- The miracles performed by Messiah were to:
  - show that He has come with the power, approval, annointing, and authority of Aluhiym
  - fulfill prophesy showing that He is the Messiah
  - grant healing requests from people with great faith
  - show mercy to the poor
  - teaching moments
  - show that man-made religious rules were null and void in the Kingdom of Heaven
  - set in motion the chain of events required for the consecration of the New Covenant

# His Word on Unclean Vessels

- These also shall be unclean unto you among the creeping things that creep upon the earth; the weasel, and the mouse, and the tortoise after his kind, And the ferret, and the chameleon, and the lizard, and the snail, and the mole... And <u>upon whatsoever any of</u> them, when they are dead, doth fall, it shall be unclean; whether it be any vessel of wood, or raiment, or skin, or sack, whatsoever vessel it be, wherein any work is done, it must be put into water, and it shall be unclean until the even; so it shall be cleansed. And every earthen vessel, whereinto any of them falleth, whatsoever is in it shall be unclean; and ye shall break it. (Leviticus 11:29-30/32-33)
- Of all meat which may be eaten, that on which such water cometh shall be unclean: and <u>all drink that may be drunk in every such</u> <u>vessel shall be unclean</u>. And every thing whereupon any part of their <u>carcase falleth shall be unclean</u>; whether it be oven, or ranges for pots, they shall be broken down: for they are unclean, and shall be unclean unto you. Nevertheless <u>a fountain or pit</u>, wherein there is <u>plenty of water</u>, shall be clean: but that which toucheth their carcase shall be unclean. (Leviticus 11:34-36)

# **Traditions Turning Into Doctrine**

- For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, except they wash their hands oft, eat not, holding the tradition of the elders. And when they come from the market, except they wash, they eat not. And many other things there be, which they have received to hold, as the washing of cups, and pots, brasen vessels, and of tables. (Mark 7:3-4)
  - The "elders" were the previous generations of the Pharisees that made up the new rules...
- Ye shall not add to the word which I command you, and ye shall not take from it: keep the commandments of AFAL our Aluhiym, all that I command you this day. (Deuteronomy 4:2, LXXE)

# Whatever He Says... Do It!

- On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of @\fat was there. Now both @\fat and His disciples were invited to the wedding. And when they ran out of wine, the mother of @\fat said to Him, They have no wine. (John 2:1-3 NKJV)
- My dear lady, what does it have to do with Me? MAR asked. My time hasn't come yet. His mother said to the staff, do whatever He tells you to do. (John 2:4-5 – TS)
  - "My dear lady" (G1135, γύναι), common as a form of polite address in Greek, e.g. Aristophanes, Acharnians, 262 and Sophocles, O.T., 928 (TS note)

## The Man-Made Rules Shown to be Void

 Messiah used the stone pots and filled them in a specific way to show that the man-made purification rules created by the non-ordained Jewish priests and leaders was null and void in the Kingdom of Aluhiym

#### Warning: False Doctrine Below!

- TALMUD: ALL VESSELS FOUND IN JERUSALEM (10) IN THE WAY OF GOING DOWN TO THE PLACE OF IMMERSION (11) ARE UNCLEAN, [BUT THOSE FOUND] IN THE WAY OFGOING UP [FROM THE PLACE OF IMMERSION] ARE CLEAN; FOR THEY ARE NOT INTHE SAME CONDITION WHEN ON THE WAY GOING DOWN (12) [TO THE PLACE OFIMMERSION] AS ON THE WAY GOING UP (13) [THEREFROM]; THUS R. MEIR. R. JOSESAYS: THEY ARE ALL CLEAN (14) EXCEPT THE BASKET AND THE SHOVEL AND THEBONE CRUSHER WHICH ARE SPECIALLY CONNECTED WITH [WORK IN]BURIAL-PLACES. (Shekalim 8.2)\*
  - (10) Outside Jerusalem all articles found anywhere were declared by a preventive enactment of the Rabbis to be suspect of defilement; cf. Toh. IV, 5; and supra n. 1.
  - (11) To be immersed for the purpose of purification; cf. Lev. XI, 32; XV, 17.
  - (12) When found on the way down they may be presumed to have been unclean vessels lost before immersion.
  - (13) When found on the way up they may be presumed to have been lost after immersion. So according to Maimonides.According to Rashi (Pes. 19b) the passage should be rendered as follows:
    'For their way of going down (to the place of immersion) is not the same as their way of going up (therefrom),' i.e. things going down to immersion and things going up from immersion went by different routes.
  - (14) No suspicion need be entertained as to the purity of articles found in Jerusalem.

# Traditions Of Men = Worthless

• And <u>have no fellowship</u> with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather <u>expose them</u>. (Ephesians 5:11)

Warning: False Doctrine Below!



- Our Rabbis taught: <u>Tamad</u> before it has fermented can be rendered clean by bringing it into contact with the water [of a mikweh];(1) <u>after it has fermented it cannot be rendered</u> <u>clean by bringing it in to contact with the water</u> [of a mikweh]. (Chullin 26a/26b)
  - (1) V. Bezah 17b and Pes. 34a. Water that has become unclean can be rendered clean by pouring it into a stone vessel and lowering it into a mikweh, so that the water in the vessel touches (lit., 'kisses') the water of the mikweh and becomes one with the latter. Now Tamad before fermentation is regarded as water and therefore can be rendered clean in this way. Other liquids, however, once unclean, can never be rendered clean, and therefore fermented Tamad, being regarded as wine, cannot be rendered clean in this way. (Chullin 26b)

# The Lame Man

- After this <u>there was a Feast</u>... and <sup>@</sup>养<sup>†</sup>𝑘<sup>‡</sup> went up to Jerusalem. Now there is at Jerusalem by the sheep market a pool, which is called in the Hebrew tongue Bethesda, having five porches. In these lay a great multitude of impotent folk, of blind, halt, withered... And a certain man was there, which had an infirmity thirty and eight years... <sup>@</sup>养<sup>†</sup>𝑘<sup>‡</sup> saith unto him, <u>Rise, take up thy bed, and walk</u>. And <u>immediately the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked</u>: and <u>on the same day was the Sabbath</u>. The Jews therefore said unto him that was cured, <u>It is the Sabbath day: it is not lawful for thee to carry thy bed</u>. (John 5:1-3/5/8-10)
- And <u>for this cause the Jews persecuted</u> <sup>⊕</sup>→f<sup>A</sup>, because <u>He did</u> these things on the Sabbath. (John 5:16)

#### Warning: False Doctrine Below!

Talmud: no healing on Sabbath unless there is a danger to life (Shabbat – multiple places including 12b, 18a, 111a, 147a); no carrying items outside the home on Sabbath (Shabbat – multiple places including <u>73a</u>, 2a, 2b, 3b, 4a, 4b, 5a, 5b, 6a, 6b)\*

## Man-Made Religion = False Doctrine

#### Warning: False Doctrine Below!

- Our Rabbis taught: There are <u>four domains in respect to the Sabbath; private ground, publicground, karmelith, and a place of non-liability</u>. And what is private ground? A trench ten [handbreadths] deep and four wide, and likewise a wall ten [handbreadths] high and four broad, —that is absolute private ground.9 And what is public ground? A highroad,10 a great public square,11and open alleys,12 that is absolute public ground. One may not carry out from this private to thispublic ground, nor carry in from this public to this private ground; and **if one does carry out** or in,unwitting, he is liable to a sin-offering; if **deliberately**, he is public nor as private ground:15 onemust not carry [objects] about16 within it and if he does, he is liable; and one must not carry out [anobject] thence into public ground or from the public ground into it; yet if he does carry out or in, he is not liable. (Shabbat 6a)\*
- (13) Healing on the Sabbath itself is forbidden, unless there is danger to life. (Shabbat 18a)\*
- MISHNAH. IF ONE'S TEETH PAIN HIM, HE MUST NOT SIP VINEGAR THROUGH THEM,15 BUT MAY DIP [HIS BREAD IN VINEGAR] IN THE USUAL MANNER,16 AND IF HEIS CURED, HE IS CURED. (Shabbat 111a)\*
- YOU MUST NOT GO DOWN TO A WRESTLING GROUND,23 OR INDUCE VOMITING,24 OR STRAIGHTEN AN INFANT['S LIMBS],25 OR SET A BROKEN BONE. IF ONE'S HAND OR FOOT IS DISLOCATED, HE MUST NOT AGITATE IT VIOLENTLY IN COLD WATER BUT MAY BATHE IT IN THE USUAL WAY, AND IF IT HEALS, IT HEALS. (Shabbat 147a)\*

## Blasphemy Against Messiah (Miracle #15)

- At that time ant a went on the Sabbath day... (Matthew 12:1)
- Then was brought unto Him <u>one possessed with a devil</u>, blind, and dumb: and He healed him, insomuch that the blind and dumb both spake and saw... But when the Pharisees heard it, they said, This fellow doth not cast out devils, but by Beelzebub the prince of the devils. And ant at knew their thoughts, and said unto them, Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house divided against itself shall not stand: And if satan cast out satan, he is divided against himself; how shall then his kingdom stand? ... But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of Aluhiym, then the kingdom of Aluhiym is come unto you... whosoever speaketh against the Set Apart Spirit, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come. (Matthew 12:24-26/28/32)

## ...And Destroying Pagan Tradition

- And ye crossed over Jordan... and the inhabitants of Jericho fought against us, the Amorite... and <u>the Gergesite</u>... (Joshua 24:11)
- Hippos (Sussita) was one of the Decapolis, a region of ten Roman cities in the country on the east side of the Sea of Galilee. It gained its name Antiochia Hippos after the Battle of Panium around 199 B.C.E., named for the Hellenistic Seleucid Greek king Antiochus.
- During Hippos' slightly later Roman era, <u>the vast majority of the town's</u> population would have been pagans, Eisenberg says, though <u>a Jewish</u> minority did live there, per Josephus ("Wars of the Jews.")
- A rare bronze mask of the pagan god pan was found outside the city, in 2015. <u>Two burial grounds</u> were also found outside the city. Ancient Romans would worship pan and dionysus, both pagan gods of nature. <u>The sanctuary that was excavated with the theater</u> and bathhouse could <u>have been dedicated to pan and/or dionysus – the two were often</u> <u>worshipped together</u>. <u>Worship of dionysus centered on the theater</u> since the earliest days of Greek culture, in the late 6th century B.C.E.
- Pigs were sacrificed to dionysus, at a sanctuary altar.

# The Feeding of the 5000 (Miracle #22)

- And they departed into a desert place by ship privately. And the people saw them departing, and many knew Him, and ran afoot thither out of all cities, and outwent them, and came together unto Him. And ant and when He came out, saw much people, and was moved with compassion toward them, because they were as sheep not having a shepherd: and He began to teach them many things. And when the day was now far spent, His disciples came unto Him, and said... Send them away, that they may... buy themselves bread: for they have nothing to eat. He...said unto them, Give ye them to eat... How many loaves have ye? go and see. And when they knew, they say, Five, and two fishes. And He commanded them to make all sit down by companies upon the green grass...And when He had taken the five loaves and the two fishes, He looked up to heaven, and blessed, and brake the loaves, and gave them to His disciples to set before them; and the two fishes divided He among them all... And they did all eat, and were filled... And they that did eat of the loaves were about five thousand men. (Mark 6:32-39/41-44)

# Walking on the Sea

- ...@\fat constrained His disciples to get into a ship, and to go before Him unto the other side, while He sent the multitudes away. (Matthew 14:22)
- Owfat...departed again into a mountain Himself alone. And when even was now come, His disciples went down unto the sea, And entered into a ship, and went over the sea toward Capernaum. And it was now dark, and Messiah was not come to them. And the sea arose by reason of a great wind that blew. So when they had rowed about five and twenty or thirty furlongs, they see ant and drawing nigh unto the ship: and they were afraid. But He saith unto them, It is I; be not afraid. Then they willingly received Him into the ship: and immediately the ship was at the land whither they went. (John 6:15-21)
  - And when they were gone over, they came into the land of Gennesaret. (Matthew 14:34)

# Why Did He Walk Across the Sea of Galilee?



 Messiah walked on the water with the power and authority from our Father to expose the false doctrines of the commandments of men, and the blasphemous accusations (casting out devils by Beelzebub) of the Pharisees.

#### Warning: False Doctrine Below!

- Talmud: Products of sorcery are reverted back to their original form when brought into contact with water. (Sanhedrin 67b/ Berachoth 55b)\*
- \* The Talmud is the man-made religion that Messiah fought against... stay away from it!

# **Prophecy Fulfilled**

Thy way is in the sea, and thy paths in many waters, and thy footsteps cannot be known. Thou didst guide thy people as sheep by the hand of Moses and Aaron. (Psalm 76:19-20, LXXE)

> Who alone has stretched out the heavens, and <u>walks on</u> <u>the sea as on firm</u> ground. (Job 9:8, LXXE)

# The Feeding of the 5000... Unwashed Hands

- Then came to Image: Seribes and Pharisees, which were of Jerusalem, saying, Why do Thy disciples transgress the tradition of the elders? for they wash not their hands when they eat bread. (Matthew 15:1-2)
  - Then came together unto Him the Pharisees, and certain of the scribes, which came from Jerusalem. And when they saw some of His disciples eat bread with defiled, that is to say, with unwashen, hands, they found fault. (Mark 7:1-4)

#### Warning: False Doctrine Below!

- Talmud requires the hands to be washed before eating a meal containing bread. This washing was initially known as mayim rishonim (first waters) but is now commonly known simply as netilat yadayim (hand washing).
- Talmud: I do know the following teaching, viz.: Rab Judah said in the name of Rab: some say it was taught in a Baraitha, <u>Sanctify yourselves: this refers to "washing of</u> the hands before the meal" (*literally, <u>first waters</u>*) (Berachoth 53b)
- \* Part of the Talmud, the man-made religion that Messiah fought against... stay away from it!

# Messiah Rejects the Rules of Men

- But He answered and said unto them, Why do ye also transgress the commandment of Aluhiym by your tradition? ... Ye hypocrites, well did Esaias prophesy of you, saying, This people draweth nigh unto Me with their mouth, and honoureth Me with their lips; but their heart is far from Me. But in vain they do worship Me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men. (Matthew 15:3/7-9) For laying aside the commandment of Aluhiym, ye hold the tradition of men, as the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do. And He said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of Aluhiym, that ye may keep your own tradition. (Mark 7:8-9)
- And He called the multitude, and said unto them, Hear, and understand: <u>Not that which goeth into the mouth defileth a</u> <u>man; but that which cometh out of the mouth, this defileth a</u> <u>man... but to eat with unwashen hands</u> defileth not a man. (Matthew 15:10-11/20)

# The Blind Leading The Blind

 Then came His disciples, and said unto Him, Knowest Thou that the Pharisees were offended, after they heard this saying? But He answered and said, Every plant, which My heavenly
 Father hath not planted, shall be rooted up. Let them alone: they be blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch. (Matthew 15:12-14)

#### Warning: False Doctrine Below!

- The Babylonian Talmud Gemarah contains descriptions of the importance of the practice, including an argument that washing before meals is so important that neglecting it is tantamount to unchastity, and risks divine punishment in the form of sudden destruction or poverty.
  - Whoever eats bread without previously washing the hands is as though he had intercourse with a harlot... Whoever makes light of washing the hands [before and after a meal] will be uprooted from the world. (Sotah 4b)\*




# **Prophecy In Fulfillment**

 For <u>AFAT has made you to drink a spirit of deep sleep;</u> and He shall close their eyes, and [the eyes] of their prophets and of their rulers ... And AFAT has said, This people draw nigh to Me with their mouth, and they honour Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me: but in vain do they worship Me, teaching the commandments and doctrines of men. Therefore behold I will proceed to remove this people, and I will remove them: and I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and will hide the understanding of the prudent... And in that day the deaf shall hear the words of the book, and they that are in darkness, and they that are in mist: the eyes of the blind shall see, and the poor shall rejoice with joy because of araz, and they that had no hope among men shall be filled with joy. (Isaiah 29:10/13-14/18-19, LXXE)

### Deaf and a Speech Impediment (Miracle #27)

...<u>the ears of the deaf shall hear... and the tongue of the</u> <u>stammerers shall speak plainly</u> (Isaiah 35:2/4-5-6, LXXE)





### Deaf and a Speech Impediment (Miracle #27)

- And they bring unto Him <u>one that was deaf, and had an</u> <u>impediment in his speech</u>; and they beseech Him to put His hand upon him. And He took him aside from the multitude, and <u>put His fingers into his ears, and He spit, and touched His</u> <u>tongue</u>; And looking up to heaven, He sighed, and saith unto him, Ephphatha, that is, Be opened. And straightway his ears were opened, and the string of his tongue was loosed, and he spake plain. (Mark 7:32-36)
- Why Messiah used spit to heal the deaf man with the speak impediment:

#### Warning: False Doctrine Below!

 Talmud: IF THERE WAS IN THE TOWN <u>AN IMBECILE</u>, A HEATHEN, OR A SAMARITAN WOMAN, <u>ALL SPITTLE ENCOUNTERED IN THE</u> <u>TOWN IS DEEMED UNCLEAN</u>. (Taharoth Ch5 Mishna 8)\*

### The Feeding of the 4000 (Miracle #28)

About five days after feeding 5000... He did it again. Message sent.

- And <u>He commanded the multitude to sit down on the ground</u>. And <u>He took the seven loaves and the fishes</u>, and gave thanks, and brake them, and gave to His disciples, and the disciples to the multitude. And they did all eat, and were filled: and they took up of the broken meat that was left seven baskets full. And they that did eat were <u>four thousand</u> men, beside women and children. (Matthew 15:35-38)(same details also in Mark 8:6-8)
  - After these things @৵f為↓ walked in Galilee; for He would not walk in Jewry, because the Jews sought to kill Him. Now the Jews' Feast of Tabernacles was at hand. (John 7:1-2)



#### The Blind Man at Bethsaida (Miracle #29)

...<u>My people shall see the glory of AFAL</u>...<u>Then shall the</u> eyes of the blind be opened</u>... (Isaiah 35:2/5, LXXE)



#### The Blind Man from Bethsaida (Miracle #29)

- And He cometh to Bethsaida; and they bring a blind man unto Him, and besought Him to touch him. And He took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when <u>He had spit on his</u> eyes, and put His hands upon him, He asked him if he saw ought. And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking. After that He put His hands again upon his eyes, and made him look up: and he was restored, and saw every man clearly. (Mark 8:22-26)
  - Messiah put His spit on the man's eyes to show that man-made saliva healing rules are worth nothing.

#### Warning: False Doctrine Below!

- There is a tradition that the spittle of the firstborn of a father is healing, but that of the firstborn of a mother is not healing. (Baba Bathra 126b)\*
- May one wash with this water on the Sabbath?— It is well, he replied. Is it permissible to shut and open [one's eyes]?... [To put] tasteless saliva, even on the eye, is forbidden. (Shabbath 108b)\*
- \* Talmud, the man-made religion that Messiah fought against... stay away from it!

#### Blind From Birth (Miracle #33)

- ...then went He also up unto the Feast... Now about the midst of the Feast @৵f為⊋ went up into the temple, and taught. (John 7:10/14)
- And as @wfat passed by, He saw a man which was <u>blind from his birth</u>...When He had thus spoken, <u>He spat on the ground, and made clay</u> of the spittle, and He anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay, And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam... He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing... And <u>it was the Sabbath</u> day when @wfat made the clay, and opened his eyes. (John 9:1/6-7/14)



# Rules of Men Shown As Worthless

- Image: Answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of Aluhiym should be made manifest in him. (John 9:3)
- Therefore said some of the Pharisees... <u>How can a man that is a</u> sinner do such miracles? (John 9:16)
  - Messiah made clay on Sabbath to show that the specific Sabbath work rules created by men are worthless to those seeking the Kingdom of <sup>A</sup><sup>\*</sup><sup>A</sup><sup>2</sup>.

#### Warning: False Doctrine Below!

- MISHNAH. <u>THE PRIMARY LABOURS ARE FORTY LESS ONE</u>, [VIZ.:] SOWING, PLOUGHING, REAPING, BINDING SHEAVES, THRESHING, WINNOWING, SELECTING, GRINDING, SIFTING, <u>KNEADING</u>, BAKING,..., DIVIDING TWO THREADS, TYING [KNOTTING] AND UNTYING, SEWING TWO STITCHES, TEARING IN ORDER TO SEW TWO STITCHES, CAPTURING A DEER, SLAUGHTERING, OR FLAYING, OR SALTING IT, CURING ITS HIDE, SCRAPING IT [OF ITS HAIR], CUTTING IT UP, WRITING TWO LETTERS, ERASING IN ORDER TO WRITE TWO LETTERS [OVER THE ERASURE], BUILDING, PULLINGDOWN, EXTINGUISHING, KINDLING, STRIKING WITH A HAMMER, [AND] CARRYING OUT FROM ONE DOMAIN TO ANOTHER: THESE ARE THE FORTY PRIMARY LABOURS LESS ONE. (Shabbat 73a)\*
- (13) <u>Healing on the Sabbath itself is forbidden</u>, unless there is danger to life. (Shabbat 18a)\*

# It Is Always Lawful to Do Good

- Therefore said some of the Pharisees, This man is not of Aluhiym, because He keepeth not the Sabbath day. <u>Others said</u>, <u>How can a man that is a sinner</u> <u>do such miracles</u>? And there was a division among them. (John 9:16)
- And And Antipate answering spake unto the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, <u>Is it</u> <u>lawful to heal on the</u> <u>Sabbath day</u>? (Luke 14:3)
- ...<u>it is lawful to do well on</u>
  <u>the Sabbath days</u>. (Matthew 12:12)



## Let Them Be Ashamed

- And the scribes and Pharisees brought unto Him a woman taken in adultery; and when they had set her in the midst, They say unto Him, Master, this woman was taken in adultery, in the very act. Now Moses in the law commanded us, that such should be stoned: but what sayest Thou? This they said, tempting Him, that they might have to accuse Him. But OMF stooped down, and with His finger wrote on the ground... So when they continued asking Him, He lifted up Himself, and said unto them, he that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her. And again He stooped down, and wrote on the ground. And they which heard it, being convicted by their own conscience, went out one by one, beginning at the eldest, even unto the last: and 8:3-9)
  - O 🍕 🍕, the hope of Israel, <u>let all that have left Thee be</u> <u>ashamed</u>, <u>let them that have revolted be written on the</u> <u>earth</u>, <u>because they have forsaken the fountain of life</u>, 🍕 🍕. (Jeremiah 17:13, LXXE)

## For the Love of Money and Power

- Then gathered the chief priests and the Pharisees a council, and said, What do we? for this Man doeth many miracles. If we let Him thus alone, all men will believe on Him: and the Romans shall come and take away both our place and nation. And one of them, named Caiaphas, being the high priest that same year, said unto them, Ye know nothing at all, Nor consider that it is expedient for us, that one man should die for the people, and that the whole nation perish not... Then from that day forth they took counsel together for to put Him to death. (John 11:47-50/53)
  - council synedrion (G4892, συνέδριον), a joint session (specially, <u>the Jewish Sanhedrin</u>)
- The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, Perceive ye how ye prevail nothing? <u>behold, the world is gone after Him</u>. (John 12:19)

#### For the Love of Money and Power...

- ...consider that it is expedient for us, that one man should die for the people, and that the whole nation perish not. And this spake he not of himself: but being high priest that year, he prophesied that and for that nation... Then from that day forth they took counsel together for to put Him to death. (John 11:47-50-51/53)
  - ...Mine enemies have spoken evil against Me, [saying], <u>When</u> <u>shall He die, and His name perish</u>? And if he came to see [Me], his heart spoke vainly; he gathered iniquity to himself; he went forth and spoke in like manner. <u>All My enemies</u> <u>whispered against Me; against Me they devised My hurt</u>. They denounced a wicked word against Me, [saying], Now that He lies, shall He not rise up again? (Psalm 40:5-8, LXXE)

#### ...Judgement Is Declarerd

- <u>The scribes and the Pharisees</u>...<u>do not do according to</u> <u>their works</u>... For they bind heavy burdens, hard to bear, and lay them on men's shoulders (Matthew 23:2-4, NKJV)
- But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you shut up the kingdom of heaven against men; for you neither go in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in... For you...have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faith. These you ought to have done... you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness. Serpents, brood of vipers! How can you escape the condemnation of hell? (Matthew 23:13/23/28/33, NKJV)
  - Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, <u>We</u>
    <u>ought to obey Aluhiym rather than men</u>. (Acts 5:29)
- I know the blasphemy of those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan. (Revelation 2:9, NKJV)

## You Shall See Greater Things

 Nathanael answered and saith unto Him, **Rabbi, Thou art the Son of Aluhiym; Thou** art the King of Israel. Owfat answered and said unto him, Because I said unto thee, I saw thee under the fig tree, believest thou? thou shalt see greater things than these. And He saith unto him, Verily!, I say unto you, Hereafter ye shall see heaven open, and the angels of Aluhiym ascending and descending upon the Son of man. (John 1:49-51)
