# Blessed Be His Name

- **Let His name be blessed for ever:** His name shall endure longer than the sun: and all the tribes of the earth shall be blessed in Him: all nations shall call Him blessed. **Blessed is אלהים Aluhiym of Israel,** who alone does wonders. **And blessed is His glorious name forever, even for ever and ever:** and all the earth shall be filled with His glory. SO BE IT. The hymns of David the son of Jessae are ended. (Psalm 72:17-20, LXXE)
- **Praise ye אלהים.** Praise, O ye servants of אלהים, **praise the name of אלהים.** **Blessed be the name of אלהים** from this time forth and for evermore. **From the rising of the sun unto the going down of the same, אלהים's name is to be praised.** (Psalm 113:1-3, KJV)

# His Name Forever

- And Aluhiym said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, אלהינו Aluhiym of your fathers, the Aluhiym of Abraham, the Aluhiym of Isaac, and the Aluhiym of Jacob, hath sent Me unto you: this is My name for ever, and this is My memorial unto all generations. (Exodus 3:15, KJV)



# satan's Targets

# His Name... Hidden by Men

- The name of the Father has been hidden/ obscured/ replaced in almost every Bible ever published. His name is in the scriptures over 6800 times, but has been replaced with:
  - “the LORD” - “And the LORD God formed man...” (Genesis 2:7, KJV)
    - וייצר יהוה אלהים את־האדם
  - “JEHOVAH” - “...but by My name JEHOVAH...” (Exodus 6:3)
    - ושמי יהוה
  - “GOD” - “Ah Lord GOD!” (Jeremiah 32:17)
    - אהה אדני יהוה

# LORD (יהוה) vs. lord (אדון)

## Different Words

- “The man, who is **the lord** (H113) of the land, spake roughly to us, and took us for spies of the country.”  
(Genesis 42:30, KJV)
- “Who have said, With our tongue will we prevail; our lips are our own: who is **lord** (H113) over us?”
  - lord (H113, אדון), sovereign, lord, master, ruler, (written in Scripture about 329 times)
- “These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens” (Genesis 2:4, KJV)
  - the LORD (H3068, יהוה), the proper name of the one true God, (written in Scripture over 6500 times)

# Yah (יְהוָה) in Scripture

- Sing unto Aluhiym, sing praises to His name: extol Him that rideth upon the heavens by His name JAH, and rejoice before Him. (Psalm 68:4, KJV)
  - JAH (H3050, יְהוָה), Contraction for H3068 (יְהוָה), the sacred name, the proper name of the one true Almighty
- יְהוָה is my strength and song, and He is become my salvation: He is my Aluhiym, and I will prepare Him an habitation; my father's Aluhiym, and I will exalt Him. (Exodus 15:2, KJV)
- Behold, Al is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for יְהוָה יְהוָה is my strength and my song; He also is become my salvation. (Isaiah 12:2, KJV)
  - Al (H410, אֱלֹהִים), strength, mighty; especially the Almighty

# Yah (יָהּ) in Scripture

- Praise ye יָהּ. Praise ye the name of יְהוָה;  
praise Him, O ye servants of יְהוָה. (Psalm 135:1, KJV)
  - “Praise ye” ha-la-lu (H1984, הללו) celebrate, commend, praise
  - “Praise ye יָהּ” ha-la-lu-Yah (H1984, הללו)(H3050, יָהּ)
- Blessed is the man whom Thou chastenest, יָהּ, and teachest him out of Thy law. (Psalm 94:12, KJV)
- About 40 other times in the Psalms.

- Matthew (G3156, Ματθαῖον), a shorter form of (G3161, Ματθαίας)
  - (G3161, Ματθαίας), of Hebrew origin (H4993, מתתיה)
  - Mattithiah - (H4993, מתתיה), from (H4991, מתת) and (H3050, יה), “gift of **יהיה**” (a Levite priest, 1 Chr 9:31)
    - (H4991, מתת), a present, gift
    - (H3050, **יה**), Contraction for H3068 (**יהיה**), the sacred name, the proper name of the one true Almighty

**OR**

- Mattithiah - (H4993, מתתיהו), from (H4991, מתת) and (H3068, **יהיה**), “gift of **יהיה**” (a Levite musician, 1 Chr 15:21), (the disciple and apostle, Mark 3:18 - HG)

# Names Changed To Hide The Truth

- John (G2491, Ἰωάννης), of Hebrew origin (H3110, יוחנן)
  - Johanan (H3110, יוחנן), a form of (H3076, יהוחנן), “אָפֶזֶז has favored”, (the first-born of Josiah, 1 Chr 3:15)(the disciple and apostle, Mark 3:17 - HG)

## OR

- Jehohanan (H3076, יהוחנן), from (H3068, אָפֶזֶז) and (H2603, חנן), “אָפֶזֶז has favored”, (a Levite porter, 1 Chr 26:3)
  - (H3068, אָפֶזֶז) the sacred name, the proper name of the one true Almighty
  - (H2603, חנן), to bend or stoop in kindness to an inferior, to show favor, be gracious

# Kum Ba YAH (כּוּם בּוֹא יְהוָה)

- An African American spiritual song, first recorded by Robert Winslow Gordon in Darien, Georgia in 1926 (singer: Henry Wylie)\*
  - Kum (H6965, קוּם) a root word: to rise, arise, accomplish, establish
  - Bua (H935, בוֹא), a root word, to come: H935 is used in the imperative tense in 1 Samuel 20:21 to say “come thou” (ba - באה)
- And כּוּם בּוֹא shall bring thee back to Egypt in ships, by the way of which I said, Thou shalt not see it again; and ye shall be sold there to your enemies for bondmen and bondwomen, and none shall buy you. (Deuteronomy 28:68, LXXE)

# Kum Ba YAH (አጌ አተግ ማየዋ)

**Arise, come Thou YAH !!**

- “Kum Ba Yah,” was released in 1958 by Ohio-based group the Folk-smiths. In the liner notes, they claimed that the song came from Africa, and presented as evidence a previous claim that the song had been collected from missionaries in Angola.\*
  - The claims to African origins come, in part, from Lynn and Katharine Rohrbaugh, leaders of the Cooperative Recreational Service in Ohio. Among their activities was the compiling of songbooks for camps... They received the song from Melvin Blake, a missionary who had returned from Angola. Their first printings spelled the name of the song “Koombaya”... \*\*

# Hidden By Judaism

- When Hebraists are asked why they read the Almighty's name “Adonay”, instead of אֲדֹנָי, they usually respond that it is for sake of the Jewish custom inspired by one of the 10 commandments, not to blaspheme the Almighty's name. Once again these Hebraists induce people into error because the Torah by no means forbids the pronouncing of the Almighty's name, but only not to use it in vain for worthless things: You shall not take the name of אֲדֹנָי, your Almighty, in vain, for אֲדֹנָי will not hold blameless anyone who takes His name in vain (Exodus 20:7, The Complete Jewish Bible With Rashi Commentary).
- This unbiblical practice emerged by the middle of the 2<sup>nd</sup> century CE.
- This tradition is not observed by all Jews, it is generally respected in Rabbinism, the majority tendency of Judaism, but not in Karaism.



# Hidden By Judaism (Talmud)

Warning: false doctrine below!

- MISHNA I.: All Israel has a share in the world to come. As it reads [Is. LX. 21]: "And thy people-they will all be righteous, for ever shall they possess the land, the sprout of my planting, the work of my hands, that I may glorify myself." The following have no share in the world to come:... and him who mumbles over a wound, reciting the verse [Ex. xv. 26]: "I will put none of those diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians; for I the Lord am thy physician." Abba Shaul said: Also he who speaks out the Holy Name with its vocals. (Tractate Sanhedrin, Chapter 11)

# His Name Shall No More Be Spoken

- Therefore hear ye the word of יהוה, all Judah dwelling in the land of Egypt; Behold, I have sworn by My great name, saith יהוה, My name shall no longer be in the mouth of every Jew to say, יהוה lives, in all the land of Egypt.

(Jeremiah 51:26, LXXE)



# Catholics Forbidden to Say His Name

- So they read in the book in the law of Aluhiym distinctly, and gave the sense, and caused them to understand the reading. (Nehemiah 8:8)

**Warning: false doctrine below!**

- June 29, 2008 letter to Catholic bishops conferences around the world from the Vatican's top liturgical body, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Sacraments, by an explicit "directive" of Pope Benedict XVI
  - "In recent years, the practice has crept in of pronouncing the God of Israel's proper name," the letter noted, referring to the four-consonant Hebrew Tetragrammaton, YHWH.
  - But such pronunciation violates long-standing Jewish tradition, the Vatican reminded bishops.

# Catholics Told To Replace His Name With "Lord"

**Warning: false doctrine below!**

- That practice continued with Christianity, the letter explained, recalling the "church's tradition, from the beginning, that the sacred Tetragrammaton was never pronounced in the Christian context nor translated into any of the languages into which the Bible was translated."
- Invoking a Vatican document from 2001, the Congregation reminded bishops that the name "Yahweh" in Catholic worship should be replaced by the Latin "Dominus" (Lord) or a word "equivalent in meaning" in the local language.
- "As an expression of the infinite greatness and majesty of God, (the name) was held to be unpronounceable and hence was replaced during the reading of sacred Scripture by means of the use of an alternate name: 'Adonai,' which means 'Lord,'" the Congregation said.

# Catholics Banned From Saying His Name

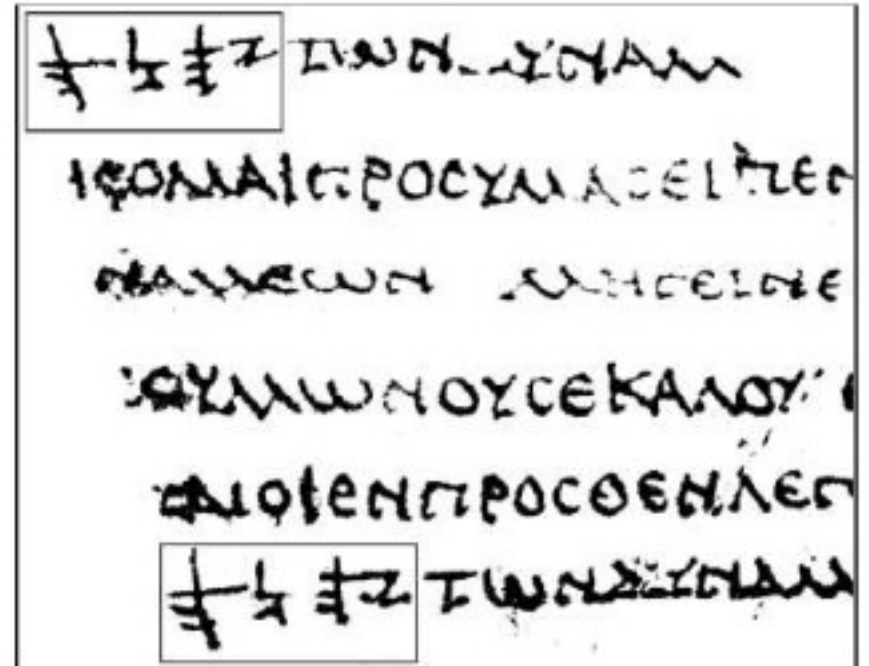
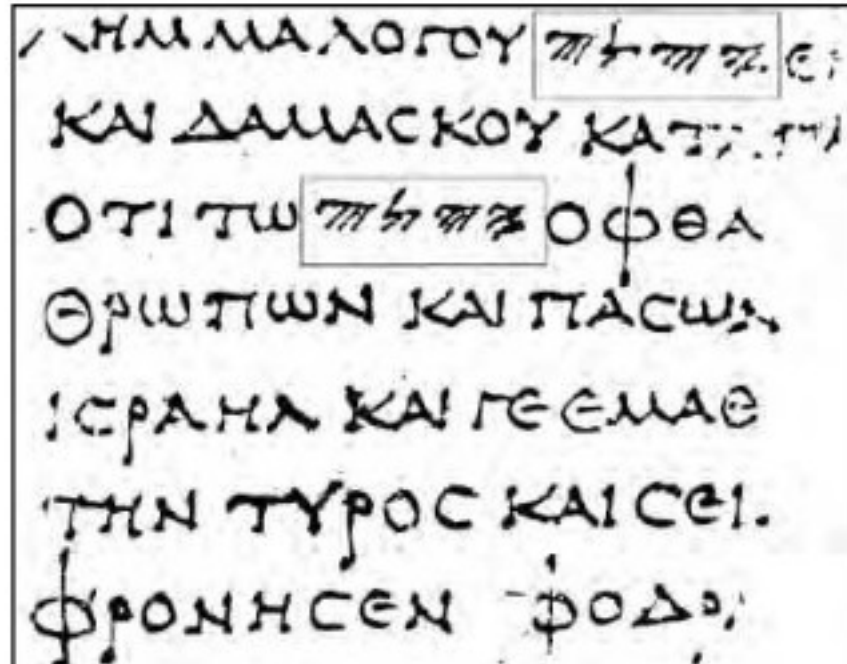
- He that loveth father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me. (Matthew 10:27)

**Warning: false doctrine below!**

- Pope Benedict issued a “ban” on using “God’s” “real name.” In August 2008, the Holy See issued a directive regarding the use of “Yahweh” in sacred music and public prayer.
- *Per the Pope:*
  - Christians have never used this name to address “God” in public worship.
  - Second, the actual oral pronunciation of “Yahweh” is considered potentially offensive to Jewish people. Recognizing the long-standing prohibition among Jewish people against uttering the Divine Name

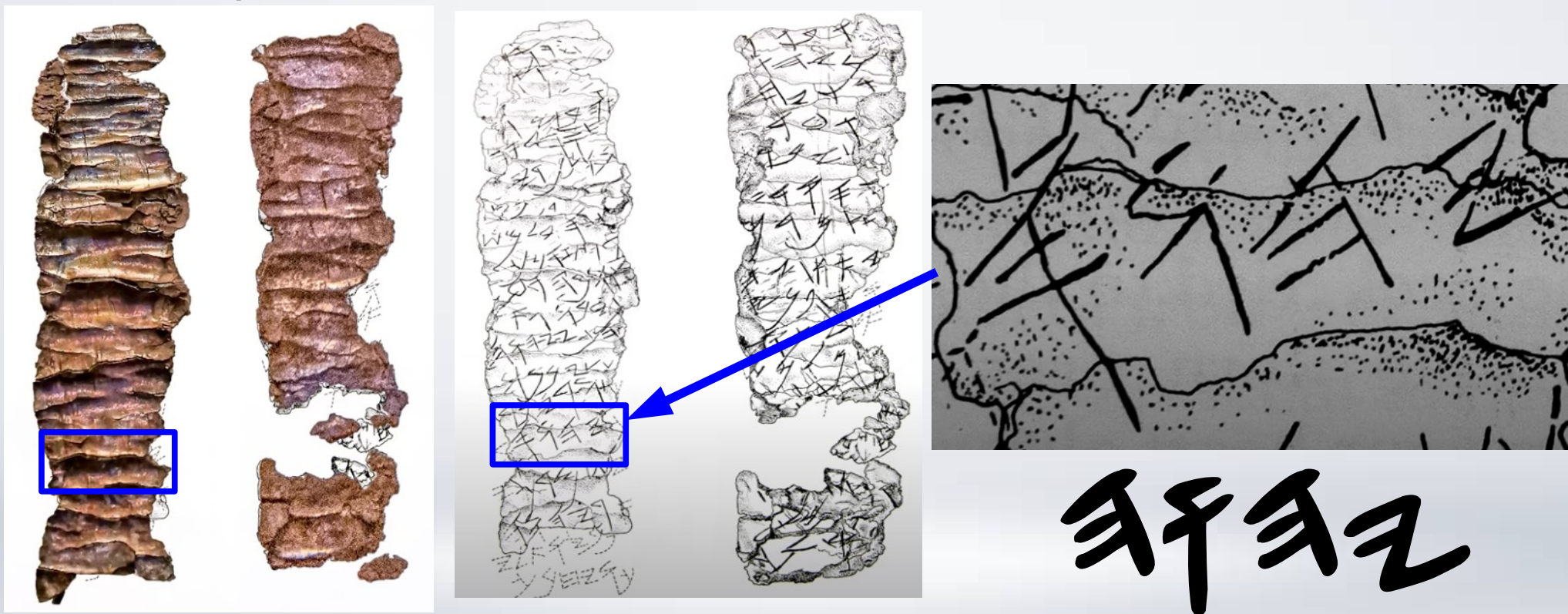

# The Ketef Himmon Sheet Silver Scrolls

- Discovered in Jerusalem by Dr. Gabi Barkay in 1979. The only artifact to date proving the existence of the Scriptures during the First Temple period.
- Numbers 6:24-26 (the Priestly Blessing) is written in First Temple period style Hebrew, dated to about the sixth or seventh century BC.

# His Name Blasphemed

- Awake, awake, Sion; put on your strength, O Sion; and o you put on your glory, Jerusalem the set apart city: there shall no more pass through you, **the uncircumcised and unclean.** Shake off the dust and arise; sit down, Jerusalem: put off the band of your neck, captive daughter of Sion. For thus says אִיִּי, **You have been sold for nothing; and you shall not be ransomed with silver.** Thus says אִיִּי, My people went down before to Egypt to sojourn there; and were carried away forcibly to the Assyrians. And now why are you here? Thus says אִיִּי, Because My people was taken for nothing, wonder you and howl. Thus says אִיִּי, **On account of you note My name is continually blasphemed among the Gentiles.** Therefore **shall My people know My name in that day, for I AM He that speaks...** (Isaiah 52:1-6, LXXE)

# His Name Still Blasphemed

- Behold, thou art called a Jew, and rest in the law, and make thy boast of Aluhiym, And know His will, and approve the things that are more excellent, being instructed out of the law; And art confident that thou thyself art a guide of the blind, a light of them which are in darkness, An instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, which hast the form of knowledge and of the truth in the law. **Thou therefore which teach another, teach thou not thyself?** thou that preach a man should not steal, dost thou steal? Thou that sayest a man should not commit adultery, dost thou commit adultery? thou that abhorrest idols, dost thou commit sacrilege? **Thou that make thy boast of the law, through breaking the law dishonor thou Aluhiym? For the name of Aluhiym is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you, as it is written\***. For circumcision verily profits, if thou keep the law: but if thou be a breaker of the law, thy circumcision is made uncircumcision. (Romans 2:17-25)

# The World Has Forgotten

If we have forgotten the name of our Aluhiym, and if we have spread out our hands to a strange god; Shall not Aluhiym search these things out? (Psalm 43:21-22, LXXE)

For the shepherds have become foolish, and have not sought אִפְאֵל; therefore the whole pasture has failed, and [the sheep] have been scattered... Chasten us, O אִפְאֵל, but with judgment; and not in wrath, lest Thou make us few. Pour out Thy wrath upon the nations that have not known Thee, and upon the families that have not called upon Thy name: for they have devoured Jacob, and consumed him, and have made his pasture desolate. (Jeremiah 10:24-25, LXXE)



# The World's Reward Is Wrath


- Come down, sit on the ground, O virgin daughter of Babylon... **I will exact of thee due vengeance...** Thy deliverer is אֲפִיז of hosts, **the Set Apart One of Israel is His name**. (Isaiah 47:1/3-4, LXXE)
- **...they profaned My set apart Name with their iniquities which they wrought:** and I destroyed them in My wrath and **with slaughter**. (Ezekiel 43:8, LXXE)
- **Pour out Thy wrath** upon the nations that have not known Thee, **and upon the families that have not called upon Thy name...** (Jeremiah 10:25, LXXE)
  - And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, **Go your ways, and pour out the vials of the wrath of Aluhiym upon the earth**. (Revelation 16:1)

# The Third Commandment

- Thou shalt not take **the name of יהוה** thy Aluhiym in vain; for יהוה will not hold him guiltless that taketh **His name** in vain. (Exodus 20:7)(Deuteronomy 5:11)
  - vain (H7723, שוא), in the sense of desolating; evil (as destructive), literally (ruin) or morally (especially guile); figuratively idolatry (as false, subjective), uselessness (as deceptive, objective; also adverbially, in vain):—false(-ly), lie, lying, vain, vanity, emptiness, nothingness
  - take (H5375, נשא), a primitive root, to lift, in a great variety of applications: accept, bear, desire, extol, hold up, magnify, raise, respect
- ...they profaned My set apart Name with their iniquities which they wrought: and I destroyed them in My wrath and with slaughter. (Ezekiel 43:8, LXXE)

# Taking His Name

- Know ye therefore that **they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham.** (Galatians 3:7)
  - **He that hath the bride is the bridegroom:** but the friend of the bridegroom, which standeth and heareth Him, rejoiceth greatly because of the bridegroom's voice: this my joy therefore is fulfilled. (John 3:29)
  - Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Master... Therefore **as the assembly is subject unto Messiah,** so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing. (Ephesians 5:22/24)
  - **Whosoever overcomes, I will write upon him the name of My Aluah... and also My new name.** (Revelation 3:12, HG)
    - “My Aluah” (אלהי), Aluah (H433, אלוה) a title of The Almighty with the suffix (י), first person singular possessive (“my”)
- 

# One Language Returned

- Therefore wait upon Me, saith אֱלֹהִים, until the day when I rise up for a witness: because My judgment [shall be] on the gatherings of the nations... For then will I turn to the peoples a tongue for her generation, that all may call on the name of אֱלֹהִים, to serve Him under one yoke. (Zephaniah 3:8-9, LXXE)
  - Thus saith אֱלֹהִים, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths of אֱלֹהִים; and see what is the good way, and walk in it, and ye shall find purification for your souls. (Jeremiah 6:16, LXXE)
  - I began to speak with him in Hebrew in the tongue of the creation. (Jubilees 12:26)
  - ...I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, SAUL, why persecutest thou Me? (Acts 26:14)

# We Will Remember His Name

- For Aluhiym will save Sion, and the cities of Judea shall be built; and [men] shall dwell there, and inherit it. And the seed of His servants shall possess it, and **they that love His name shall dwell therein** (Psalm 68:36, LXXE)
- We will rejoice in Thy salvation, and in the name of our Aluhiym we will set up our banners: אלהינו fulfil all Thy petitions... Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the name of אלהינו our Aluhiym. (Psalm 20:5/7)
- אלהינו's voice shall be proclaimed in the city, and He shall save those that fear His name (Micah 6:9, LXXE)



# Call on the Name of אֱלֹהִים

- For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Adun over all is rich unto all that call upon Him. For **whosoever shall call upon the name of אֱלֹהִים shall be saved**. (Romans 10:12-13)
- **And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of אֱלֹהִים shall be saved.** (Acts 2:21)
  - The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and glorious day of אֱלֹהִים come. **And it shall come to pass, [that] whosoever shall call on the name of אֱלֹהִים shall be saved:** for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be the saved one be as אֱלֹהִים has said, and they that have glad tidings preached to them, whom אֱלֹהִים has called. (Joel 3:4-5, LXXE)

# His Name Is Sanctified Through His Servants

- And I will sanctify My great name, which was profaned among the nations, which ye have profaned in the midst of them; and the nations shall know that I am אף אע, when I am sanctified among you before their eyes. And I will take you out from the nations, and will gather you out of all the lands... And I will put My Spirit in you, and will cause you to walk in Mine ordinances, and to keep My judgments, and do [them]. (Ezekiel 36:23-24/27, LXXE)
- These be they that have put off the mortal clothing, and put on the immortal, and have confessed the name of Aluhiym: now are they crowned, and receive palms... It is the Son of Aluah, whom they have confessed in the world. (2 Esdras 2:45/47)

# The Word And The Testimony

- **...for thou... hast kept My word, and hast not denied My name.**  
(Revelation 3:8)
- ...John the witness of the word of אֱלֹהִים, and the testimony of אֱלֹהִים the Messiah... (Revelation 1:1-2, HG)
- I...was on the island called Patmos, because of the word of אֱלֹהִים, and the testimony of אֱלֹהִים the Messiah. (Revelation 1:9, HG)
- ...the woman... the remaining ones of her seed, who perform the commandments of אֱלֹהִים, and believe in the testimony of His Messiah. (Revelation 12:20, HG)
- Here is the hope of the set-apart ones: and here are those who do the commandments of אֱלֹהִים, and believe in אֱלֹהִים. (Revelation 14:12, HG)

# Exalt His Name

- Then Moses and the children of Israel sang this song to אֶלֹהֵינוּ... I will sing to אֶלֹהֵינוּ, For He has triumphed gloriously! The horse and its rider He has thrown into the sea! אֱלֹהֵינוּ is my strength and song, And He has become my salvation; He is my Aluhiym, and I will praise Him; My father's Aluah, and I will exalt Him. (Exodus 15:1-2, KJV)
- And in that day thou shalt say, O אֱלֹהֵינוּ, I will praise Thee: though Thou wast angry with me, Thine anger is turned away, and Thou comfortedst me. Behold, Aluhiym is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for אֱלֹהֵינוּ אֱלֹהֵינוּ is my strength and my song; He also is become my salvation. Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation. And in that day shall ye say, Praise אֱלֹהֵינוּ, call upon His name, declare His doings among the people, make mention that His name is exalted. (Isaiah 12:1-4, KJV)
- ...Son of man, thou hast seen the place of My throne... in which My name shall dwell in the midst of the house of Israel for ever; and the house of Israel shall no more profane My set apart name... (Ezekiel 43:7, LXXE)
