Thou, O \*f\*\*, hast not failed them that diligently seek Thee ...Let sinners be driven away into Hades... (Psalm 9:1/8-9/11/18, LXXE)
- And I saw a great white throne, and Him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before Aluhiym; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life. and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire. (Revelation 20:11-12/15)



### The Parable of the Tares A Solemn Assembly

 the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels. As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire: so shall it be in the end of this world. The Son of man shall send forth His angels, and they shall gather out of His kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity: And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth. Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Who hath ears to hear, let him hear. (Matthew 13:40-43)



#### The Sheep

• When the Son of man shall come in His glory, and all the set apart angels with Him, then shall He sit upon the throne of His glory: And before Him shall be gathered all nations: and He shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth His sheep from the goats: And He shall set the sheep on His right hand, but the goats on the left. Then shall the King say unto them on His right hand, Come, ye blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was an hungred, and ye gave Me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave Me drink... (Matthew 25:31-35)





#### The Goats



- Then shall He say also unto them on the left hand, <u>Depart from Me</u>, <u>ye cursed</u>, <u>into everlasting fire</u>, prepared for the devil and his angels: For I was an hungred, and ye gave Me no meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave Me no drink... (Matthew 25:41-42)
- Not every one that saith unto Me, Lord! shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of My Father which is in heaven. Many will say to Me in that day, Lord! have we not prophesied in Thy name? and in Thy name have cast out devils? and in Thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from Me, ye that work iniquity. (Matthew 7:21-23)
- There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of Aluhiym, and you yourselves thrust out. (Luke 13:28)
- And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal. (Matthew 25:46)

#### Then Comes the Final

- ...Thou hast set Him over the works of Thy hands: Thou hast put all things under His feet: (Psalm 8:7, LXXE)
  - Then cometh the end, when He shall have delivered up the kingdom to Aluhiym, even the Father; when He shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. For He must reign, till He hath put all enemies under His feet. The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death. For He hath put all things under His feet... And when all things shall be subdued unto Him, then shall the Son also Himself be subject unto Him that put all things under Him, that Aluhiym may be all in all. (1 Corinthians 15:24-28)
  - And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. (Revelation 20:14)
  - And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of Aluhiym is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people, and Aluhiym Himself shall be with them, and be their Aluhiym. (Revelation 21:3)

### The Eighth Day... Comes Down From Heaven

- And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. And I John saw the set apart city, New Jerusalem, coming down from Aluhiym out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. (Revelation 21:1-2)
- ...Come, ye blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. (Matthew 25:34)



#### New Jerusalem - Which Gate Is Yours?

- I AM... the beginning and the end, the first and the last.

  Blessed are they that do His commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city. (Revelation 22:13-14)
  - I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel. (Matthew 15:24)
- ...the set apart Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from El... And had a wall great and high, and had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel: (Revelation 21:10/12)





#### I AM - The Light of the World

- ...the sun stood still in the midst of heaven...there was not such a day either before or after (Joshua 10:13, LXXE)
- And thou shalt no more have the sun for a light by day, nor shall the rising of the moon lighten thy night; but \*f\*\* shall be thine everlasting light, and Aluhiym thy glory. For the sun shall no more set, nor shall the moon be eclipsed; for \*f\*\* shall be thine everlasting light, and the days of thy mourning shall be completed. Thy people also shall be all righteous; they shall inherit the land for ever, preserving that which they have planted, [even] the works of their hands, for glory. (Isaiah 60:19-21, LXXE)
- And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it:
   for the glory of Aluhiym did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light
   thereof... and They shall reign for ever and ever. (Revelation 21:23; 22:5)
- And Aluhiym said, Let there be light, and there was light. And Aluhiym saw the light that it was good... (Genesis 1:3, LXXE)
- <u>I AM the light of the world</u>: he that followeth Me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life. (John 8:12)

# The Eighth Day Is... The Final Restoration of All Things

- And He that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things
   new... And He said unto me, It is done. I am the Aleph and the
   Taw, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is
   athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely. (Revelation 21:5-6)
- And he shewed me <u>a pure river of water of life</u>, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of Aluhiym and of the Lamb. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there <u>the tree of life</u>, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month... (Revelation 22:1-2)



# The Eighth Day Is... The Final Restoration of All Things

- ... | make all things new... (Revelation 21:5)
  - For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Master <sup>②</sup>✓★ Messiah, who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body... (Philippians 3:20-21, NKJV)
  - And <u>I will give you a new heart</u>, and will put a new spirit in you:

# The Eighth Day Is... Eternity in New Jerusalem

Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of My Aluhiym, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of My Aluhiym, and the name of the city of My Aluhiym, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from My Aluhiym: and I will write

upon him My new name. (Revelation 3:12)

And they shall dwell in their land, which I have given to My servant Jacob, where their fathers dwelt; and they shall dwell upon it: and David My servant [shall be their] prince forever. and I will establish My sanctuary in the midst of them for ever. (Ezekiel 37:25-26, LXXE)

# The Eighth Day Is... Eternal Joy

- From of old we have not heard, neither have our eyes seen an Aluhiym beside Thee, and Thy works which Thou wilt perform to them that wait for mercy. For [these blessings] shall happen to them that work righteousness, and they shall remember Thy ways... (Isaiah 64:4-5, LXXE)
  - But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which Aluhiym hath prepared for them that <u>love Him</u>. (1 Corinthians 2:9)

# The Eighth Day Is... Eternal Joy

- ...for they shall forget the former affliction, it shall not come into their mind. For there shall be a new heaven and a new earth: and they shall not at all remember the former, neither shall they at all come into their mind. But they shall find in her joy and exultation; for, behold, I make Jerusalem a rejoicing, and My people a joy. And I will rejoice in Jerusalem, and will be glad in My people: and there shall no more be heard in her the voice of weeping, or the voice of crying. (Isaiah 65:16-19, LXXE)
