The Feasts of afaz

- And And
 - "feasts" (H4150, מועדי), an appointment, a fixed time or season, a year, a signal, feast, an assembly (by implication),
- - The Spring Feasts contain the shadow of the events that were performed by Messiah during His First Coming, on the very day of the feast associated with that event.
 - The Fall Feasts contain the shadow of the events that <u>Messiah</u> <u>will complete</u> beginning with His Second Coming, on the very same day of the feast!

The Feasts of afaz

- For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect. (Hebrews 10:1)
- For we know in part, and we prophesy in part. But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away... For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face. Now I know in part, but then shall I will know... (1 Corinthians 13:12)
- Let no man therefore judge you in eating, or in drinking, or with respect to a feast day or a new month or Sabbath, which are a shadow of the things to come; but the body is Messiah's. (Colossions 2:16-17 – HNV)



The Day of Trumpets

- Day of Trumpets (Yom Taruah), יום תרועה
 - Taruah (H8643, תרועה), defined as:
 - clamor, i.e. <u>acclamation of joy</u> or a battle-cry; especially clangor of trumpets, as an alarm:
 - alarm
 - blowing (of, the) (trumpets)
 - joy, jubile, loud noise, rejoicing, <u>shouting</u>, (high, joyful) sounding
- Also known as the Day of Shouting

The Day of Trumpets

- Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a Sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, a set apart convocation. Ye shall do no servile work therein: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto AFA2. (Leviticus 23:24-25)
- And in the seventh month, on the first day of the month, ye shall have a set apart convocation; ye shall do no servile work: it is a day of blowing the trumpets unto you. (Numbers 29:1)

The Day of Trumpets A Celebration!

- For the end... Rejoice ye in Elohiym our helper: shout aloud to the Elohi of Jacob. Take a psalm, and produce the timbrel, the pleasant psaltery with the harp. Blow the trumpet at the new month, in the glorious day of your feast. (Psalm 81:1-3 - LXXE)
 - "psalm" (H2172 זמרה), a musical melody or song to be accompanied by an instrument
 - "timbrel" (H8596, תף), a tambourine
 - "harp" (H3658, כנור), a harp, to twang
 - "psaltery" (H5035, נבל), a lyre (as having a body of like form as a vase)
 - "trumpet" (H7782, שופר), a cornet (as giving a clear sound) or curved horn

The Book of Jubilees

- Between 1947 and 1956, approximately <u>15 copies of the "Book of Jubilees" were found among the Dead Sea Scrolls</u>. This is <u>second only in number to Psalms</u>, <u>Deuteronomy</u>, <u>Isaiah</u>, <u>Exodus</u>, and <u>Genesis</u>, and far greater than any other extra-biblical text found there, including "The Book of Enoch". (The Book of Jubilees: Re-Presented by Robert Bagley III)
- The original Hebrew text survives only in fragments found in the Dead Sea Scrolls at Qumran. Up until their discovery, the work was known only from an Ethiopic translation of the whole and incomplete versions in Latin and Syriac. The fact that the surviving Hebrew fragments are from at least 12 different caves indicates that the Book enjoyed considerable popularity among the Qumran <u>community</u>. (The Oxford Dictionary of the Christian Church, s.v. "Jubilees, Book of." Page 905.)
- <u>The book of Jubilee</u> (Kufale, i.e. Division) otherwise known as the Little Genesis <u>has also been preserved entire only in the Ethiopic</u> (Bible)... (https://www.ethiopianorthodox.org/english/canonical/books.html)

Day of Trumpets Noah and the Flood

 ...And <u>on the new month of the seventh month all the</u> mouths of the abysses of the earth were opened, and the waters began to descend into them. (Jubilees 6:26)



Day of Trumpets Abram Declares the Most High

...<u>Abram sat up</u> throughout the night <u>on the new month of the</u> <u>seventh month</u> to observe the stars from the evening to the morning, in order to see what would be the character of the year with regard to the rains... And a word came into his heart and he said: <u>All the signs of</u> the stars, and the signs of the moon and of the sun are all in the hand of <u>AfA</u>. Why do I search them out?.. And he prayed that night and said, <u>'My Sovereign Ruler</u>, <u>AfA</u> Most High, You alone are my <u>Sovereign Ruler</u>, <u>And You and Your dominion have I chosen</u>. (Jubilees 12:16-17)



Day of Trumpets Abram Asks to Walk the Path of 3132

- And <u>Terah took Abram his son, and Lot</u> the son of Haran his son's son, and Sarai his daughter in law, <u>his son Abram's wife</u>; <u>and they went forth with them from Ur</u> of the Chaldees, to go into the land of Canaan; <u>and they came unto Haran, and dwelt</u> <u>there</u>. (Genesis 11:31)
- Deliver me from the hands of evil spirits who have dominion over the thoughts of men's hearts, and let them not lead me astray from You, my Sovereign Ruler. And establish You me and my seed forever that we go not astray from henceforth and forevermore.'... 'Shall I return unto Ur of the Chaldees who seek my face that I may return to them, am I to remain here in this place? The right path before You prosper it in the hands of Your servant that he may fulfill it and that I may not walk in the deceitfulness of my heart, O afat my Sovereign Ruler.' ... behold the word of afat was sent... (Jubilees 12:19-21)

Day of Trumpets Promises to Abram

- Now AFA had said unto Abram, <u>Get thee out of thy</u> <u>country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's</u> <u>house, unto a land that I will shew thee</u>: And <u>I will make of</u> <u>thee a great nation</u>, and <u>I will bless thee</u>, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing: And <u>I will bless</u> <u>them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee</u>: and <u>in</u> <u>thee shall all families of the earth be blessed</u>. (Genesis 12:1-3)
 - 'Get you up from your country, and from your kindred and from the house of your father unto a land which I will show you, and I shall make you a great and numerous nation....And I will be a Sovereign Ruler to you and your son, and to your son's son, and to all your seed: fear not, from henceforth and unto all generations of the earth I am 🍕 🖘 your Sovereign Ruler.' (Jubilees 12:22/24)

Day of Trumpets Abram Receives the Pure Language

 And ATA Almighty said: 'Open his mouth and his ears, that he may hear and speak with his mouth, with the language which has been revealed'; for it had ceased from the mouths of all the children of men from the day of the overthrow (of Babel). And I opened his mouth, and his ears and his lips, and I began to speak with him in Hebrew in the tongue of the creation. And he took the books of his fathers, and these were written in Hebrew, and he transcribed them, and he began from henceforth to study them... (Jubilees 12:25-27)



The Day of Trumpets Isaac's Prophecies

Jacob's Sanctification Before The Day of Trumpets

- And Elohiym said unto Jacob, Arise, go up to Bethel, and dwell there: and make there an altar unto Elohiym, that appeared unto thee when thou fleddest from the face of Esau thy brother. <u>Then Jacob said unto</u> his household, and to all that were with him, <u>Put away the strange</u> gods that are among you, and <u>be clean</u>, and <u>change your</u> <u>garments</u>: (Genesis 35:1-2)
- And on the new month of the month (Note: this would be the sixth month) Yacob spoke to all the people of his house. saying: 'Purify yourselves and change your garments, and let us arise and go up to Bethel, where I vowed a vow to Him on the day when I fled from the face of Esau my brother, because He has been with me and brought me into this land in shalom, and put you away the strange gods that are among you.'And they gave up the strange gods and that which was in their ears and which was on their necks and the idols which Rachel stole from Laban her father she gave wholly to Yacob. And he burnt and brake them to pieces and destroyed them, and hid them under an oak which is in the land of Shechem. (Jubilees 31:1-2)

The Day of Trumpets Isaac's Prophecy to Levi

- And <u>he went up on the new month of the seventh month to</u> <u>Bethel</u>. And he built an altar at the place where he had slept, and he set up a pillar there... And <u>Yacob</u> went to... the house of his father Abraham, and <u>he took two of his sons with him, Levi</u> and Yahudah, and he came to his father Yitschaq and to his mother Rebecca. (Jubilees 31:3/5)
- And the spirit of prophecy came down into his mouth,... And he turned to Levi first, and began to bless him first, and said to him: May the ALMIGHTY of all, the very 🍕 🖘 of all the ages, bless you and your children throughout all the ages. And may 🍕 🎝 give to you and to your seed greatness and great splendor, and cause you and your seed, from among all flesh, to approach Him to serve in His sanctuary as the messangers of the presence and as the set apart ones. (Even) as they, shall the seed of your sons be for splendor and greatness and sanctification, and may He make them great unto all the ages. (Jubilees 31:12-14)

The Day of Trumpets Isaac's Prophecy to Levi

 And they shall be judges and princes, and chiefs of all the seed of the sons of Yacob; They shall speak the word of afat in righteousness, And they shall judge all His judgments in righteousness. And they shall declare My ways to Yacob And My paths to Yisrael. The blessing of AFA2 shall be given in their mouths To bless all the seed of the beloved. Your mother has called your name Levi, And justly has she called your name; You shall be joined to AFAT And be the companion of all the sons of Yacob; Let His table be yours, And do you and your sons eat thereof; And may your table be full unto all generations, And your food fail not unto all the ages. And let all who hate you fall down before you, And let all your adversaries be rooted out and perish; And blessed be he that blesses you, And cursed be every nation that curses **YOU.'** (Jubilees 31:15-17)

The Day of Trumpets Isaac's Prophecy to Judah

• And to Yahudah he said: 'May afat give you strength and power To tread down all that hate you; A prince shall you be, you and one of your sons, over the sons of Yacob; May your name and the name of your sons go forth and traverse every land and region. Then shall the Gentiles fear before your face, and all the nations shall quake [And all the peoples shall quake]. In you shall be the help of Yacob, And in you be found the salvation of Yisrael. And when you sit on the throne of honor of your righteousness, There shall be great shalom for all the seed of the sons of the beloved; Blessed be he that blesses you, And all that hate you and afflict you and curse you Shall be rooted out and destroyed from the earth and be accursed... And he went forth from between his feet and fell down and bowed down to him, and he blessed them and rested there with Yitschag his father that night, and they eat and drank with joy... And Yacob told his father everything during the night, how AFAT had shown him great mercy, and how he had prospered (him in) all his ways, and protected him from all evil. (Jubilees 31:18-20/22/24)

The Day of Trumpets Eternal Hope

 And Yacob remembered the prayer with which his father had blessed him and his two sons, Levi and Yahudah, and he rejoiced and blessed AFAT the ALMIGHTY of his fathers, Abraham and Yitschaq. And he said: 'Now I know that I have an eternal hope, and my sons also, before the ALMIGHTY of all'; and thus is it ordained concerning the two; and they record it as an eternal testimony unto them on the heavenly tablets how Yitschag blessed them. (Jubilees 31:31-32)

The Day of Trumpets Joseph

The Day of Trumpets Joseph

- Blow the trumpet at the new month, in the glorious day of your feast. (Psalm 81:1-3 - LXXE)
- For this was a statute for Israel, and a law of the Elohiym of Jacob. This He ordained in Joseph for a testimony, when he went out through the land of Egypt: where I heard a language that I understood not. I removed his shoulder from the burden: his hands were delivered from the pots. Thou calledst in trouble, and I delivered thee; I answered thee in the secret place of thunder: I proved thee at the waters of Meribah. Selah. (Psalm 81:4-7)

The Day of Trumpets Joseph

- Then Pharaoh sent and called Joseph, and they brought him hastily out of the dungeon... (Genesis 41:14)
- And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I have dreamed a dream...And Pharaoh said unto his servants, Can we find such a one as this is, a man in whom the Spirit of Elohiym is? And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, See, I have set thee over all the land of Egypt. And Pharaoh took off his ring from his hand, and put it upon Joseph's hand, and arrayed him in vestures of fine linen, and put a gold chain about his neck; And he made him to ride in the second chariot which he had; and they cried before him, Bow the knee: and he made him ruler over all the land of Egypt. And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I am Pharaoh, and without thee shall no man lift up his hand or foot in all the land of Egypt. (Genesis 41:15/38-41)

The Day of Trumpets Just Left Babylon

And when the seventh month was come, and the children of Israel were in the cities, the people gathered themselves together as one man to Jerusalem. Then stood up Yeshua the son of Jozadak, and his brethren the priests, and Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and his brethren, and builded the altar of the Elohiym of Israel, to offer burnt offerings thereon, as it is written in the law of Moses the man of Elohiym... From the first day of the seventh month began they to offer burnt offerings unto the ৰাজ not yet laid. (Ezra 3:1-2/6)



The Day of Trumpets Worshipping Our Father

 And all the people gathered themselves together as one man into the street that was before the water gate; and they spake unto Ezra the scribe to bring the book of the law of Moses, which the afat had commanded to Israel. And Ezra the priest brought the law before the congregation both of men and women, and all that could hear with understanding, upon the first day of the seventh month. And he read therein before the street that was before the water gate from the morning until midday...and the ears of all the people were attentive unto the book of the law... And Ezra opened the book... and when he opened it, all the people stood up: And Ezra blessed the afa, the great Elohivm. And all the people answered, Amein, Amein, with lifting up their hands: and they bowed their heads, and worshipped afaz with their faces to the ground... Also Yeshua... and the Levites, caused the people to understand the law (Nehemiah 8:1-3/5-7)

The Day of Trumpets A Celebration!


 This day is Set Apart unto ふそうえ your Elohiym; mourn not, nor weep ... Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is Set Apart unto our Adon: neither be ye sorry; for the joy of afaz is your strength. ...And all the people went their way to eat, and to drink, and to send portions, and to make great mirth, because they had understood the words that were declared unto them. (Nehemiah 8:9-10/12)

A Memorial of Blowing of Trumpets

 And AFAI said unto Moses, Go unto the people, and sanctify them to day and to morrow, and let them wash their clothes, And be ready against the third day: for the third day afaz will come down in the sight of all the people upon mount Sinai. And Moses went down from the mount unto the people, and sanctified the people; and they washed their clothes. And he said unto the people, Be ready against the third day... Take heed to yourselves, that ye go not up into the mount, or touch the border of it: whoever toucheth the mount shall be surely put to death... when the trumpet soundeth long, they shall come up to the mount. (Exodus 19:10-13)

A Memorial of Blowing of Trumpets

• And it came to pass <u>on the third day</u> in the morning, that there were thunders and lightnings, and <u>a thick cloud upon the mount</u>, and <u>the voice of the trumpet exceeding loud</u>; so that all the people that was in the camp trembled... And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because **AFA** descended upon it in fire... And when <u>the voice of the trumpet sounded long</u>, and <u>waxed louder and louder</u>, Moses spake, and Elohiym answered him by a voice... and <u>AFA</u> called Moses up to the top of the <u>mount</u>; and Moses went up. (Exodus 19:16/18-20)



The Day of Trumpets: Summary (so far)

- A day the floods and destruction of the earth began to recede (Noah)
- A day that Abram reached up in faith, was blessed, told to go to a promised land, and was given the pure language (Abraham)
- A day that Levi and Judah were blessed to have the seed of judges princes, and chiefs being close to
 at a great kingdom (Isaac, Jacob, Levi, and Judah)
- A day that delivered Joseph from prison and elevated him to second in the kingdom (Joseph)
- A day to remember and a law to be kept forever (Moses)
- A day for great celebrations (David)
- A day that the children of Israel, after just leaving Babylon, gather in Jerusalem and build the altar of Elohiym (Yeshua the son of Yozedek)
- A day that the people worshipped
 A day that the people worshipped
 Inderstanding of it, and celebrated (Ezra and Nehemia)

Daniel's Resurrection Vision

 And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book. And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever. (Daniel 12:1-3)

There Are Two Resurrections

- And AFA spake unto Moses, saying, <u>Make thee two trumpets</u> of silver; of a whole piece shalt thou make them: that thou mayest use them for the calling of the assembly, and for the journeying of the camps. And <u>when they shall blow with them,</u> all the assembly shall assemble themselves to thee at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. And <u>if they blow with</u> one, then the princes, heads of the thousands of Israel, shall gather themselves unto thee. (Numbers 10:1-4)
- Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which <u>all that are in</u> the graves shall hear <u>His voice</u>, And shall come forth; <u>they that have</u> <u>done good</u>, unto the resurrection of life; and <u>they that have done</u> <u>evil</u>, unto the resurrection of damnation</u>. (John 5:28-29)
- The first resurrection is only for the righteous and faithful, called to be princes, judges, and priests in His Millennial Kingdom.
- The second resurrection is for all remaining mankind

Be Chosen

- And he spake unto Korah and unto all his company, saying, Even tomorrow 🍕 🖘 will show who are His, and who is set apart; and will cause him to come near unto Him: even him whom He hath chosen will He cause to come near unto Him. (Numbers 16:5)
- So the last shall be first, and the first last: for many be called, but few chosen. (Matthew 20:16)
- ...there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. For many are called, but few chosen. (Matthew 22:13-14)
- And except that
 Af
 had shortened those days, no flesh should be saved: but for the elect's sake, whom He hath chosen, He hath shortened the days. (Mark 13:20)

Be Chosen !!

- Thus spoke they that feared is, every one to his neighbour: and if is gave heed, and hearkened, and <u>He wrote a book of</u> remembrance before Him for them that feared is is and reverenced His name. And they shall be Mine, saith is is Almighty, in the day which I appoint for a peculiar possession; and I will make choice of them, as a man makes choice of his son that serves him. Then shall Ye return, and discern between the righteous and the wicked, and between him that serves Elohiym, and him that serves Him not. (Malachi 3:16-18, LXXE)
 - "a peculiar" The Greek verse has no word(s) to support this text

- "possession" (G4047, περιποίησιν), preservation, obtaining, possession, saving
- For, behold, a day comes burning as an oven, and it shall consume them; and all the aliens, and all that do wickedly... <u>But to you that fear</u> <u>My name shall the Sun of righteousness arise, and healing shall</u> <u>be in His wings</u>... <u>Remember the law</u> of My servant Moses... <u>for all</u> <u>Israel</u>, even the commandments and ordinances. (Malachi 4:1-2/4, LXXE)
- Go ye therefore and teach all nations... to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you... (Matthew 28:19-20)

The Joyful Sound

- Thine is the mighty arm: let Thy hand be strengthened, let <u>Thy right hand be exalted</u>. Justice and judgment are the establishment of Thy throne: mercy and truth shall go before Thy face. Blessed is the people that knows the joyful sound: they shall walk, O ATA, in the light of Thy countenance. (Psalm 88:13-14/15, LXXE)
 - "the joyful sound" (H8643, תרועה), defined as acclimation of joy, <u>blowing of trumpets</u>, <u>shouting</u>, <u>joyful sound</u>
 - countenance (H6440, פנים), defined as <u>face</u>, countenance
 - ...and <u>His countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.</u> (Revelation 1:16)
- ...I have exalted One chosen out of My people... I have annointed Him by My set apart mercy... The enemy shall have no advantage against Him; and the son of transgression shall not hurt Him again. (Psalm 88:19-20/22, LXXE)

The Joyful Sound

- Blessed is the people that knows the joyful sound... And in Thy name shall they rejoice all the day: and in Thy righteousness shall they be exalted. For Thou art the boast of their strength; and in Thy good pleasure shall our horn be exalted, for our help is of AFA; and of the Set Apart One of Israel, our king. (Psalm 88:15-18, LXXE)
- Thus saith 🍕 🍕, Keep ye judgment, and do justice: for My salvation is near to come, and My mercy to be revealed. <u>Blessed is the man</u> <u>that does these things, and the man that holds by them, and</u> <u>keeps the Sabbaths from profaning them, and keeps his hands</u> <u>from doing unrighteousness</u>. (Isaiah 56:1-2, LXXE)
- Now <u>faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things</u> not seen... But <u>without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*</u>: for he that cometh to EI must believe that He is, and *that <u>He is a rewarder</u>* <u>of them that diligently seek Him</u>. (Hebrews 11:1/7)
- And now, little children, <u>abide in Him; that, when He shall appear, we may have confidence, and not be ashamed before Him at His coming</u>.
 If ye know that He is righteous, ye know that <u>every one that doeth</u> <u>righteousness is born of Him</u>. (1 John 2:28-29)

The Terrible Sound

Afaz, have mercy upon us; for we have trusted in Thee: the seed of the rebellious is gone to destruction, but our deliverance (G4991) was in a time of affliction. By reason of the terrible sound (G5401) (G5456)(G4675) the nations were dismayed for fear of Thee (G4675), and the heathen were scattered. And now shall the spoils of Your small and great be gathered: as if one should gather locusts, so shall they mock You. The Elohiym who dwells on high is set apart: Sion is filled with judgment and righteousness. They shall be delivered up to the law: our salvation (G4991) is our treasure: there are wisdom and knowledge and piety (G2150) toward afaz these are the treasures of righteousness. (Isaiah 33:2-6, LXXE)

- deliverance (G4991, σωτηρία), salvation, deliverance, rescue
- sound (G5456, φωνήν), noise, sound, voice
- terrible (G5401, φόβου), to be put in fear, alarm or fright, be afraid + exceedingly, fear, terror
- piety (G2150, εὐσέβεια) fidelity to obligations, dutiful, reverence
- "of You" (G4675, σου), genitive case of you (of you, your)

The Terrible Sound

- There shall be one law for you and for the strangers abiding among you, a perpetual law for your generations: as ye are, so shall the stranger be before ふたふ. There shall be one law and one ordinance for you, and for the stranger that abides among you. (Numbers 15:15-16)
- There shall be one judgment for the stranger and the native, for I am AFAT your God. (Leviticus 24:22)
- Thus saith 🍕 🍕, Keep ye judgment, and do justice: for My salvation is near to come, and My mercy to be revealed. Blessed is the man that does these things, and the man that holds by them, and keeps the Sabbaths from profaning them, and keeps his hands from doing unrighteousness. Let not the stranger who attaches himself to AT A Surely AT A will separate me from his people... I will give it to the strangers that attach themselves to ATA, to serve Him, and to love the name of ATA, to be to Him servants and handmaids; and as for all that keep My Sabbaths from profaning them, and that take hold of My covenant; I will bring them to My set apart mountain... Messiah's Day Just Before The Day of Trumpets

Messiah's Words – Day of Trumpets

- For I came down from heaven, not to do Mine own will, but the will of Him that sent Me. And this is the Father's will which hath sent Me, that of all which He hath given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day. And this is the will of Him that sent Me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on Him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day. (John 6:38-40)
- No man can come to Me, except the Father which hath sent Me draw him: and <u>I will raise him up at the last day</u>. (John 6:44)
- Whoso eatheth My flesh, and drinketh My blood, hath eternal life; and <u>I will raise him up at the last day</u>. (John 6:54)
- These things said He in the synagogue, as He taught in Capernaum. (John 6:59)*
 - * Note: This Sabbath was either the one preceding, or possibly on The Day of Trumpets

Day of Trumpets Coming With The Clouds

- Immediately after the tribulation of those days...And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And He shall send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other. (Matthew 24:29-31)
- And when He had spoken these things, while they beheld, He was taken up; and <u>a cloud received Him out of their sight</u>. And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel; Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? <u>this same @\fat,</u> which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen Him go into heaven. (Acts 1:9-11)
- Behold, <u>He cometh with clouds</u>; and every eye shall see Him, and they also which pierced Him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of Him. (Revelation 1:7)

The Day of Trumpets The Day of Shouting

- For as in Adam all die, even so in Messiah shall all be made alive. But every man in his own order: Messiah the firstfruits; afterward they that are Messiah's at His coming. (1 Corinthians 15:22-23)
- For this we say unto you by the word of Messiah, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of Messiah shall not prevent them which are asleep. For <u>Messiah Himself shall descend from</u> heaven with a shout with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of Elohiym: and the dead in Messiah shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet Messiah in the air: and so shall we ever be with Messiah. (1 Thessalonians 4:15-17)
- Beloved, now are <u>we the sons of Elohiym, and it doth not yet</u> appear what we shall be: but we know that, <u>when He shall appear</u>, <u>we shall be like Him</u>; for we shall see Him as He is. (1 John 3:2)

The Day of Trumpets Glory!

- When <u>Messiah</u>, who is our life, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory. (Colossians 3:4)
- And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, <u>ye shall receive a</u> <u>crown of glory that fadeth not away</u>. (1 Peter 5:4)
- And to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, <a>href="mailto:@wfat_">@wfat_, which delivered us from the wrath to come. (1 Thessalonians 1:10)
- Behold, <u>I shew you a mystery</u>; <u>We shall not all sleep</u>, but <u>we shall</u> all be changed, <u>In a moment</u>, in the twinkling of an eye, <u>at the</u> <u>last trump</u>: for <u>the trumpet shall sound</u>, and <u>the dead shall be</u> raised incorruptible, and <u>we shall be changed</u>. (1 Corinthians 15:51-52)
- ...<u>when the trumpet soundeth long, they shall come up to</u> the mount. (Exodus 19:10-13)

The Day of Trumpets

- And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Adonai, and of His Messiah; and He shall reign for ever and ever. And the four and twenty elders... fell upon their faces, and worshipped EI, Saying, We give thee thanks, O Adonai EI Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because Thou hast taken to Thee Thy great power, and hast reigned... and that Thou shouldest give reward unto Thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear Thy name, small and great ... (Revelation 11:15-18)
 - And now shall the spoils of Your small and great be gathered... (Isaiah 33:4)
