#### At The Mountain of AFAL

• And Moses was feeding the flock of Jethro... and he brought the sheep...and came to the mount of Horeb. And an <u>angel of \*f\*\*</u> appeared unto him in flaming fire out of the bush: and he sees that the bush burns with fire – but the bush was not consumed. (Exodus 3:1-2, LXXE)



#### IAM

... A called him out of the bush, saying, MOSES... LAM (ἐγώ είμι) Aluhiym of thy father, the Aluhiym of Abraham, and the Aluhiym of Isaac, and the Aluhiym of Jacob... (Exodus 3:4/6, LXXE)

- I egō (G1473, ἐγώ), I
- AM -eimi (G1510, είμι), to exist, am
- And Moses said... they will ask me,
  What is His name? What shall I say to
  them? And Aluhiym spoke to Moses,
  saying, I AM (ἐγώ εἰμι) THE BEING...
  (Exodus 3:13-14, LXXE)
  - I AM (H1961, אהיה), (I will) to exist, be
  - The (G3588, ò), definite article: the, one, he
    - BEING (G5607, ὤν), present participle of G1510: being, be, exists

#### I AM - The Same ONE

And 漸氧元 spoke all these words, saying, LAM (ἐγώ είμι)
 漸氧元 thy Aluhiym, who brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. Thou shalt have no other gods beside Me. (Exodus 20:1-3, LXXE)

Then said the Jews unto Him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham? ΦΥΓΑΣ said unto them, VERILY, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I AM (ἐγὼ είμί). (John 8:57-58)



#### Be Set Apart in All Things

- But as <u>He which hath called you is set apart</u>, <u>so be ye set apart</u> in all manner of conversation; <u>Because it is written</u>: "<u>Be set apart</u>, for I am <u>set apart</u>." (1 Peter 1:15-16)
  - "conversation" anastrophē (G391, ἀναστροφῆ), defined as manner of life, conduct, behavior, deportment
- For [AM (ἐγώ εἰμι) ձζάν your Aluhiym; and ye shall be set apart, because [ ձζάν your Aluhiym am set apart... For [AM (ἐγώ εἰμι) ձζάν who brought you up out of the land of Egypt to be your Aluhiym: and ye shall be set apart, for [ ձζάν am set apart... To distinguish between the unclean and the clean... between those that ...should be eaten, and those that... should not be eaten. (Leviticus 11:44-45/47, LXXE)
  - unclean (H2931, טמא), from H2930, defiled, polluted, unclean
    - (H2930, טמא), <u>defile (self)</u>, pollute (self), <u>be</u> (make, make self, <u>pronounce</u>) <u>unclean</u>
  - unclean (G169, ακαθαρτων), foul, unclean, impure (morally or demonic)

## Be Set Apart in All Things

- And \*f\*\* spoke... these ye shall not eat... the swine... is unclean to you... all things which have not fins or scales in the water... they shall be abominations to you. Ye shall not eat of their flesh... winged creatures that creep, which go upon four feet, are abominations to you... And by these ye shall be defiled... (Leviticus 11:1/4/7/10-11/20/24, LXXE)
- ... be set apart yourselves also in all behavior; (1 Peter 1:15, NASB)



## You Are The Temple Now

- ...for ye are the temple of the living Aluhiym; as Aluhiym hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their Aluhiym, and they shall be My people. Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith 4542, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be My sons and daughters, saith AFAL Almighty. (2 Corinthians 6:16-18, quoting Ezekiel 37:26-27, Leviticus 26:12, Isaiah 52:11, Ezekiel 20:41, 2 **Samuel 7:14)** 
  - unclean (G169, ακαθαρτων), Same word used for every single instance of "unclean" in Leviticus 11 LXX)

## For I am अ१७२ your Aluhiym, and am not changed (Malachi 3:6, LXXE)

**MY Messiah is the same yesterday and today and forever**. (Hebrews 13:8)



## Scriptures Twisted Into Destruction

- ...even as our beloved brother <u>Paul</u> also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you; As also <u>in all his epistles</u>, speaking in them of these things; in which are <u>some things hard to be understood</u>, <u>which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest</u>, as they do also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction. (2 Peter 3:15-16)

# You Are The Temple Don't Defile The Temple

- Know ye not that ye are the temple of Aluhiym, and that the Spirit of Aluhiym dwelleth in you? If any man defile the temple of Aluhiym, him shall Aluhiym destroy; for the temple of Aluhiym is set apart, which temple ye are. (1 Corinthians 3:16-17)
  - defile (G5251, φθείρει), to shrivel or wither, ruin, corrupt (self),
     defile, destroy
- And whatever man that shall be defiled and shall not purify himself, that soul shall be cut off from the midst of the congregation, because he hath defiled the set apart things of afaz, , because the water of sprinkling has not been sprinkled upon him; he is unclean. (Numbers 19:20, LXXE)

Know ye not that <u>ye are the temple of Aluhiym</u>, and that <u>the Spirit of Aluhiym</u> dwelleth in you? <u>If any man defile the temple of Aluhiym him shall Aluhiym destroy</u>; for <u>the temple of Aluhiym is set apart, which temple ye are</u>. (1



#### Your Temple Can Still Be Purified

- ...the king sent an old man of Athens to compel the Jews to ... not to live after the laws of Aluhiym: And to pollute also the temple in Jerusalem... The altar also was filled with profane things, which the law forbiddeth. (2 Maccabees 6:1-2/5)
- Then said Judas and his brethren, Behold, our enemies are discomfited: let us go up to cleanse and dedicate the sanctuary. And when they saw the sanctuary desolate, and the altar profaned, and the gates burned up... They rent their clothes, and made great lamentation, and cast ashes upon their heads, And fell down flat to the ground upon their faces, and blew an alarm with the trumpets, and cried toward heaven. Then Judas appointed certain men to fight against those that were in the fortress, until he had cleansed the sanctuary... and built a new altar according to the former; (1 Maccabees 4:36/38-41/47)
- Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting sanctification in the fear of Aluhiym. (2 Corinthians 7:1)

#### Remove Filth Towards Sanctification

- ...for ye are the temple of the living Aluhiym; as Aluhiym hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their Aluhiym, and they shall be My people. Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith 4742, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be My sons and daughters, saith 4742 Almighty. (2 Corinthians 6:16-18, quoting Ezekiel 37:26-27, Leviticus 26:12, Isaiah 52:11, Ezekiel 20:41, 2 Samuel 7:14)
- Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting sanctification in the fear of Aluhiym. (2 Corinthians 7:1)

#### Clean Animals

Speak to the children of Israel, saying, <u>These are the animals which</u> you may eat among all the animals that are on the earth: Among the animals, <u>whatever divides the hoof</u>, having cloven hooves <u>and</u> chewing the cud - that you may eat. (Leviticus 11:2-3 - NKJV)

Ye shall not eat any <u>abominable</u> thing. These [are] the beasts which
ye shall eat; the calf of the herd, and lamb of the sheep, and kid of
the goats; the stag, and doe, and pygarg, and wild goat, and
camelopard. (Deuteronomy 14:3-5, LXXE)





## Pigs... Unclean



- And the <u>swine</u>, because this [animal] divides the hoof, and makes claws of the hoof, and it does not chew the cud, is <u>unclean</u> to you. <u>Ye shall not eat of their flesh</u>, and ye shall not touch their carcases; <u>these are unclean to you.</u>
   (Leviticus 11:78, LXXE)
  - And as for the <u>swine</u>, because he divides the hoof, and makes claws of the hoof, yet he chews not the cud, he is <u>unclean</u> to you; <u>ye shall not eat of their flesh</u>, <u>ye shall not touch their dead bodies</u>. (Deuteronomy 14:8, LXXE)

#### Neither Fins Nor Scales... Unclean

And all things which have not fins or scales in the water...
and of every soul living in the water, are an <u>abomination</u>;
and they shall be <u>abominations</u> to you. (Leviticus 11:10 LXXE)




#### Carrion Birds... Unclean

• And these are the things which ye shall abhor of birds, and they shall not be eaten, they are an abomination: the eagle and the ossifrage, and the sea-eagle. And the vulture, and the kite, and the like to it; and the sparrow, and the owl, and the sea-mew, and the like to it: and every raven, and the birds like it, and the hawk and his like, and the night-raven and the cormorant and the stork, and the red-bill, and the pelican, and swan, and the heron, and the lapwing, and the like to it, and the hoopoe and the bat. And all winged creatures that creep, which go upon four feet, are abominations to you. (Leviticus 11:13-20, LXXE)





# Don't Bow to The Stomach God



**King Stomach** 

- I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of Aluhiym in Messiah @\sigma\_1 \cdots \text{N} \text{N} \text{N} \text{...} Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample. (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Messiah: Whose end is destruction, whose god is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things). (Philippians 3:14/17-19)
  - belly (G2836, κοιλία), <u>a cavity</u>, i.e. (especially) <u>the abdomen</u>; by implication, the matrix; figuratively, the heart:—<u>belly</u>, womb
    - ...Jonah was three days and three nights in the whale's belly (G2836)... (Matthew 12:40)

### The Disobedient People...

I said, Behold, I am, to a nation, who called not on My name. I have stretched forth My hands all day to a disobedient and gainsaying people, to them that walked in a way that was not good, but after their sins. This is the people that provokes Me continually in My presence... they that eat swine's flesh, and the broth of sacrifices: all their vessels are defiled: who say, Depart from me, draw not nigh to me, for I am pure. This is the smoke of My wrath, a fire burns with it continually. Behold, it is written before Me: I will not be silent until I have recompensed into their bosom, their sins and of their fathers, saith 1/12... I will deliver you up to the sword, ye shall all fall by slaughter: for I called you, and ye hearkened not; I spoke, and ye refused to hear; and ye did evil in My sight, and chose the things wherein I delighted not. (Isaiah 65:1-6/12-13, LXXE)

## Many Don't Listen To His Words

- So long too as they did these things to Me: they defiled My sanctuary, and profaned My Sabbaths. (Ezekiel 23:38, LXXE)
- Her prophets are light scornful men: her <u>priests profane the set</u> <u>apart things</u>, and <u>sinfully transgress the law</u>. (Zephaniah 3:4, LXXE)
- Therefore, as I live, saith % surely, because thou hast defiled My set apart things with all thine abominations, I also will reject thee; Mine eye shall not spare, and I will have no mercy. (Ezekiel 5:11, LXXE)
- What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Set
   Apart Spirit which is in you, which ye have of Aluhiym, and ye
   are not your own? For ye are bought with a price: therefore
   glorify Aluhiym in your body, and in your spirit, which are
   Aluhiym's. (1 Corinthians 6:19-20)

### Judgement For The Unclean

- chariots as a storm, to render His vengeance with wrath, and His rebuke with a flame of fire. For with the fire of AFAL all the earth shall be judged, and all flesh with His sword: many shall be slain by 🦄 They that sanctify themselves and purify themselves in the gardens, eating swine's flesh in the porches, and the abomination, and the mouse, shall be consumed together, saith **4742.** (Isaiah 66:15-17, LXXE)
- For I am 為するシ your Aluhiym, and I am not changed (Malachi 3:6, LXXE)

#### Clean Eating For The Kingdom of Priests

- ...these are the chambers of the sanctuary, wherein the priests the sons of Zadok, who draw nigh to shall eat the most set apart things: and there shall they lay the most set apart things... because the place is set apart. (Ezekiel 42:13, LXXE)
  - And ye shall be to Me a royal priesthood, and a set apart nation... (Exodus 19:6, LXXE)
  - I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of Aluhiym, that
    ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, set apart, acceptable
    unto Aluhiym, which is your reasonable service. (Romans 12:1)
  - And <u>hath made us kings and priests</u> unto Aluhiym and His Father (Revelation 1:6)



### Sanctify Your Temple

- Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort you by the Adon and, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please Aluhiym, so ye would abound more and more. For ye know what commandments we gave you by the Adon and. For this is the will of Aluhiym, even your sanctification... That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour... For Aluhiym hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto sanctification. (1 Thessalonians 4:1-4/7)
- ...behold, the kingdom of Aluhiym is within you. (Luke 17:21)
- Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith ৰ্ৰ্ৰ, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be My sons and daughters, saith ৰ্ৰ্ৰে Almighty. (2 Corinthians 6:17-18)

### Touch Not The Unclean Thing

- A son honours [his] father, and a servant his master: if then I am a father, where is Mine honour? and if I am a master, where is My fear? saith 4/4 Almighty... (Malachi 1:6, LXXE)
- Delight [thyself] in 4/42; and He shall grant thee the requests of thine heart... Submit thyself to 4/42, and supplicate Him... (Psalm 36:4/7, LXXE)
- And thou shalt do that which is pleasing and good before 4542 thy Aluhiym, that it may be well with thee... (Deuteronomy 16:18, LXXE)
- ...present your bodies a living sacrifice, set apart, acceptable unto Aluhiym, which is your reasonable service. (Romans 12:1)
- For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light. (Matthew 11:30)
- Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith %f%2, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,
   And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be My sons and daughters, saith %f%2 Almighty. (2 Corinthians 6:17-18)
