I Am Not A Prophet

- ...I am no prophet, nor a prophet's son am I...
(Amos 7:14, YLT)
- But of the times and the seasons, brethren, ye have no need that I write unto you.
(1 Thessalonians 5:1)
- For אלהים Aluhiym will do nothing, without revealing instruction to His servants the prophets. (Amos 3:7, LXXE)
- I Daniel understood by books the number of the years which was the word of אלהים to the prophet Jeremiah... (Daniel 9:2, LXXE)
- **But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved**
(Matthew 24:13)



His Words To One In Tribulation

- ... אֱלֹהִים spoke to Job through the whirlwind and clouds...
did I order the morning light in thy time; and [did] the morning star [then first] see his appointed place; to lay hold of the extremities of the earth, to cast out the wicked out of it? Or didst thou take clay of the ground, and form a living creature, and set it with the power of speech upon the earth?... And who prepared a course for the violent rain, and a way for **the thunders**; to rain upon the land where [there is] no man, the wilderness, where there is not a man in it; so as to feed the untrodden and uninhabited [land], and cause it to send forth a crop of green herbs? (Job 38:1/12-14/25-27, LXXE)

The Unicorn

And will the unicorn be willing to serve thee, or to lie down at thy manger? And wilt thou bind his yoke with thongs, or will he plough furrows for thee in the plain? And dost thou trust him, because his strength is great? and wilt thou commit thy works to him? And wilt thou believe that he will return to thee thy seed, and bring [it] in [to] thy threshing-floor? (Job 39:9-12, LXXE)

PHE. While we yet lived **our eyes failed**, while we looked in vain for our help... (Lamentations 4:17, LXXE)



The Peacock

- The peacock has a beautiful wing... (Job 39:13, LXXE)
 - a wing of delighted ones is **the peacock** (Job 39:13*)
 - **...vanity of vanities; all is vanity.** (Ecclesiastes 1:2, LXXE)
 - **The sinner has provoked אף אג: according to the abundance of his pride** he will not seek after [Him]... (Psalm 9:25, LXXE)
 - **Pride goes before destruction**... (Proverbs 16:18, LXXE)
 - ...TSADE. **We looked to a nation that could not save.** (Lamentations 4:17, LXXE)



The Stork In Contrast To...

- **if the stork** and the ostrich **conceive**, [it is worthy of notice]... (Job 39:13, LXXE)
 - stork (H2624, חסידה), feminine of H2623; the kind (maternal) bird, i.e. a stork (kind and affectionate to its young)
 - (H2623, חסיד), kind, good, set apart (one), sanctified, merciful, saint
 - Yea, **the stork in the heaven knows her time**... but this **My people knows not the judgments of אִפְאֵל**. (Jeremiah 8:7, LXXE)
 - **How will ye say, We are wise, and the law of אִפְאֵל is with us?** In vain have **the scribes used a false pen. The wise men** are ashamed, and alarmed, and taken; because they **have rejected the word of אִפְאֵל; what wisdom is there in them?** (Jeremiah 8:8-9, LXXE)
 - *Storks were perceived as the enemy of serpents (part of a stork's diet)*
 - Storks are generally quiet, monogamous, nurturing parents, and return to an established nesting site*



...The Ostrich

- ...for [the ostrich] will leave her eggs in the ground, and warm them on the dust, and has forgotten that the foot will scatter them, and **the wild beasts of the field trample them**. She has hardened [herself] against her young ones, as though [she bereaved] not herself: she labours in vain without fear. For Aluhiym has withholden wisdom from her, and not given her a portion in understanding. In her season she will lift herself on high; she will scorn the horse and his rider. (Job 39:13-18, LXXE)
- We have hunted our little ones, that they should not walk in our streets...
(Lamentations 4:18, LXXE)



The Horse

...the horse and his rider. Hast thou invested the horse with strength, and clothed his neck with terror? And hast thou clad him in perfect armour, and made his breast glorious with courage? He paws exulting in the plain, and goes forth in strength into the plain. He laughs to scorn a king as he meets him, and will by no means turn back from the sword. The bow and sword resound against him; and [his] rage will swallow up the ground: and he will not believe until the trumpet sounds. And when the trumpet sounds, he says, Aha! and afar off he smells the war with prancing and neighing. (Job 39:18-25, LXXE)

KOPH. Our time has drawn nigh, our days are fulfilled, our time is come. (Lamentations 4:18, LXXE)

And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer. (Revelation 6:2)



The Hawk



- And does the hawk remain steady by thy wisdom, having spread out her wings unmoved, looking toward the region of the south? (Job 39:26, LXXE)
 - **Our pursuers were swifter than the eagles of the sky,** they flew on the mountains, in the wilderness they laid wait for us. (Lamentations 4:19, LXXE)

The Eagle

- And does the eagle rise at thy command, (Job 39:27, LXXE)
 - RECHS. The breath of our nostrils, anointed אף אף, was taken in their destructive snares, of whom we said, In his shadow we shall live among the Gentiles.
(Lamentations 4:20, LXXE)
 - ...there came up from the sea an eagle, which had twelve feathered wings, and three heads... there awaked one of the heads that were at rest, namely, it that was in the midst; for that was greater than the two other heads... But this head put the whole earth in fear, and bare rule in it over all those that dwelt upon the earth with much oppression; and it had the governance of the world more than all the wings that had been. (2 Esdras 11:1/29/32)



The Vulture

- ...and the vulture remain sitting over his nest, on a crag of a rock, and in a secret [place]? (Job 39:27-28, LXXE)
 - CHSEN. Rejoice and be glad, O daughter of Idumea, that dwellest in the land: yet the cup of $\aleph\aleph\aleph$ shall pass through to thee... (Lamentations 4:21, LXXE)



- ...the synagogue of satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie... (Revelation 3:9)
 - And upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH. (Revelation 17:6)
- And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices... I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not. (Revelation 10:4)

The Vulture

- Thence he seeks food, his eyes observe from far. And his young ones roll themselves in blood, and wherever the carcasses may be, immediately they are found. (Job 39:29-30, LXXE)
 - ...thou shalt be drunken, and pour forth. (Lamentations 4:21, LXXE)
 - For wheresoever the carcass is, there will the eagles be gathered together. (Matthew 24:28)
 - And in whatever place the body will be, there the vultures gather together. (Matthew 24:28, HG)
 - And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of ⓪ⓂⓕⓐⓏ: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration. (Revelation 17:6)
 - ...I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of ⓪ⓂⓕⓐⓏ, and for the word of Aluah, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Messiah a thousand years. (Revelation 20:4)

The Vulture

- **Immediately after the tribulation of those days... He shall send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.** (Matthew 24:29/31)
 - THAU. **O daughter of Sion, thine iniquity has come to an end; He shall no more carry thee captive: He has visited thine iniquities, O daughter of Edom**; He has discovered thy sins. (Lamentations 4:22, LXXE)
 - carry (G4369, προσθήσει), increase, add to, proceed further



The Seven Thunders

And who prepared ...a way for **the thunders**; to rain upon the land where ...there is not a man in it... (Job 38:25-26, LXXE)

...and when he had cried, **seven thunders** uttered their voices. And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, **Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not**. (Revelation 10:3-4)

...and the vulture remain sitting over his nest, on a crag of a rock, and in **a secret [place]**? (Job 39:27-28, LXXE)

Thou calledst in trouble, and I delivered thee; I answered thee in **the secret place of thunder**: I proved thee at the waters of Meribah. Selah... (Psalm 81:7)

Meribah (H4809, מריבה), “strife” or “contention”

The Wild Goats and Deer

- [Say] if thou knowest the time of the bringing forth of the wild goats and [if] thou hast marked the calving of the hinds... and [if] thou hast relieved their pangs: and hast reared their young without fear; and wilt thou loosen their pangs? Their young will break forth; they will be multiplied with offspring: (Job 39:1-4, LXXE)
 - Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but out of them all אֱלֹהִים will deliver them. (Psalm 33:20, LXXE)
 - [It is] Aluhiym that girds me with strength, and has made my way blameless: who strengthens my feet as hart's feet, and sets me upon high places. (Psalm 17:33-34, LXXE)



The Donkey

- ...And who is He that sent forth the wild ass free? and who loosed his bands? whereas I made his habitation the wilderness, and the salt land his coverts. He laughs to scorn the multitude of the city, and hears not the chiding of the tax-gatherer. He will survey the mountains [as] his pasture, and he seeks after every green thing.
(Job 39:5-8, LXXE)

Babylon

- 𐤁𐤓𐤁𐤓 recompenses, and will make her leaders and her wise men and her captains completely drunk, saith the King, 𐤁𐤓𐤁𐤓 Almighty is His name. (Jeremiah 28:57, LXXE)
- And Babylon shall be a desolation... In their heat I will give them a draught, and make them drunk, that they may be stupified, and sleep an everlasting sleep, and not awake, saith 𐤁𐤓𐤁𐤓. (Jeremiah 28:37/39, LXXE)

FLEE OUT OF BABYLON

- Thus saith יהוה ; Behold, I stir up against Babylon... I will send forth against Babylon spoilers, and they shall spoil her, and shall ravage her land. Woe to Babylon round about her in the day of her affliction... Flee ye out of the midst of Babylon, and deliver every one his soul: and be not overthrown in her iniquity; for it is the time of her retribution from יהוה ; He is rendering to her a recompence. (Jeremiah 28:1-2/6, LXXE)
- And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, My people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues. (Revelation 18:4)

- Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of the iniquities of those... therefore, son of man, prepare thyself baggage for going into captivity... I have made thee a sign to the house of Israel. (Ezekiel 12:2-3/6, LXXE)

Flee From Job's Jungle

- The Rhino – trusting in the strength of the nations
- The Peacock – Pride and vanity
- The Ostrich – Ignorance, scoffing, and neglect of their young
- The Horse – Coming for war and destruction
- The Hawk – Swiftly pursuing its prey
- The Eagle – Rising up on command to take the prey
- The Vulture – Hiding in secret and then rolling around in the blood of the killed



The Days of Judgement

- Behold, the days come, saith אֲנִי , that I will punish all them which are circumcised with the uncircumcised; Egypt, and Judah, and Edom, and the children of Ammon, and Moab, and all that are in the utmost corners, that dwell in the wilderness: for all these nations are uncircumcised, and all the house of Israel are uncircumcised in the heart.

(Jeremiah 9:25-26)



The Days of Judgement

- The Spirit of אִשְׂרָאֵל is upon Me, because He has anointed Me... to declare...**the day of recompense**... (Isaiah 61:1-2, LXXE)
- ...Yet they have chosen their own ways, and their soul has delighted in their abominations. I also will choose their mockeries, and **will recompense their sins upon them**; because I called them, and they did not hearken to Me; I spoke, and they heard not: and they did evil before Me, and chose the things wherein I delighted not. (Isaiah 66:3-4, LXXE)

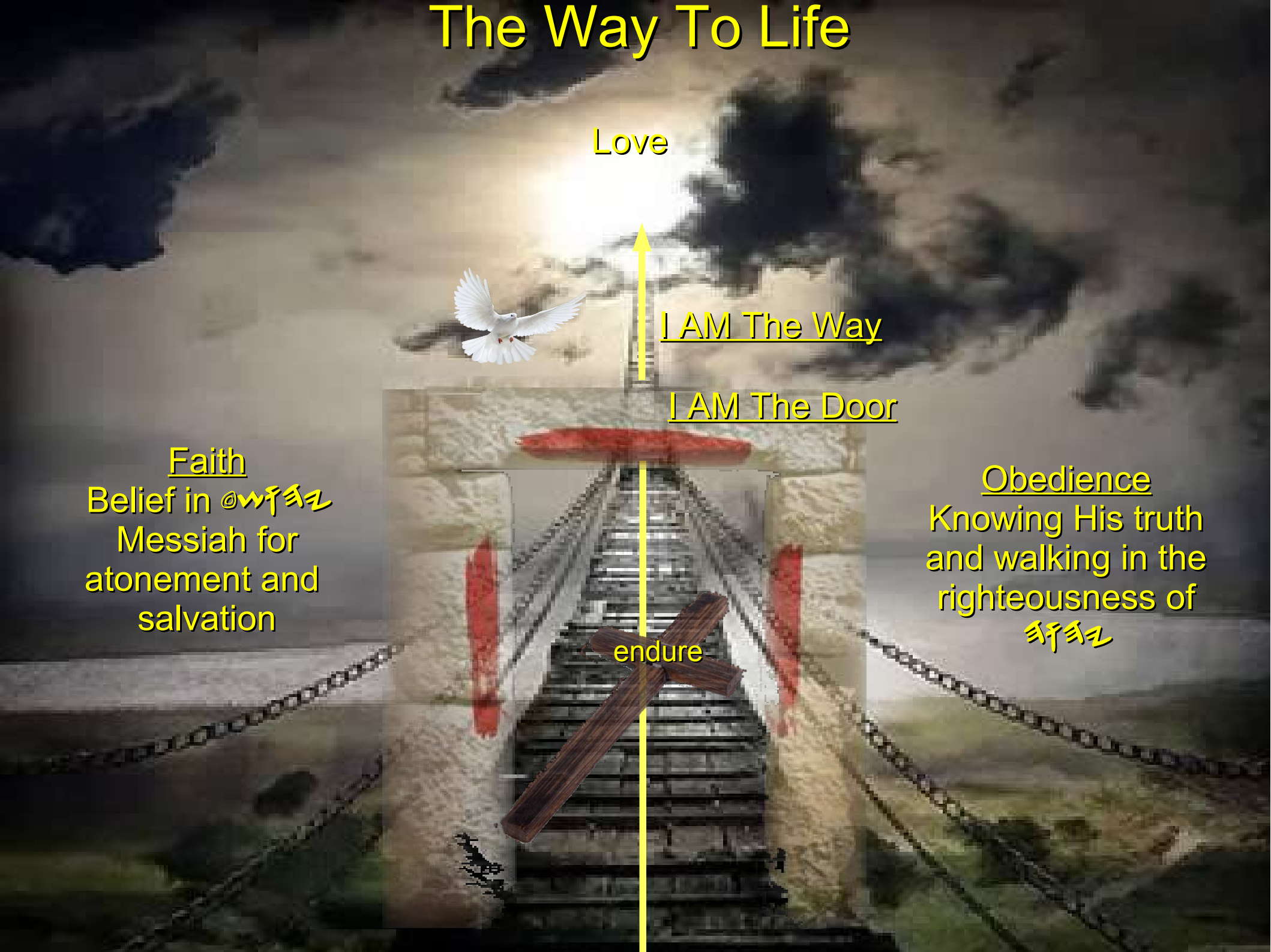
