# Reminder of Israel in the Wilderness

- Moreover, brethren, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; And were **all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea;** (1 Corinthians 10:1-2)
- Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto אֲפֹאֲרָה... So Moses brought Israel from the End sea, and they went out into the wilderness... (Exodus 15:1/22)
- And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Messiah. But **with many of them Elohiym was not well pleased:** for they were overthrown in the wilderness. Now these things were our examples... and **they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.** (1 Corinthians 10:4-6/11)



# Led By The Spirit To The Wilderness

- ⲙⲓⲛⲓⲁⲛⲓ, when He was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto Him, and he saw the Spirit of El descending like a dove, and lighting upon Him: And lo a voice from heaven, saying, **This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.** Then was ⲙⲓⲛⲓⲁⲛⲓ led up of the Spirit into the wilderness... (Matthew 3:16-17; 4:1)



# The Subtle Temptation

- Then was  $\text{ⲉⲱⲛⲓⲛⲁⲛ}$  led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil. And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, He was afterward an hungred. And when the tempter came to Him, he said, If Thou be the Son of El, command that these stones be made bread. (Matthew 4:1-3)





# It Is Written...

- But He answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of El. (Matthew 4:4)
  - And thou shalt remember all the way which אֶלֶּל thy Elohiym led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep His commandments, or no. And He humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger... that He might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of אֶלֶּל doth man live. (Deuteronomy 8:2-3)

# The Prophet

- אֶפְרָיִם thy Elohiym will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto Me; unto Him ye shall hearken... I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put My words in His mouth; and He shall speak unto them all that I shall command Him. And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto My words which He shall speak in My name, I will require it of him. But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in My name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other gods, even that prophet shall die.  
(Deuteronomy 18:15/18-20)

– “hearken” - schma (H8085, שָׁמַע), defined as to hear and obey, hear with attention

# That Prophet?

- ...this is the record of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, Who art thou? ...Art thou that prophet? And he answered, **No...** but there standeth One among you, whom ye know not; He it is, who coming after me is preferred before me, whose shoe's latchet I am not worthy to unloose. (John 1:19/21/26-27)



# That Prophet

- Then those men, when they had seen the miracle (*the feeding of the 5000*) that **᠎ᠠᠮᠤᠰᠢᠰ** did, said, This is of a truth **that prophet** that should come into the world. (John 6:14)
- And the multitude said, This is **᠎ᠠᠮᠤᠰᠢᠰ** **the prophet** of Nazareth of Galilee. (Matthew 21:11)
- Peter... answered... And he shall send **᠎ᠠᠮᠤᠰᠢᠰ** Messiah, which before was preached unto you... For Moses truly said unto the fathers, A Prophet shall **ᠰᠢᠮᠤᠰ** your Elohiym raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; Him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever He shall say unto you. And it shall come to pass, that **every soul, which will not hear that Prophet, shall be destroyed** from among the people. (Acts 3:12/20/22-23)





# I AM That Prophet

- **᠋ᠣᠩᠰᠢᠨ** answered them, and said, **My doctrine is not Mine, but His that sent Me.** If any man will do His will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of El, or whether I speak of Myself. He that speaketh of himself seeketh his own glory: but **He that seeketh His glory that sent Him,** the same is true, and **no unrighteousness is in Him.** (John 7:16-18)
- He that sent Me is true; and **I speak to the world those things which I have heard of Him...** Then said **᠋ᠣᠩᠰᠢᠨ** unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, **then shall ye know that I AM ~~he~~,** and that **I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father hath taught Me, I speak these things.** And **He that sent Me is with Me:** the Father hath not left Me alone; for **I do always those things that please Him.** (John 8:26/28-29)

# I AM That Prophet

- **⓪ⓂⓉⓂ** cried and said, He that believeth on Me, believeth not (only) on Me, but on Him that sent Me. And he that seeth Me seeth Him that sent Me. I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on Me should not abide in darkness... For I have not spoken of Myself; but the Father which sent Me, He gave Me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak. And I know that His commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto Me, so I speak. (John 12:44-46/49-50)

# He Is That Prophet

- אֶפְרָיִם thy Elohiym will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto Him ye shall hearken... and will put My words in His mouth; and He shall speak unto them all that I shall command Him. (Deuteronomy 18:15/18)
- My doctrine is not Mine, but His that sent Me. (John 7:16)
- He gave Me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak. And I know that His commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto Me, so I speak. (John 12:49-50)

# The Words of The Father

- **If ye love Me, keep My commandments.** (John 14:15)
  - Therefore **thou shalt love** אהבתי thy Elohiym, and **keep** His charge, and His statutes, and His judgments, and **His commandments, always.** (Deuteronomy 11:1)
- It is **the Spirit who gives life**; the flesh profits nothing. **The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.** (John 6:63)
- ...but **if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.** (Matthew 19:17)
- But the hour cometh, and now is, when **the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth**: for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. El is a Spirit: and **they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth.** (John 4:23-24)

# The Prophet Shows The Father

- @wƒʌz saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me. If ye had known Me, ye should have known My Father also: and from henceforth ye know Him, and have seen Him. Philip saith unto Him, Adon, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us. @wƒʌz saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known Me, Philip? he that hath seen Me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father? Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of Myself: but the Father that dwelleth in Me, He doeth the works. (John 14:6-10)

# I AM: The Way, The Truth, And The Life

- Blessed are the undefiled in **the way**, **who walk in the law of אֱלֹהִים**. (Psalm 119:1)
- Thy righteousness is an everlasting righteousness, and **Thy law is the truth**. (Psalm 119:142)
- **The law** of the wise **is a fountain of life**, to depart from the snares of death. (Proverbs 13:14)
  - The fear of אֱלֹהִים is the beginning of wisdom (Proverbs 9:10)
  - The fear of אֱלֹהִים driveth away sins: and where it is present, it turneth away wrath. If thou desire wisdom, keep the commandments, and אֱלֹהִים shall give her unto thee. (Sirach 1:21/26)

# The Fountain of Life

- On the last day, that great day of the Feast, **אֶלְיָאזָר** stood and cried out, saying, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, **out of his heart will flow rivers of living water**. (John 7:37-38 - NKJV)
  - My son, attend to My words... **Keep them in the midst of your heart**. For **they are life to those who find them...** Keep **your heart** with all diligence, For **out of it is the wellspring of life**. (Proverbs 4:20-23 - HNV)
- **Ye that thirst, go to the water**, and all that have no money, go [and] buy; and eat [and drink] wine and fat without money or price. **...hearken to Me ...and your soul shall feast itself on good things**. **Give heed with your ears, and follow My ways: hearken to Me, and your soul shall live in prosperity; and I will make with you an everlasting covenant**, the sure mercies of David. Behold I have made Him a testimony among the Gentiles... (Isaiah 55:1-4 – Sept)
- ...this **shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel**; After those days, saith **אֶלְיָאזָר**, **I will put My law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts**... (Jeremiah 31:33)

# The Light of Life

- Then spake  $\text{אֱלֹהִים}$  again unto them, saying, **I am the light of the world**: he that followeth Me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have **the light of life**. (John 8:12)
- And now, saith  $\text{אֱלֹהִים}$  that formed Me from the womb to be His servant, to bring Jacob again to Him, Though Israel be not gathered, yet shall I be glorious in the eyes of  $\text{אֱלֹהִים}$ , and My El shall be My strength. And He said, It is a light thing that Thou shouldest be My servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: **I will also give Thee for a light to the Gentiles**, that Thou mayest be My salvation unto the end of the earth. (Isaiah 49:5-6)



# Words Of Life... Or Death

- אֵלֹהִים thy Elohiym will raise up... a Prophet... and He shall speak unto them all that I shall command Him... But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in My name, which I have not commanded him to speak, ...even that prophet shall die. (Deuteronomy 18:15/18/20)
  - If Thou be the Son of El, command that these stones be made bread. (Matthew 4:3)
  - אֵלֹהִים thy Elohiym led thee... in the wilderness... to prove thee, ... whether thou wouldest keep His commandments, or no. And He humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger... that He might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of אֵלֹהִים doth man live. (Deuteronomy 8:2-3)
- He gave Me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak. And I know that His commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto Me, so I speak. (John 12:49-50)

# The Prophet Finished His Work

- These words spake  $\text{ⲉⲱⲩⲁⲛⲁ}$ , and lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said, **Father... I have finished the work which Thou gavest Me to do...** I have manifested Thy name unto the men which Thou gavest Me out of the world... and **they have kept Thy word**. Now they have known that all things whatsoever Thou hast given Me are of Thee. For **I have given unto them the words which Thou gavest Me**; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from Thee, and **they have believed that Thou didst send Me**. (John 17:1/4/6-8)

# The Prophet Finished His Work

- I have given them Thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world... Sanctify them through Thy truth: Thy word is truth... And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth. Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on Me through their word; That they all may be one; as Thou, Father, art in Me, and I in Thee, that they also may be one in Us: that the world may believe that Thou hast sent Me. (John 17:14/17/19-21)



# The Tempting Temptation

- Then the devil taketh Him up into the set apart city, and setteth Him on a pinnacle of the temple, And saith unto Him, If Thou be the Son of El, cast Thyself down: for it is written, He shall give His angels charge concerning Thee: and in their hands they shall bear Thee up, lest at any time Thou dash Thy foot against a stone. (Matthew 4:5-6)
  - For He shall give His angels charge over Thee, to keep Thee in all Thy ways. They shall bear thee up in Their hands, lest Thou dash Thy foot against a stone. (Psalm 91:11-12)
- אלהים said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt אלהים thy Elohiym. (Matthew 4:7)
  - Ye shall not tempt אלהים your Elohiym, as ye tempted Him in Massah. (Deuteronomy 6:16)

# A Lack of Faith




- ...the congregation of the children of Israel journeyed from the wilderness of Sin, after their journeys, according to the commandment of אָפְאֵל, and pitched in Rephidim: and there was no water for the people to drink. Wherefore **the people did chide with Moses**, and said, Give us water that we may drink. And Moses said unto them, **Why chide ye with me? wherefore do ye tempt אָפְאֵל?** And the people thirsted there for water; and **the people murmured against Moses...** (Exodus 17:1-5....)
- And he called the name of the place Massah, and Meribah, because of **the chiding of the children of Israel**, and because **they tempted אָפְאֵל**, saying, **Is אָפְאֵל among us, or not?** (Exodus 17:7)
  - Massah (H4532, מַסָּה), “temptation”, trial, a testing of El

# The Wilderness Shadow

- if ye will obey My voice indeed, and keep My covenant, then...ye shall be unto Me a kingdom of priests, and a set apart nation....all the people answered together, and said, All that אף אז hath spoken we will do. (Exodus 19:5-6/8)
- And Moses went down from the mount unto the people, and sanctified the people; and they washed their clothes. (Exodus 19:14)
- ...go not up into the mount, or touch the border of it: whosoever toucheth the mount shall be surely put to death...when the trumpet soundeth long, they shall come up to the mount. (Exodus 19:12-13)

# The Heavenly Mount Zion

- For ye are not come unto the mount that might be touched, and that burned with fire, nor unto blackness, and darkness, and tempest, And the sound of a trumpet, and the voice of words; which voice they that heard intreated that the word should not be spoken to them any more:... But **ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living El, the heavenly Jerusalem,** and to an innumerable company of angels... **And to  the mediator of the New Covenant...** (Hebrews 12:18-19/22/24)

# Paul's Wilderness Journey

- **...I will shew him how great things he must suffer for My name's sake.** (Acts 9:16)
- ...thrice I suffered shipwreck, a night and a day I have been in the deep; In journeyings often, in perils of waters... in perils in the sea... (2 Corinthians 11:25-26)





# Paul Suffered Greatly

- Of the Jews five times received I forty stripes save one. Thrice was I beaten with rods, once was I stoned... in perils of robbers, in perils by mine own countrymen, in perils by the heathen, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils among false brethren... In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness. Beside those things that are without, that which cometh upon me daily, the care of all the assemblies. (2 Corinthians 11:24-25/27-28)
- Paul, an apostle of  $\text{@w}\text{f}\text{A}\text{z}$  Messiah by the will of El... Who now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Messiah in my flesh for His body's sake, which is the assembly: (Colossians 1:1/24)



# You Shall Suffer Also

- Yea, and all that will live sanctified in Messiah shall suffer persecution... But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned them; And that from a child thou hast known the set apart scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Messiah. All scripture is given by inspiration of Elohiym, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of Elohiym may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works. (2 Timothy 3:12/14-17)
- But rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Messiah's sufferings; that, when His glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy. (1 Peter 4:13)



# The Great Temptation

- Again, the devil taketh Him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth Him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them; And saith unto Him, All these things will I give Thee, if Thou wilt fall down and worship me. (Matthew 4:8-9)
- Then saith **אֵלֹהִים** unto him, **Get thee hence, satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship אֵלֹהִים thy Elohiym, and Him only shalt thou serve.** (Matthew 4:10)
  - Thou shalt fear אֵלֹהִים thy Elohiym, and serve Him, and shalt swear by His name. Ye shall not go after other gods... (Deuteronomy 6:13-14)
    - “fear” (H3372, ירא), defined as to fear, morally to revere, be in reverence

# Dominion Of The World Now

- Now is the judgment of this world: now shall the prince of this world be cast out. (John 12:31)
- ...for the prince of this world cometh, and hath nothing in Me. (John 14:30)
- Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged. (John 16:11)
- We know that we are of El, and **the whole world lies under the sway of the wicked one**. (1 John 5:19 - NKJV)
- In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not... (2 Corinthians 4:4)
- Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience: (Ephesians 2:2)
- ...satan, which deceiveth the whole world... (Revelation 12:9)
- Who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil world... (Galatians 1:4)

# The Earth Was Cursed

- And Elohiym said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and **let them have dominion** over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and **over all the earth**, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. (Genesis 1:26)
- **Trust in אֱלֹהִים with all thine heart**; and **lean not unto thine own understanding**. (Proverbs 3:5)
- And אֱלֹהִים Elohiym said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou art **cursed** above all cattle, and above every beast of the field... And **I will put **enmity** between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed**; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.... And unto Adam He said, Because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: **cursed is the ground for thy sake**... Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee... (Genesis 3:14-15/17-18)
  - And אֱלֹהִים **cursed** the serpent, **and was wroth with it forever**. (Jubilees 3:23)

# Curses

- But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of אף אעז thy Elohiym... curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee (Deuteronomy 28:15)
  - And thy heaven that is over thy head shall be brass, and the earth that is under thee shall be iron. (Deuteronomy 28:23)
  - אף אעז shall cause thee to be smitten before thine enemies... (Deuteronomy 28:25)
  - Moreover all these curses shall come upon thee, and shall pursue thee, and overtake thee, till thou be destroyed; because thou hearkenedst not unto the voice of אף אעז thy Elohiym (Deuteronomy 28:45)
  - And thou shalt serve thine enemies, which אף אעז will send forth against thee, in hunger, and in thirst, and in nakedness, and in the want of all things; and thou shalt wear upon thy neck a yoke of iron until he shall have destroyed thee. (Deuteronomy 28:48)

# A Covenant With Death Made

- For Elohiym made not death: neither hath He pleasure in the destruction of the living. For He created all things, that they might have their being: and the generations of the world were healthful; and there is no poison of destruction in them, nor the kingdom of death upon the earth: (For righteousness is immortal:) But ungodly men with their works and words called it to them: for when they thought to have it their friend, they consumed to nought, and **made a covenant with it, because they are worthy to take part with it.** (Wisdom 1:13-16)
- For Elohiym created man to be immortal, and made him to be an image of His own eternity. Nevertheless through envy of the devil came death into the world: and they that do hold of his side do find it. (Wisdom 2:23-24)



# Written Down in Heaven

- And אָפּפּוּ reprov'd Cain because of Abel, because he had slain him, and He made him a fugitive on the earth because of the blood of his brother, and He **cursed** him upon the earth. **And on this account it is written on the heavenly tables, 'Cursed is he** who smites his neighbour treacherously... (Jubilees 4:4-5)
- And the judgment of all is ordained and written on the heavenly tablets in righteousness -even (the judgment of) all who depart from the path which is ordained for them to walk in; and if they walk not therein, judgment is written down for every creature and for every kind. And there is nothing in heaven or on earth, or in light or in darkness, or in Sheol or in the depth, or in the place of darkness (which is not judged); and all their judgments are ordained and written and engraved. (Jubilees 5:13-14)



# Who Is Worthy?

- And I saw in the right hand of Him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals. And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof? And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon. And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon. (Revelation 5:1-4)



# Speak To Zerubbabel

- Speak now to Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah... Who is left among you that saw this house in her first glory? and how do ye see it now? is it not in your eyes in comparison of it as nothing?... I will shake all nations, and the desire of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with glory... The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former, saith  $\text{יהוה}$  of hosts: and in this place will I give peace... (Haggai 2:2-3/7/9)
- And  $\text{יהושע}$  Himself began to be about thirty years of age, being (as was supposed) the son of Joseph, which was the son of Heli... which was the son of Zorobabel, which was the son of Salathiel... which was the son of Nathan, which was the son of David, Which was the son of Jesse... (Luke 3:23/27/31-32)

# You Will Have The Signet



- And again the word of אֱלֹהֵינוּ came unto Haggai... saying, Speak to Zerubbabel, governor of Judah, saying, **I will shake the heavens and the earth**; (Haggai 2:20-21)
- and I will overthrow the thrones of kings, and I will destroy the power of the kings of the nations; and I will overthrow chariots and riders; and **the horses and their riders shall come down**, every one by the sword striving against his brother. (Haggai 2:22 - Sept)
- **In that day**, saith אֱלֹהֵינוּ Almighty, **I will take Thee, O Zerubbabel, the son of Salathiel, My servant**, saith אֱלֹהֵינוּ **and will make Thee as a seal: for I have chosen Thee**, saith אֱלֹהֵינוּ Almighty. (Haggai 2:23 - Sept)
  - **...and will make Thee as a signet...** (Haggai 2:23 - KJV)

# No One Can Open The Decree... Sealed With the King's Signet

- Write ye... in the king's name, and seal it with the king's ring: for the writing which is written in the king's name, and sealed with the king's ring, may no man reverse. (Ester 8:8)



# There Stood A Lamb

- And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon. And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, **the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.** And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, **stood a Lamb as it had been slain**... (Revelation 5:4-6)
- ...the father said to his servants, Bring forth the best robe, and put it on him; and **put a ring on his hand**, and shoes on his feet: (Luke 15:22)

**All power is given unto Me in heaven and in earth.** (Matthew 28:18)

# Worthy Is The Lamb

- And He came and took the book out of the right hand of Him that sat upon the throne. And when He had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb... And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof for Thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to El by Thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; And hast made us unto our El kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth... Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power... (Revelation 5:6-10)

# Reverse the Curse

- Trust in אֱלֹהִים with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. (Proverbs 3:5)
- Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools... Who changed the truth of Elohiym into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever (Romans 1:22/25)
- ...He was manifested to take away our sins; and in Him is no sin. (1 John 3:5)
- Messiah hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: (Galatians 3:13)
- For as in Adam all die, even so in Messiah shall all be made alive. (1 Corinthians 15:22)
- I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in Me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever liveth and believeth in Me shall never die. Believest thou this? (John 11:25-26)



# Satan Defeated

- But we speak the wisdom of Elohiym in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which Elohiym ordained before the world unto our glory: Which **none of the princes of this world knew**: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Adon of glory. (1 Corinthians 2:7-8)
- ...apart from blood-shedding forgiveness doth not come. (Hebrews 9:22)
- And ye are complete in **Him, which is the head of all principality and power.** In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Messiah... **Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us,** and took it out of the way, nailing it to His cross; And **having spoiled principalities and powers, He made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.** (Colossians 2:10-11/14-15)

# The Lamb Takes Back Complete Ownership of The Earth

- And I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals...And when He had opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour. And I saw the seven angels which stood before El; and to them were given seven trumpets. (Revelation 6:1; 8:1-2)
- And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Adon, and of His Messiah; and He shall reign for ever and ever. (Revelation 11:15)
- And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done. (Revelation 16:17)

# I Make All Things New

- And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. And I John saw the set apart city, new Jerusalem, coming down from El out of heaven... And He that sat upon the throne said, **Behold, I make all things new**... (Revelation 21:1-5)
